LAST TIME OUT: The Cyclones dropped their second-straight affair, 7-6, on Sunday afternoon vs. Aberdeen...Brooklyn carried a 6-2 lead into the eighth inning, but the IronBirds scored one in the eighth and four in the ninth to win it...LF Chris Suero posted the first multi-home run game of his career, blasting two rabito, and 2B Junior Tilien each collected multi-hit games...Tilien clocked a solo home run in the fifth inning...C Francisco Alvarez went O-for-5 while batting second and serving as catcher in his third Major League rehab game of the week...RHP Edwin Díaz, walking and striking out one, faced the minimum in a scoreless fifth inning..
CROWN CONSUEGRA!: In a win at Jersey Shore on May 29, OF Stanley Consuegra's RBI double in the fourth inning made him the new Cyclones' all-time hits leader (178), breaking a tie with OF Alex Ramírez...Last Saturday, Con suegra's one-out double in the ninth inning broke his tie with Ramírez for the franchise record in doubles (39)...The 23-year-old is atop the Cyclones' ranks home runs (35), and RBI (119)...On the final day of the 2023 regular season, he home runs (35), and RBI (i9)...On the final day of the 2023 regular season, he
broke a tie with C Francisco Alvarez for Brooklyn's single-season home run record (23)...The Dominican native also broke the franchise's single-season record for extra-base hits (42) and tied the mark for RBI (63) set by Ronny Mauricio in 2021.
SUPER STANLEY: OF Stanley Consuegra is also in the midst of his best of fensive stretch of the season...Consuegra is on an 11-game on-base streak and has a hit in 17 of his last 19 games since May 17 at Bowling Green...During that time, he's hitting .333/.440/.696 with a 1.136 OPS...The Dominican native has scored 12 runs and added seven doubles, six home runs, and 18 RBI...Consuegra has raised his batting average by 65 points (. 171 to .236 ) and his OPS by 247

2024: Joined the Cyclones from Single-A St. Lucie on May 14... Posted a $1-1$ record with a 2.81 ERA ( 5 ER in 16.0 IP), 10 walks, and 16 strikeouts in eight relief appearances for the Mets...Earned the win out of the bullpen on Opening Day, April 5 vs. Daytona, striking out a season-best six over three frames...Among Florida State League relievers with $16.0+$ innings pitched at the time of his promotion, Ramírez was sixth in batting average against (.182) and opposing OPS (.573).

THE WHOLE NINE YARDS: Ramírez's Cyclones debut was one to remember...The 22-year-old was the only Brooklyn pitcher in 2023 to work into the ninth inning, ultimately tossing a career-high 8.0 innings of three-run ball...Ramírez allowed six hits, did not walk a batter, and struck out four...The Dominican native was the first Brooklyn pitcher to complete eight-full innings and work into the 9th since RHP Conner Grey carried a no-hit bid into the 9th inning vs. Jersey Shore on July 16, 2021...Grey ultimately tossed 8.1 innings that day...No Cyclone pitcher has tossed a nine-inning complete game since RHP John Gant posted a one-hit shutout on August 28, 2013, at Maimonides Park vs. Tri-City.

2023: Ramírez split the season between Single-A St. Lucie and Brooklyn...In 18 appearances (six starts) in the Florida State League, he registered a 4-8 record with a 4.91 ERA (42 ER in 77.0 IP)...Issued 23 walks and struck out 61...Thrived in a starting role, tallying a 2-2 record with a 2.89 ERA (9 ER in 28.0 IP) with six walks and 11 strikeouts in six starts...In 12 appearances out of the bullpen, Ramírez composed a 2-6 record with a 6.06 ERA ( 33 ER in 49.0 IP), 17 walks, and 50 strikeouts...
