ONE MORE TIME

Today marks the 9th and final matchup between the Shuckers and Trash Pandas in the first half... The teams will not meet again until August 18-23 at Toyota Field, the second-to-last road trip of the season.

☞ **2B/OF DYLAN O'RAE** enters today 11-for-32 (.344) with 8 stolen bases against the Trash Pandas... **OF DAMON KEITH** enters today 8-for-28 (.286) with 3 doubles and 2 home runs.

GETTING FAMILIAR

The Shuckers enter today in the midst of a 33-game stretch to begin the season that sees the team face the same 3 teams: Pensacola Blue Wahoos (12g), Columbus Clingstones (12g) and Rocket City Trash Pandas (9g)... The Shuckers will not face an opponent outside of those 3 teams until May 11-17, when they face the Montgomery Biscuits at DABOS Park.

☞ The Shuckers will face 5 different opponents in the first half, with 21 games against North Division opponents.

RUNNING INTO THE RECORD BOOKS

2B/OF DYLAN O'RAE set the Shuckers single-game record (since 2015) with 5 stolen bases on Wednesday against the Trash Pandas... O'Rae broke the previous record of 4 which was set and tied 7 different times.

☞ O'Rae needs 5 stolen bases over the final 4 games of April to become the 3rd Southern League player since 2005 with 20+ stolen bases in a month... O'Rae would join **OF BILLY HAMILTON** (PNS, Aug. 2012, 37) and **OF CHANDLER SIMPSON** (MTG, Aug. 2024, 25).

RUNNING DOWN A DREAM

The Shuckers enter today with 61 stolen bases, the most by a Double-A team and the 8th-most by a team in Minor League Baseball through 20 games since 2005... The Shuckers have recorded 5+ stolen bases in 7 of 20 games... The Shuckers are on pace for 421 stolen bases... The Southern League stolen base record is 264 set by the 1989 Birmingham Barons... The Minor League record is 363, set by the Aberdeen IronBirds (BAL, A+), in 2024.

ALL ABOUT THE STREAKS

1B BLAKE BURKE (20g) and **2B/OF DYLAN O'RAE** (19g) enter today with 2 of the 3 longest on-base streaks in the Southern League this season... Both players have reached base in every game played this season.

☞ Burke's streak, a career-high is the first 20-game streak by a Shuckers player since **1B LUKE ADAMS** reached base in a franchise-record 39 consecutive games between April 29 and June 19, 2025.

☞ The last time two Shuckers teammates had 20+ game on-base streaks in the same season was in 2024, when **OF ADAM HALL** (21g) and **OF CARLOS RODRIGUEZ** (21g) each reached the mark.

THE ARM BARN IS SLINGING IT

The Shuckers bullpen enters today with a 3.92 ERA, the 2nd-lowest mark in the Southern League and the 5th-lowest in Double-A... The bullpen has also limited batters to a .195 average (2nd, Double-A) with a 26% strikeout rate.

☞ This series, the Shuckers bullpen has held a 3.42 ERA (10er, 26.1ip) with 23 strikeouts.

WELCOME BACK, EDWIN

On Friday, **RHP EDWIN JIMENEZ** extended his scoreless streak to 6.0 consecutive innings to begin the season... Through 4 appearances, Jimenez has limited opponents to 1-for-20 with no walks and 7 strikeouts.

☞ Prior to making his Double-A debut, Jimenez had not appeared in a game since May 26, 2024, as a member of the High-A Wisconsin Timber Rattlers.

BREAKING THE CENTURY MARK

On Wednesday, the Shuckers set the franchise record for the fastest team to reach 100 runs, needing 17 games to reach the mark... This season, the Shuckers have set a franchise record for the fastest team to reach 20 home runs (14g), 50 stolen bases (17g) and 100 walks (14g).

☞ The Shuckers 121 runs are the most through 20 games in franchise history (since 2015) and the 8th-most by a Southern League team in the Digital Stats Era (since 2005)... The Shuckers broke the previous record of 101, set in 2018.

I'M JUST A KID AND I MAKE PITCHERS LIVE A NIGHTMARE

On Wednesday, **SS/2B JESUS MADE** became the 6th Double-A player since 2005 to record at least 100 plate appearances before their 19th birthday... The group includes **OF BRYCE HARPER**, who held a .256/.329/.395 slash line with Double-A Harrisburg in 2011.

MADE FOR THE BIG STAGE

SS/2B JESUS MADE enters the 2026 season as the top-ranked Brewers prospect and the 4th-ranked overall prospect by *Baseball America*.

☞ Made will become baseball's top prospect once **Konnor Griffin** (74 AB), **Kevin McGonigle** (102 AB) and **JJ Wetherholt** (96 AB) all reach 130 AB.

BACK IN THE SADDLE

MANAGER MIKE GUERRERO is in his 8th season as Shuckers manager and 10th as manager of a Brewers Double-A affiliate... After reaching 1,400 career wins during the 2023 season, Guerrero needs 45 wins to reach 1,500... His 1,455 wins are the sixth-most among active managers in Minor League Baseball.

TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER

RHP BRETT WICHROWSKI (2-1, 5.30) makes his 2nd start and 3rd appearance against the Trash Pandas... Wichrowski enters today among the Southern League leaders in strikeouts (T-7th, 21) and innings (T-8th, 18.2).
