The Chesapeake Baysox dropped their second in a row to Richmond by final of 3-2 on Saturday night. Starter Trace Bright pitched 2.2 innings and gave up two runs (one earned) on two hits and two walks. Ryan Long threw six innings of one-run ball in relief with six strikeouts. Jalen Vasquez tripled home Chesapeake's first run and Doug Hodo went 2-for-3, including a broken bat RBI single in the eighth.

#### **HEY NOW, YOU'RE AN ALL-STAR**

OF Enrique Bradfield Jr. and RHP Keagan Gillies were both selected by MLB to participate in the 2025 MLB All-Star Futures Game in Atlanta on Saturday, July 12. Bradfield and Gillies are the 15th and 16th Baysox players and the first duo in franchise history to be selected to baseball's top prospect showcase. Bradfield, the Orioles No. 2 prospect, stole the second-most bases last season (74) and won an MiLB Rawlings Gold Glove in the outfield. Gillies held a 1.15 ERA in 31.1 innings pitched out of the bullpen before earning promotion to Triple-A Norfolk on Wednesday.

#### CREED CRUSHES

YESTERDAY'S RECAP

C **Creed Willems** has been one of the best performers in the Orioles system this year. Amongst O's minor leaguers, the Orioles No. 11 prospect is tied for third in extra base hits (24), third in doubles (15), tied for sixth in home runs (8) and seventh in total bases (98) and RBI (31). Willems has three multi-hit games in his last four played.

#### REED CAN RAKE

OF Reed Trimble is batting .302 (13-for-43) over his last 11 games and has collected a hit in five of his last six contests. Trimble is also on a 12-game on-base streak, which is the longest active streak on the team.

Chesapeake has won just 11 games at home this season, which is tied for the fewest in all of Minor League Baseball along with High-A Dayton. The Baysox have dropped 16 of their last 20 home games since May 27. The last time the Baysox finished a season at least 10 games below .500 at home was in 2016 (30-41).

#### **CLOSE GAMES AND FREE BASEBALL**

Chesapeake has won 18 one-run games this season - which is the most in the Eastern League. The Baysox have played 32 one-run games this season, which is the most in all of Double-A. Chesapeake has won nine extra-inning games this season, which is the second-most amongst full-season MiLB clubs (Quad Cities - High-A KC).

#### **BULLPEN BEASTS**

Chesapeake's bullpen holds a 3.06 ERA, which is fourth-best in Double-A and tied for sixth-best in full-season MiLB. Baysox relievers have punched out 395 hitters, which is fourth-most in Double-A and the most in the Eastern League.

#### SIZING UP THE SQUIRRELS

The Richmond Flying Squirrels - Double-A affiliate of the San Francisco Giants - finished the first half with a 21-46 record, which was last in the league. Richmond started the second half with a home series loss to Reading. Richmond's roster includes five of the Giants' top 30 prospects, per MLB.com - LHP Joe Whitman (No. 6), IF Diego Velasquez (No. 15), IF Aeverson Arteaga (No. 16), IF Sabin Ceballos (No. 23) and LHP Jack Choate (No. 27)

## **TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER**

LHP Jack Choate makes his 16th start of the season for the Flying Squirrels. The Giants No. 27 prospect pitched on Tuesday against Chesapeake and threw three innings of one-run ball with four strikeouts in an outing interrupted early due to rain. Choate has had two of his last three starts end prematurely due to weather. The 24-year-old is tied for seventh in the Giants system and tied for ninth in the Eastern League in strikeouts (71).

2025: Threw 2.0 shutout innings with 2 K in most recent start on 7/1 @ RIC which ended early due to rain. Finished month of June with a 2.49 ERA (8th-best in EL), a 0.74 WHIP (2nd-best in EL) and a .135 BAA. Named EL Pitcher of the Week for 6/10-6/15 after 6.0 shutout, one-hit innings and 6 K on 6/13 vs HBG. First Baysox player this season to be named EL Player/Pitcher of the Week. Threw 11.2 consecutive scoreless innings to start month of June. Baysox are 3-5 when he starts. Pitched 5.2 shutout innings and struck out six in Double-A debut on 5/16 vs AKR. Promoted to Double-A Chesapeake on 5/13. Started season in High-A Aberdeen. Made six starts and posted a 3.60 ERA with 37 K over 25 innings pitched over 10 walks allowed. Struck out seven batters in each of his final three starts with IronBirds before earning promotion. At time of promotion, was tied for 10th in South Atlantic League in strikeouts.

2024: Spent first season in Minors between Single-A Delmarva as a starter and High-A Aberdeen as a tandem reliever. Struck out 90 batters in 73.2 innings to a 1.59 ERA. Began season in Delmarva. Recorded a 1.49 ERA in 48.1 IP with 57 K. Missed a month of season from 5/15-6/14 due to injury. Promoted to Aberdeen on 8/1. In seven outings, posted a 1.78 ERA in 25.1 innings with 33 strikeouts over just three walks. Excelled at home: 0.69 ERA in 11 home outings.

# **ALTERNATE IDENTITIES**

#### CHESAPEAKE OYSTER CATCHERS



For select home games, the Chesapeake Baysox will take the field as the Chesapeake Oyster Catchers as a tribute to the Chesapeake Bay's rich heritage and thriving ecosystem.

Inspired by the American oystercatcher, the prominent patterned shorebird can be found along the Chesapeake Bay year-round. With its bold black-and-white plumage, orange beak, and knack for hunting shellfish, the oystercatcher is a symbol of strength and ingenuity—qualities that define both the Chesapeake region and its passionate baseball fans.

The Oyster Catchers name also pays homage to the Chesapeake Bay's rich maritime traditions and oyster restoration efforts, celebrating the region's deep connection to its waters.

#### **CANGREJOS FANTASMAS DE CHESAPEAKE**



The Cangrejos Fantasmas De Chesapeake (Chesapeake Ghost Crabs) are a part of MiLB's "Copa de la Diversión<sup>TM</sup>" or "Fun Cup<sup>TM</sup>"- a season-long event series specifically designed to embrace the culture and values that resonate most with Minor League Baseball<sup>TM</sup> teams' local U.S. Hispanic communities.

Boasting a desire to better represent the Chesapeake Bay area, Bowie's "Cangrejos Fantasmas de Chesapeake" identiy came to light after research presented the existence of the small, yet active Atlantic Ghost Crab species in the bay.

#### **BOWIE PIT BEEF**



The "Bowie Pit Beef" is an alternate identity of the Chesapeake Baysox that pays tribute to the culinary culture of Maryland.



Pit Beef consists of top round cuts of beef, thinly sliced and prepared over a charcoal fire. The meat is cooked quickly at high temperatures and has a slight smoked flavor. The sandwich got its name on Baltimore's east side in the 1970s, before being popularized by the 1980s.
