ABOUT LAST NIGHT...: CJ Van Eyk went five shutout innings and the offense hung a crooked number in the fifth as the Vancouver Canadians took down the Hillsboro Hops (Diamondbacks) 5-2 Tuesday night at Ron Tonkin Field.

After both teams were held scoreless through four, the C's broke through in their fifth time at bat against Hops starter Justin Vernia (L, 1-3). Luis De Los Santos started the rally with a walk then went to third on an Eric Rivera one-out single. Up stepped Zac Cook, who executed a perfect safety squeeze to score the run and beat it out for an infield single. Rafael Lantigua brought in Rivera with a rule book double, Tanner Morris plated a run with a sacrifice fly and Orelvis Martinez - MLB.com's #4 Blue Jays prospect making his High-A debut after getting called up from Low-A Dunedin - slugged his first homer as a Canadian and 20th of the year to make it 5-0.

After Van Eyk (W, 3-5) twirled his five scoreless stanzas that featured two hits, two walks and three punch outs, a trio of relievers - Gabriel Ponce, Andrew Bash and Roither Hernandez - were the bridge to Parker Caracci (S, 8) who retired the side in order in the ninth to secure the win and take sole nossession of the league lead in saves. Hillsboro spoiled the shutout with two unearned runs in the eighth on three singles, but that was the only inning the Hops had a runner reach third base.

Lantiqua's two hits and Martinez's two RRI paced the offense as six of nine C's starters finished with a hit. The win puts the C's back in fourth place and improves Vancouver's record against Hillsboro to 7-6 with 17 games left against the Diamondbacks affiliate.

BATTLE FOR THE 'BORO: Vancouver and Hillshoro go head-to-head this week in their third of five series this season. It's the first time the C's have been the home team; they're 6-6 in 12 games against the Hops at Ron Tonkin Field in 2021. The Canadians took four of six in their first meeting May 18-23 before the Diamondbacks affiliate did the same July 13-18. These two teams are evenly matched; the C's have outscored the Hops 59-55 so far.

HOME AWAY FROM HOME: Due to pandemic-related border closures, Ron Tonkin Field in Hillsboro will serve as Vancouver's home ballpark this year. 78 of 120 C's game will take place in the Tualatin Valley over the course of the season (60 home games, 18 as the visitors).

ON THIS DATE IN CANADIANS BASEBALL HISTORY: August 4, 2012 - The Canadians attacked early and scored seven runs in the first three innings to beat Eugene 8-5 at PK Park. Art Charles hit three doubles and drove in four to lead the offense. Arik Sekula worked the last two innings and kept the Emeralds scoreless to earn the save.

BACK-TO-BACK: Last night was the first time the Canadians have won consecutive games since July 10-13, when they beat Spokane twice to end the series then took down the Hops 3-2 behind Eric Rivera's eighth inning two-out RBI single. That stretch was the last time the C's had won three in a row since June 6-9 between Eugene and Spokane.

THAT WAS QUICK: Yesterday's game lasted two hours and 28 minutes, the fifth-shortest game of the

SAVE ME: Last night was Parker Caracci's eighth save of the season, the most by any pitcher in the High-A West. The Jackson, MS native has converted eight of 11 chances and is responsible for nearly half of Vancouver's 18 saves, tied for the third-most in the league

O-MAZING: Orelvis Martinez - Toronto's #4 prospect - announced his arrival in Advanced-A with a towering home run in the fifth inning last night. It was his 20th homer of the year, 14 of which have come since July 2. The 19-year-old is the youngest player in the league.

ON THE HILL: MLB.com's #6 Blue Jays prospect Adam Kloffenstein climbs the slope for the Canadians tonight looking to recapture some of his early summer success. Between June 30 and July 17, the righty made four starts, logged an ERA of 2.95 in 21.1 innings and K'd 19 while issuing 13 walks. His last turn was on July 29 in Spokane, where he went 4.2 frames and scattered seven hits, surrendered five runs, didn't walk a batter and matched a season high with six strikeouts. This is Kloff's third start against the Hops; he last worked against the baby Snakes on July 17 and posted five and two-thirds innings with two runs (one earned) on a pair of hits with three walks and six punch outs but didn't factor into the decision.

Marcos Tineo takes the ball for Hillsboro in his High-A West debut. He began the year with Low-A Visalia where he went 2-4 with a 5.51 ERA in 16 games (two starts) over 50.2 innings of work. The right-hander K'd 71 and walked 18, a 3.9:1 strikeout-to-walk ratio. Tineo, 24, begins his second tenure with the Hops; he spent all of 2019 in the Northwest League and went 6-4 with a 2.57 ERA, appeared in 15 games (eight starts) and logged 66.2 innings pitched. He racked up 66 strikeouts and walked 19 while limiting opposing hitters to a .245 average.
