**LAST TIME OUT:** The Cyclones dropped their second-straight affair, 7-6, on Sunday afternoon vs. Aberdeen...Brooklyn carried a 6-2 lead into the eighth inning, but the IronBirds scored one in the eighth and four in the ninth to win it...LF **Chris Suero** posted the first multi-home run game of his career, blasting two-run homers in the fourth and sixth innings...SS **Wilfredo Lara**, CF **Nick Morabito**, and 2B **Junior Tilién** each collected multi-hit games...Tilién clocked a solo home run in the fifth inning...C **Francisco Alvarez** went 0-for-5 while batting second and serving as catcher in his third Major League rehab game of the week...RHP **Edwin Díaz**, walking and striking out one, faced the minimum in a scoreless fifth inning...

**CROWN CONSUEGRA!** In a win at Jersey Shore on May 29, OF **Stanley Consuegra's** RBI double in the fourth inning made him the new Cyclones' all-time hits leader (178), breaking a tie with OF **Alex Ramírez**...Last Saturday, Consuegra's one-out double in the ninth inning broke his tie with Ramírez for the franchise record in doubles (39)...The 23-year-old is atop the Cyclones' ranks in numerous other offensive categories as well, including extra-base hits (80), home runs (35), and RBI (119)...On the final day of the 2023 regular season, he broke a tie with C **Francisco Alvarez** for Brooklyn's single-season home run record (23)...The Dominican native also broke the franchise's single-season record for extra-base hits (42) and tied the mark for RBI (63) set by **Ronny Mauricio** in 2021.

**SUPER STANLEY:** OF **Stanley Consuegra** is also in the midst of his best offensive stretch of the season...Consuegra is on an 11-game on-base streak and has a hit in 17 of his last 19 games since May 17 at Bowling Green...During that time, he's hitting .333/.440/.696 with a 1.136 OPS...The Dominican native has scored 12 runs and added seven doubles, six home runs, and 18 RBI...Consuegra has raised his batting average by 65 points (.171 to .236) and his OPS by 247 points (.519 to .766) during the stretch...Since that date, the 23-year-old leads the South Atlantic League in slugging (.696) and OPS (1.136) and is tied for first in home runs (6).

**MARVELOUS MORABITO:** OF **Nick Morabito** has been as good as any offensive player in Minor League Baseball in 2024...Morabito is sixth in Minor League Baseball in on-base percentage (.459)...He is also tied for 11th in stolen bases (26) and batting average (.341)...Since making his South Atlantic League debut on May 7, the former second-round pick is third in the league lead in steals (15), fifth in runs scored (23), and ninth in on-base percentage (.402).

**FETTUCINE WILFREDO:** INF **Wilfredo Lara** has been scorching hot for the Cyclones since May 19...The 20-year-old has appeared in 18 games and tallied a .344/.446/.541 line with a .987 OPS...Lara has scored 15 runs and added two doubles, two triples, two home runs, 10 RBI, and nine walks...In that time, the Dominican native is tied for fifth in runs scored (15) and ninth in batting average (.344) and on-base percentage (.446)...Lara is also riding a 12-game on-base streak since May 26 vs. Hudson Valley...He is hitting .385/.519/.564 with a 1.083 OPS during the stretch.

**JUNIOR MINTS:** INF **Junior Tilién** enters play with the longest active on-base streak in the South Atlantic League, reaching in 19 consecutive games since Game 1 of a doubleheader on May 17 at Bowling Green...The 21-year-old has accumulated a .310/.400/.465 slash line with a .865 OPS during the streak, adding three doubles, a triple, two home runs, and 10 RBI...Tilién has also posted a 10-game hitting streak since May 26 vs. Hudson Valley...He is hitting .375/.409/.550 with a .959 OPS in that time.

**SUERO SUAVE:** C **Chris Suero** has started to find his rhythm offensively in the South Atlantic League...The 20-year-old capped last week's series vs. Aberdeen with his first career multi-home run game, blasting two-run shots in the fourth and sixth innings...In five games against the IronBirds, Suero was 7-for-16 (.438) at the dish with seven runs scored, a double, three home runs, and an eye-popping 11 RBI...Since May 17 at Bowling Green, Suero has reached safely in 15 of 16 games, hitting .321/.471/.566 with a 1.037 OPS...The Bronx native has scored a whopping 17 runs with a double, four home runs, and 16 RBI...Since that date, Suero is fourth in the SAL in on-base percentage (.471), tied for fourth in runs scored (17), sixth in OPS (1.037), tied for sixth in walks (14), seventh in RBI (16), and eighth in slugging (.566).

**JOLTIN' JEFREY:** IF/OF **Jeffrey De Los Santos** has been an extra-base machine in recent games...The 20-year-old has accrued a six-game hitting streak since the beginning of June and has tallied multiple knocks in five of his last eight games...Since May 30 at Jersey Shore, De Los Santos is hitting .394/.444/.879 with a 1.323 OPS, seven runs scored, three doubles, two triples, three home runs, and six RBI...During the six-game hit streak, the left-handed swinger is batting .440 (11-25) with six extra-base hits, a .920 slugging percentage, and a 1.401 OPS...In June, De Los Santos is second in the circuit in slugging (.920) and OPS (1.401) and third in batting average (.440).

**YOU'LL GET NOTHING AND LIKE IT:** RHPs **Dakota Hawkins** (5.0 IP), **Joey Lancellotti** (1.0), and **Joshua Cornielly** (3.0) combined on the first nine-inning no-hitter in Brooklyn Cyclones history in Tuesday's 3-0 win vs. Aberdeen...

**vs. HUDSON VALLEY:** Brooklyn hits the road for the final six-game series of the season's first half against the Yankees' High-A affiliate... Hudson Valley possesses five of New York's top 30 prospects per MLB Pipeline: LHP **Kyle Carr** (11), INF **Roc Riggio** (18), INF **Jared Serna** (19), INF **Tyler Hardman** (25), and OF **Jace Avina** (28)...The Cyclones captured the first meeting at Maimonides Park, winning 4-of-6...In 2023, Brooklyn went 6-6 against Hudson Valley on Coney Island and 8-4 at Heritage Financial Park...Dating back to 2001, Brooklyn trails the all-time series, 144-146 (.497).

The only previous no-hitter came on August 23, 2009, when RHP **Brandon Moore** tossed a seven-inning no-no in a 5-0 win during Game 1 of a doubleheader at Aberdeen...It is just the third no-hitter in Minor League Baseball in 2024...LHP **Chayce McDermott**, RHP **Nolan Hoffman**, and RHP **Kaleb Ort** combined on a 2-0 no-hitter for Baltimore's Triple-A Norfolk on May 3 vs. Nashville...RHP **Dylan Cumming**, RHP **Nick Sinacola**, and LHP **Seth Corry** of San Francisco's High-A Eugene combined on a 4-0 no-no on April 17 vs. Vancouver...Tuesday's effort was the first no-hitter by a Mets minor league affiliate since RHP **Joander Suárez** hurled a seven-inning one on September 7 at Hartford...It was also the first nine-inning no-hitter thrown in the borough of Brooklyn since RHP **Sal Maglie** tossed a no-no for the Dodgers against the Philadelphia Phillies on September 25, 1956, at Ebbets Field.

**NECK AND NECK DOWN THE STRETCH:** Including Tuesday, nine games remain in the First Half of the South Atlantic League season...The Cyclones are in third place...They are 2.0 games back of Jersey Shore for first in the North Division and 1.5 games behind second place Greensboro...

**GET YOUR OFFENSE HERE!** In back-to-back games on SNY, the Brooklyn Cyclones erupted for a season-high-tying 13 runs and 14 hits in Thursday's 13-3 win vs. Aberdeen and followed it up with 13 more runs and a season-best 18 hits in a 13-7 win on Friday...The 13 runs were the most for the Cyclones since a 13-3 win vs. Wilmington on April 24...The 14 knocks were also the most for Brooklyn since a 14-hit outing in a 9-7 win at Jersey Shore on April 20...Friday's 18-hit effort was the best for Brooklyn since they accumulated 18 knocks in an 8-7 win at Hudson Valley on July 21, 2023...The 18 hits were the most for the Cyclones at Maimonides Park in almost 13 years...Brooklyn racked up 20 hits, also against Aberdeen, in a 13-0 rout on July 21, 2011...Friday marked the first time the 'Clones accrued 13+ runs and 18+ hits in the same game since scoring a franchise-record 20 runs in a 20-6 win at Bowling Green on May 27, 2022...It was the first time Brooklyn accomplished those numbers at Maimonides Park that 13-0 win vs. Aberdeen on July 21, 2011.

**SHUT OUT THE LIGHTS:** The Cyclones' pitching staff earned its seventh shut-out victory in Tuesday's 3-0 no-hit win vs. Aberdeen...On Sunday, Brooklyn earned its sixth of the season in a 7-0 triumph at Jersey Shore...The Cyclones had a season-high 23.2 consecutive scoreless innings since two out in the fifth inning on Saturday snapped on 3B **Mac Horvath's** one-out RBI single in the third inning on Wednesday...The Cyclones have shut out opponents in back-to-back games twice in 2024...Brooklyn's blanking of the BlueClaws on Sunday marked the team's first shutout since May 4's 4-0 and May 3's 2-0 wins vs. Aberdeen...The seven shutouts are tied for the second-most in the South Atlantic League and tied for the fourth-most in Minor League Baseball...In 2023, the Cyclones set a franchise record with 11 shutouts.

**ATOP THE HEJ-ES:** RHP **Josh Hejka** earned his first save of the season on May 5 vs. Aberdeen, making his Cyclones' franchise-record-setting 48th pitching appearance in the process...The 27-year-old broke a tie with **Hunter Parsons** (47) for the most pitching appearances in Cyclones franchise history...In his 58 career outings for Brooklyn since 2019, Hejka has accumulated a 5-2 record with a 2.48 ERA (26 ER in 94.1 IP) and 6 saves, walking just 22 and striking out 83.

**AMAZIN' STARTS HERE:** The Brooklyn Cyclones have several Top 30 prospects according to *Baseball America* and MLB Pipeline...The 'Clones have three of the Top 30 per BA: **Kade Morris** (21), **Jonah Tong** (22) and **Calvin Ziegler** (29)...Ziegler is currently on the full-season injured list...Plus four of the Top 30 per MLB: Tong (20), Ziegler (23), **Wilfredo Lara** (24), and OF **Nick Morabito** (26).

**LAST TIME OUT:** Suffered his second defeat with Brooklyn, and third overall in 2024, last Wednesday afternoon vs. Aberdeen...Yielded two runs on five hits over 3.2 innings...Walked one and struck out two...Plunked a batter...Tossed a season-high 65 pitches and 45 strikes (69.23%)...Relieved by LHP **Julian Smith** with runners at second and third and two out in the top of the fourth with Brooklyn trailing 2-0...Both bequeathed runners were stranded...Cyclones were ultimately shut out by the IronBirds, 4-0.

**2024:** Joined the Cyclones from Single-A St. Lucie on May 14... Posted a 1-1 record with a 2.81 ERA (5 ER in 16.0 IP), 10 walks, and 16 strikeouts in eight relief appearances for the Mets...Earned the win out of the bullpen on Opening Day, April 5 vs. Daytona, striking out a season-best six over three frames...Among Florida State League relievers with 16.0+ innings pitched at the time of his promotion, Ramirez was sixth in batting average against (.182) and opposing OPS (.573).

**THE WHOLE NINE YARDS:** Ramirez's Cyclones debut was one to remember...The 22-year-old was the only Brooklyn pitcher in 2023 to work into the ninth inning, ultimately tossing a career-high 8.0 innings of three-run ball...Ramirez allowed six hits, did not walk a batter, and struck out four...The Dominican native was the first Brooklyn pitcher to complete eight-full innings and work into the 9th since RHP **Conner Grey** carried a no-hit bid into the 9th inning vs. Jersey Shore on July 16, 2021...Grey ultimately tossed 8.1 innings that day...No Cyclone pitcher has tossed a nine-inning complete game since RHP **John Gant** posted a one-hit shutout on August 28, 2013, at Maimonides Park vs. Tri-City.

**2023:** Ramirez split the season between Single-A St. Lucie and Brooklyn...In 18 appearances (six starts) in the Florida State League, he registered a 4-8 record with a 4.91 ERA (42 ER in 77.0 IP)...Issued 23 walks and struck out 61...Thrived in a starting role, tallying a 2-2 record with a 2.89 ERA (9 ER in 28.0 IP) with six walks and 11 strikeouts in six starts...In 12 appearances out of the bullpen, Ramirez composed a 2-6 record with a 6.06 ERA (33 ER in 49.0 IP), 17 walks, and 50 strikeouts...Joined Brooklyn from Single-A St. Lucie on July 31...Made six starts down the stretch, collecting a 1-1 record with a 5.52 ERA (18 ER in 29.1 IP).

**2022:** Started the campaign with the Florida Complex League Mets...Named FCL Pitcher of the Year and a FCL Post-Season All-Star...Composed a 1-0 record with a 0.84 ERA (4 ER in 43.0 IP), one save, six walks (3.8 BB%), and 40 strikeouts (25.3 K%) in 11 appearances (six starts)...Transferred to Single-A St. Lucie on September 1...Made two relief appearances and accrued a 1-0 record...Did not allow a run on two hits over 3.1 innings, striking out three and walking four.
