LAST GAME

A relatively quiet night interrupted by one half inning, the Bowie Baysox fell to the Altoona Curve on Tuesday night at Peoples Natural Gas Field in Altoona. After trading scoreless innings over the first half of the contest, Altoona exploded for six runs in the fifth inning, and rode that frame to a 6-1 final. Both Chayce McDermott for Bowie and Kyle Nicolas for Altoona tossed up four scoreless frames to open the night. McDermott (L, 1-1) only dealt with two runners in scoring position over those first four innings, but he struck out five batters in the span. Nicolas (W, 1-1) only struck out two batters over five scoreless innings, but he did not allow a single runner past first base. With two runners on base and one out in the fifth inning, Bowie dipped in to their bullpen for Xavier Moore, but the right-hander allowed both inherited runners to score on base hits, before loading the bases and allowing a grand slam to Matt Gorski. The six-run explosion dwarfed Bowie's offensive attempts on the night, but it did not keep Coby Mayo from blasting his second home run of the season, a solo shot in the sixth.

TODAY'S OPPONENT

The Altoona Curve are off to a 3-6 start and currently bottom of the Southwest division, albeit only two games out of first place. The Double-A affiliate of the Pittsburgh Pirates, Altoona currently roster six of the organization's top-30 prospects, via MLB Pipeline. Headlining the roster is C Henry Davis (No. 3 PIT/ No. 57 overall), who is hitting .226 entering the series with a pair of home runs, six runs batted in and an OBP of .385. Other top prospects include INF Liover Peguero (No. 6 PIT), RHPs Jared Jones (No. 11 PIT) and Kyle Nicolas (No. 20 PIT), along with OF Matt Gorski (No. 17 PIT) and Matt Frazier (No. 23 PIT). Notable standouts through the first nine games include Frazier, who's hitting a team-high .313 and slugging a team-best .594. His 10 hits and five extra-base hits are both fourth-most in the Eastern League. As a team, the Curve enter the series tied atop the Eastern League with 12 home runs and second with a .730 OPS. However, Altoona also enters tied for the most errors in the league with 13, along with the second-worst team fielding percentage at .960. The Curve are led by first-year manager Callix Crabbe, who managed in the Pirates' system in High-A Greensboro last season.

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

The Curve project to start right-hander Justin Meis. A 10th round selection by the Pirates back in 2021 out of Eastern Michigan University, Meis already has two starts in what is his debut season in Double-A. So far, he's allowed seven runs, five of which are earned, across seven innings. Meis has pitched to a lot of contact, with nine hits surrendered already on the season and opponents hitting .300 against him in the limited sample size in 2023. Meis last pitched in Erie on Thursday, where he allowed four of his earned runs on five hits across four innings. He was much more effective last season between High-A Greensboro and Single-A Bradenton, where he combined to be fourth in the Pirates' system in innings (114), starts (23) and strikeouts (116), while maintaining an impressive 4.11 ERA and .226 opposing average. Meis has an arsenal which consists of a mid-90s fastball, low-80s curveball and slider, alongside a mid-80s changeup.

HAIL CÉSAR

INF César Prieto has had a phenomenal start at the plate to begin the 2023 season. Prieto leads the Eastern League with 15 hits. Last night's first inning single extended his hitting streak to nine games – a new career-best at the Double-A level. That streak is also the longest across the Eastern League thus far in 2023. Prieto had an 8-game hitting streak for Bowie last season that spanned from 5/28-6/7, including a 8-for-22 (.364) series in Altoona. Prieto's longest hit-streak in Minor League Baseball is 12 games, with 10 of those contests coming at the High-A level with Aberdeen before he was initially called up to Bowie on 5/24/22 for the final two games of that streak.

THE RHODE LESS TRAVELED

The production of OF John Rhodes has somewhat flown under the radar for a Baysox team struggling offensively early in 2023. Bowie is hitting just .161 with runners in scoring position. Rhodes himself is hitting .267 in such scenarios, and his four hits with runners in scoring position are more than any other Baysox player. His 10 RBI leads the Eastern League, and already surpasses his total from last season (25 games). In total, six of Rhodes' eight hits on the season have plated runs for the Baysox. His refined plate approach at Double-A goes beyond his clutch hitting, as his on-base percentage has also climbed 76 points from 2022.

COACHING STAFF

Manager - Kyle Moore

2023 will be Kyle Moore's second season as the manager of the Baysox, and his 14th within the Orioles' organization. After leading Bowie to a division-best 41-28 through the back half of last season, Moore continues to display consistency at the helm of recent successful teams throughout the Orioles system. Moore led Class-A Delmarva to a minor league-best 90 wins as manager in 2019. The Shorebirds were named MiLB.com's Team of the Year and Moore won South Atlantic Manager of the Year honors. Moore's career managerial record sits at 254-216 (.540) entering the 2023 season. Prior to his managerial career, Moore also spent three seasons as a player/coach in the Orioles system (2013 Frederick Keys, 2014 Bowie Baysox, 2015 Delmarva Shorebirds). He then took a position as the Shorebirds hitting coach in 2016, before joining the Keys in the same role in 2017. Moore played collegiately at Alabama, before signing with Baltimore as an undrafted free agent in 2010. He currently resides in Sarasota alongside his wife Whitney, and his two daughters, Madilyn and Cameron.

Hitting Coach - Sherman Johnson

Sherman Johnson makes his coaching debut, as he joins the Baysox staff as the hitting coach in 2023. Johnson had a brief stint in the major leagues with the Los Angeles Angels back in 2018 and spent parts of nine minor league seasons across the Angels, Reds and Minnesota Twins organizations. Johnson's playing career most recently landed him in independent ball this past season with the Kane County Cougars. Johnson also played two seasons collegiately at Florida State.

Pitching Coach - Forrest Herrmann

Forrest Herrmann joins the Bowie Baysox coaching staff in his second season with the Orioles organization. He served as the pitching coach of the Aberdeen IronBirds during the 2022 season, helping Aberdeen clinch a first-half division title and make it all the way to game three of the South Atlantic League Championship Series. Herrmann guided one of the best staffs in the SAL last season, which led the league in strikeouts. Prior to joining the Orioles organization, Herrmann spent two seasons as a pitching coach within the Cincinnati Reds organization. Herrmann also served as a pitching strategist in 2019 for the Seattle Mariners organization at their facility in Peoria. Herrmann also worked with current Orioles' left-hander John Means at P3 Premier Pitching Performance center in Missouri. He pitched for three seasons at the University of Evansville prior to his coaching career.

Fundamentals Coach - Tim DeJohn

Tim DeJohn returns to the Baysox in 2023 for a second season as Fundamentals coach. However, DeJohn also received a promotion this season and will also serve as the Minor League Infield Coordinator at all levels. DeJohn has been a part of the Orioles' staff since November 2019. Prior to joining the organization, DeJohn had an extensive background in the college ranks. He served as an assistant coach at the University of Memphis between 2017 and 2019 and was an assistant at the University of Hartford the two seasons prior. DeJohn played at Western Connecticut State from 2003-2008.

Development Coach - Ryan Goll

Ryan Goll, much like pitching coach Forrest Herrmann, is making a jump from High-A in 2023. Goll serves as the Baysox development coach for his first season in Bowie, after filling the same role for Aberdeen last season. Goll has also been promoted to Offseason Camp Coordinator entering 2023. Goll first served as a Player Development Intern for the Orioles organization in 2020, before joining the minor league staff full-time in 2021. Goll attended the University of Minnesota, where he began as a bullpen catcher and Head Student Manager from 2015-2018, before moving on to be a Student Undergraduate Assistant Coach in September of 2018.
