### Falling on Wednesday Night

Leading Off

The Fightin Phils dropped their second-straight game on Wednesday with a 6-3 loss to Akron. The RubberDucks scored three in the third and one in the fourth to jump up 4-0. Reading got two back in the bottom of the sixth, thanks to a two-run double from Carson Taylor. It broke up Austin Peterson's no-hitter bid. Akron got insurance runs in the seventh and eighth to make it 6-2. Robert Moore then hit an opposite-field homer in the eighth to make it 6-3, but Reading could not score any more from there.

The Fightin Phils continue a six-game series tonight against the Akron RubberDucks, Double-A affiliate of the Cleveland Guardians. It is the third-of-12 matchups between the teams this season and third-of-six in Reading. The teams did not face off in 2023, as the last time Reading and Akron played was in Akron from

Apr. 12-16, 2022. This is the first time the RubberDucks are in Baseballtown since Aug. 10-15, 2021. Akron leads the season series 2-0.

#### Jean Kabrera

Jean Cabrera gets the start on the mound tonight in his long-awaited Double-A debut. Cabrera was called up on Tuesday, along with Sam Aldegheri, from High-A Jersey Shore. Cabrera most recently won South Atlantic League Pitcher of the Week on Monday, after going six no-hit innings, with 10 strikeouts on July 4 against Wilmington. Cabrera has 91 strikeouts this season through 77 innings, which includes three games over 10 punchouts. Featured was a 14-strikeout out game on June 12 against Wilmington. Cabrera held the following South Atlantic League Ranks: 4th ERA (3.39), T-2nd SO (91), 2nd IP (77.0), 5th BAA (.210), 4th WHIP (1.09) and 6th SO/9 (10.64).

#### Welcome to the Bakeshow

Andrew Baker struck out the side in a scoreless inning in the top of the ninth inning on Wednesday night. Since returning from High-A Jersey Shore, Baker has appeared in three games, with a 2.25 ERA over four innings and five strikeouts to no walks. After a tough start to the season, Baker was transferred to Jersey Shore on May 7 and was excellent with the BlueClaws. Over 16 games, Baker had a 1.59 ERA with Jersey Shore, while striking out 30 and walking eight.

#### Bombs Away

Sine June 1, the Fightin Phils lead the Eastern League in home runs hit at 44. That recent surge has propelled the Fightin Phils to second in the Eastern League in home runs with 86. They trail Somerset by eight and are ahead of third-place Erie by nine. That stretch featured a team-best home runs in 13-straight games from June 13-28, which tied a mark set by the 2016 Fightin Phils. Currently, Reading has homed in six-straight games, dating back to July 3.

#### Phillips is a Phillie

Former Fightin Phil Tyler Phillips made his big-league debut on Sunday. Phillips was impressive, as the righty went four innings, allowing three hits, one run, no walks and seven strikeouts. His seven strikeouts were the most by a Phillie in their Major League debut since Cole Hamels had seven strikeouts in his debut on May 12, 2006, at Cincinnati. His seven strikeouts in relief also broke a 123-year old record of most relief strikeouts in a Phillies Major League debut.

#### Hey Now, You're an All-Star

Two former Fightin Phils were named All-Star representatives of the Phillies last week. Ranger Suarez (2018) and Alec Bohm (2019) will both represent the Phillies in the midsummer classic next week in Arlington, Texas.

#### This Day in Baseballtown History

July 11, 2012: At Reading, the Baseballtown All-Star Home Run Derby creates a national buzz with crazy targets, a cocktail party on the infield and a 2-minute clock for each hitter. A crowd of 9,055 watches Richmond's Daniel Mayora sock an event-high 10 home runs.

#### Akron's In Town

Akron enters tonight after finishing in third place in the Eastern League's Southwest Division for the first half with a 37-32 record. They are first in the Southwest Division with an 11-3 record in the second half of the season. Akron most recently took four-of-six in their split series with Erie. Following this week, Akron hosts Richmond in their first series after the break. Akron's roster features six players ranked amongst the Cleveland Guardians' top-30 prospects: Chase DeLauter (1), Kahlil Watson (14), Peter Halpin (15), Parker Messick (21), CJ Kayfus (27) and Dayan Frias (28).

#### Duck on the Bump

Lefty, and Guardians No. 21 Prospect, Parker Messick makes the start tonight for Akron. Between Lake County and Akron this season, Messick is 6-6, with a 3.59 ERA over 16 starts (80.1 IP, 74 H, 29 BB, 100 SO). He was promoted from High-A on June 22 and has made three starts with Akron thus far. He took the loss on July 4 at Erie, allowing five runs on six hits over 2.2 innings, with two walks and six strikeouts. Messick split 2023 between Single-A Lynchburg and Lake County in his first pro season, going 5-6, with a 3.77 ERA over 26 games and 24 starts. Cleveland drafted Messick in the second round in 2022 out of Florida St.
