YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels beat the Baysox, 10-2. Bowie struck first with a solo homer by Jud Fabian in the second inning. In the second, Logan Wyatt hit a three-run homer to move the Flying Squirrels ahead, 3-1. Richmond scored seven runs in the sixth inning to pull ahead, 10-1. Victor Bericoto and Wyatt hit RBI singles, Ismael Munguia and Will Wilson followed with two-run singles and an additional run scored on an error. Carson Seymour started and picked up his third win of the season, allowing one run with six strikeouts in five innings. Blake Rivera and Mat Olsen combined for three scoreless innings. Bericoto finished the game 3-for-3 with two runs scored. Andy Thomas and Wyatt each had two hits.

TODAY'S GAME: The Richmond Flying Squirrels play the second of a six-game series against the Bowie Baysox, Double-A affliate of the Baltimore Orioles. Richmond won four-of-five in Bowie from April 25-29 and went 3-4 in a series at Prince George's Stadium from June 13-18. The two teams split the most recent series at The Diamond from July 4-9, with the Flying Squirrels taking the first three and the Baysox winning the last three.

**THE FLYING SQUIRRELS** have gone 26-15 in their last 41 games since June 18 They went 2-4 in last week's series at Altoona but have won their last two games. Over the last 46 games since June 14, Richmond starting pitchers have combined for a 3.02ERA (59 ER/175.2 IP) and have allowed 13 home runs. For the year, the Flying Squirrels' 3.81 ERA is third-best in the league. Richmond starters have thrown 377.0 innings, which is the fewest in Double-A. Richmond relievers have thrown 508.2 innings this year, the most in Double-A. The Flying Squirrels bullpen has a 3.58 ERA, which is the third-lowest in Double-A and the ninth-lowest of the 120 full-season teams in the minors.

**THE BAYSUX** went 4-2 in last week's home series against the Sea Dogs after going 1-5 the previous week on the road against the Patriots. Bowie's roster includes six of MLB.com's top-30 Orioles prospects, including SS Jackson Holliday (No. 1), OF Dylan Beavers (No. 10), 3B Max Wagner (No. 12), OF Jud Fabian (No. 15), OF John Rhodes (No. 17), and C Silas Ardoin (No. 28). Holliday is also rated as the No. 1 prospect in baseball.

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander Spencer Bivens makes the third start of his affiliated professional career. He started last Wednesday in Altoona, 45 minutes south of his hometown of State College, Pa., and worked four scoreless innings in a combined shutout. He has made one other start this season, which was on July 6 against the Baysox at The Diamond. In that start, he worked three scoreless innings in a combined shutout. Bivens was born in Virginia Beach but grew up mostly in central Pennsylvania. After high school, he spent two seasons at Louisburg College in North Carolina before transferring to Rogers State in Oklahoma for his final two collegiate seasons. Bivens spent 2019 pitching for Lions de Savigny of French Division 1, an eight-team league in France that plays a 28-game schedule from March through October. He had signed to play for Kotlářka Praha in the Czech Baseball Extraliga before the outbreak of the COVID-19 pandemic in 2020. Bivens was pitching for the Lemont Ducks of the Centre County League in the 2020 summer before joining a four-team, independent pod league in Washington, Pa. After pitching for the independent Washington Wild Things, West Virginia Power and Gastonia Honey Hunters for parts of two seasons, he was signed by the Giants in May 2022. Last fall, he pitched in the Arizona Fall League and was named to the Fall Stars team. For more on Bivens, see page two.

FOR BOWIE: Right-hander Connor Gillispie makes his eighth start of the season and his fifth outing against Richmond. He last pitched last Wednesday against the Sea Dogs in a start and allowed four runs in four innings in a no-decision. Gillispie pitched at The Diamond on July 4 out of the bullpen and surrendered a career-high-tying seven runs over 2.2 innings, including three homers. He worked the finale of that series on July 9 and threw five scoreless innings to pick up a win. Gillispie was a pitcher for the VCU Rams, playing his home games at The Diamond. He was a first-team all-conference pitcher his final season in Richmond in 2019 prior to being drafted by the Orioles that year in the ninth round. Prior to his time at VCU, he attended The Miller School in Charlottesville, where he played for head coach Billy Wagner.

STARTING STRONG: In last week's series, Richmond starting pitchers opened the set throwing 20 innings without allowing a run until the third inning on Saturday night. On Tuesday, Carson Seymour held the Curve scoreless through five innings, allowing one hit with a season-high nine strikeouts. Spencer Bivens threw four scoreless innings, allowing one hit, in his start on Wednesday night. On Thursday, Wil Jensen allowed two hits over four scoreless innings, his third scoreless outing in three starts this season. John Michael Bertrand threw five scoreless innings in his start on Friday night. Hayden Birdsong made his Double-A debut on Saturday and threw two scoreless innings before allowing three runs in the third. Ryan Murphy allowed two runs in his three innings on Sunday afternoon. To open this week's series, Seymour picked up a win, allowing one run over five innings. Richmond starters have a 2.15 ERA (7 ER/29.1 IP) in seven since August 2.

**BERICOTO BASHING:** Over his last six games since August 2, **Victor Bericoto** is batting .375 (9-for-24) with two doubles, a triple and three RBIs. He has multiple hits in four-of-his-last-six games, including five hits in his last two games dating back to Sunday. In Tuesday's series-opener, Bericoto had a Double-A-high three hits, including a double, and drove in a run. On the season, he leads all Giants organization hitters with 18 home runs, including 16 with High-A Eugene and two with Richmond.

ALL ABDARD THE SHANE TRAIN: Shane Matheny has reached base 32 times in his last 13 games since July 25 (16 hits and 16 walks), hitting .372 (16-for-43) with one homer, four doubles, one triple and nine RBIs adding a .533 on-base percentage. On July 30 against the Sea Dogs, he hit a three-run homer and finished the afternoon with four RBIs. He went 4-for-5 with three runs scored last Wednesday night against the Curve. On Friday night, he went 1-for-2 with two walks and he added a hit, a walk and a sac fly on Saturday. He added two doubles and two RBIs in Sunday's game at Altoona. For his Flying Squirrels career, Matheny has worked 124 walks, moving ahead of Ricky Oropesa (112, 2013-16) for second-most in franchise history. He trails Jacob Heyward (2019, '21-22), who had 158 in his career.

FULL MUNGUIA: In his 16 games since returning from the IL, Ismael Munguia is batting .311 (19-for-61) with two doubles, six walks and nine RBIs. He picked up four hits in his three games in his first series back on the road in Akron from July 21-23. He had nine hits and two walks over six games in the last home series against the Sea Dogs. He hit .227 (5-for-22) in last week's series against the Curve but picked up three walks in the Sunday finale. Munguia was placed on the injured list on May 20 and reinstated on July 20, missing 49 games.

**GLOW SHOW:** Over his last 25 games since July 1, **Jimmy Glowenke** is batting .302 (26-for-86) with four homers, seven doubles, 20 RBIs and nine walks. On July 18 at Akron, he closed the game a triple shy of the cycle and went 3-for-6 with a three-run homer, a two-run double and an RBI single, picking up a career-high six RBIs. On July 29 against the Sea Dogs, he hit a lead-off double to start the bottom of the ninth in Richmond's comeback win. He is hitting .353 (6-for-17) in his last five games since August 2 with two doubles, three walks and six RBIs. On Sunday, he went 2-for-4 with a double and four RBIs.

MARTY PARTY: In his last six games since July 30, **Brandon Martorano** is batting .333 (6-for-18) with a double, a triple, two walks and four RBIs. He had five hits and three walks in his four games this week against the Curve. He went 2-for-4 with a walk last Wednesday. On Friday night, he went 1-for-2 with a double. He closed the series on Sunday going 2-for-4 with a double, a triple and three RBIs.

**LOGAN'S LIFTOFF:** On Tuesday night, **Logan Wyatt** drove a three-run, go-ahead homer. It was his 12th-overall home run of the season, which is the seventh-most in the Giants minor leagues. It was also hit first home run since he went deep three times in a five-game stretch from June 23-30, snapping a 26-game homerless drought. Over a 21-game stretch from July 6-August 5, Wyatt hit .156 (10-for-64) with eight walks and four RBIs. In his last two games, he is batting .375 (3-for-8) with a homer and four RBIs.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have seven players ranked in Baseball America's Top-30 Giants prospects, including LHP Carson Whisenhunt (No. 4 - on IL), OF Vaun Brown (No. 5), RHP Carson Seymour (No. 13), RHP Landen Roupp (No. 14 - on IL), RHP Hayden Birdsong (No. 16), RHP Ryan Murphy (No. 24) and RHP Jose Cruz (No. 26). Baseball America rates Brown as the organization's best hitter for average and best athlete, rates Roupp as having the best curveball and Cruz as having the best changeup. MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospect list includes seven Richmond players, including Whisenhunt (No. 3), Brown (No. 5), Roupp (No. 10), Seymour (No. 14), Murphy (No. 23), Birdsong (No. 25) and Cruz (No. 26).

# THIS DATE IN SOUIRRELS HISTORY

In 2010, the Flying Squirrels beat the Portland Sea Dogs, 16-8. Richmond took a 1-0 lead in the first with a sac fly by Brandon Belt, but Portland answered with two runs in the bottom of the inning. Over the middle three innings, Richmond score 15 unanswered runs to pull away. Sharlon Schoop went 4-for-5 with a three-run homer and totaled six RBIs, which was a single-game team record at the time. Darren Ford also had four hits. Nick Noonan hit a three-run homer.

# IN OTHER WORDS...

Pitcher **Spencer Bivens** on his scoreless start last Wednesday at Altoona and playing close to home:

"I never got to play (there) growing up. I coached (there), but that was my only experience actually on the field. To get cross that off the bucket list, that was pretty cool. ... I had my mom, her side of the family and a bunch of friends here. One of my friends came straight from work in his landscaping stuff, all dirty. It was really cool. Special. ...
