**LAST TIME OUT:** Brooklyn snared their 2nd-straight victory with a 6-1 triumph over Hudson Valley on Thursday night...LF **Alex Ramírez** roped an RBI double and CF **Jaylen Palmer** tallied a sacrifice fly in the 1st...3B **Mateo Gil** added a grand slam in the 6th...Ramírez finished with a season-high-tying 3 hits — adding 2 doubles — and reached base 4 times...1B **Joe Suozzi** added a multi-hit game, as well...C **Rafael Flores** and RF **Alden Sánchez** accrued multi-hit contests for Hudson Valley...RHP **Cameron Foster** posted a quality start to earn his first pro victory...RHP **Manny Rodríguez** and RHP **Wilkin Ramos** united for 3 innings of shutout relief to close out the win.

**BREAK OUT THE RYE BREAD:** 3B **Mateo Gil**'s grand slam in the top of the 6th inning marked the first 4-RBI home run by a Cyclone in 2023...It marked Brooklyn's first grand slam since 1B **JT Schwartz** smashed one off RHP **Ryan Miller** at Hudson Valley on July 27, 2022...Last season, the Cyclones smashed a pair of grand salamis...CF **Jaylen Palmer** hammered the first off RHP **Alex Pham** vs. Aberdeen on June 12.

**RAMÍ ROCKETS:** OF **Alex Ramírez** reached base 4 times and tied a season-high with 3 hits on Thursday night at Hudson Valley...The 20-year-old doubled twice, worked a walk, scored a run and drove in another...It was Ramírez's first multi-extra base hit game since he doubled twice on August 25, 2022, at Jersey Shore...Since joining Brooklyn's roster on July 4 of last year, Ramírez leads the South Atlantic League in RBI (52), hits (95) and doubles (23)...He only trails teammate OF **Stanley Consuegra** in extra-base hits (31) and total bases (141).

**LUGO LAND:** INF **William Lugo** comes into Friday's matchup riding a season-high 5-game hitting streak...The 21-year-old tallied his first multi-hit game of the season on Wednesday afternoon and is 6-for-his-last-19 (.316) during the stretch...Lugo has tallied 5 runs scored, a double, a triple, and an RBI, adding 2 walks and a stolen base...The Dominican native has also reached base safely in 7-consecutive contests dating back to May 10...Lugo is slashing .304/.429/.435 with a .863 OPS and a 141 wRC+ in that span.

**HIT PARADA:** C **Kevin Parada** cracked a home run on Tuesday night and has been on a tear since the calendar flipped to May...In 14 games during the season's second month, the 21-year-old is slashing .283/.367/.547 with a .914 OPS...Parada is 15-for-53 at the dish (.283) with 9 runs scored, 6 doubles, a triple, 2 home runs, and 7 RBI...In that time frame, the Los Angeles native holds a .406 wOBA and a 141 wRC+...In the month of May, Parada is tied for the South Atlantic League lead in extra-base hits (9) and tied for 2nd in doubles (6)...For the entire campaign, the Georgia Tech alum is tied for 3rd in the SAL in two-base hits (10).

**WIZARD OF SUOZZ:** OF/1B **Joe Suozzi** enters Friday riding a 7-game on-base streak during the course of Brooklyn's road trip...The Glen Cove, N.Y. native is 7-for-his-last-22 (.318) with 3 runs scored, 2 doubles, 4 RBI, 3 walks, and a stolen base...Suozzi has registered a .794 OPS and 116 wRC+ in those 7 contests...Dating back to April 26 at Jersey Shore, the 25-year-old has registered at least one base knock in 10-of-13 games.

**E-STEP UP:** After a bumpy month of April, INF **Chase Estep** has picked up the pace at the plate in season's second month...In his last 9 games played dating back to May 5, the 23-year-old is slashing .290/.333/.516 with an .849 OPS...Estep has accumulated 5 runs scored, 2 doubles, a triple, a home run, and 7 RBI in 33 plate appearances...The Corbin, Ky. native has also registered a 122 wRC+...In his first 12 games, the Estep was just 2-for-43 (.047) at the dish with a wRC+ of -21.

**NONE SHALL PASS:** LHP **Daniel Juárez** has been as dominant as can be out of the bullpen for the Cyclones in 2023...In his first 11 outings of the campaign, the southpaw holds a 2-0 record with 1 save...He has not permitted a run on 5 hits and 6 walks, striking out 21 (13.83 K/9)...In 16 regular season appearances with the Cyclones dating back to last season, Juárez has yielded only 1 unearned run in 18.0 innings...The 22-year-old has not surrendered an earned run in 24 straight appearances dating back to last year...Juárez last al-

**vs. HUDSON VALLEY:** Brooklyn heads continues their 2 week road trip with a 6-game set against the Yankees' High-A affiliate...The Renegades boast 3 of New York's top 30 prospects per *Baseball America*...OF **Spencer Jones** (6), RHP **Drew Thorpe** (8), and C **Antonio Gómez** (27) are featured...The Cyclones went 14-16 in 30 matchups against Hudson Valley in 2022...Brooklyn held a 8-10 record at Heritage Financial Park last year...The Cyclones are 128-135 (.487) all-time against the Renegades dating back to the 2001 season.

lowed earned runs on June 22, 2022, with Single-A St. Lucie at Palm Beach...Since then, he is 4-0 with 10 hits allowed, 15 walks, and 36 strikeouts in 28.1 innings...Since the streak began, no pitcher in Minor League Baseball has thrown more innings without allowing an earned run.

**STU-PER DUPER:** RHP **Tyler Stuart** has been as consistent as any starting pitcher in the SAL in 2023...The 23-year-old extended his scoreless inning streak to 8.0 innings with 5.0 scoreless frames at Wilmington on Saturday...Entering Friday, Stuart leads the league in ERA (1.40)...He is also tied for 6th in batting average against (.202)...The right-hander is also 4th in xFIP (3.50), 6th in strikeouts per nine innings (11.92), and 7th in strikeout rate (32.1%).

**ROAD WARRIOR:** OF **Stanley Consuegra** has thrived away from Maimonides Park in 2023...Coming into Friday, the 22-year-old has posted a batting average 125 points higher on the road (.313) than at home (.188)...Away from home, Consuegra is slashing .313/.361/.612 with a .973 OPS adding 10 of his 15 extra-base hits and all 5 of his home runs...17 of his 19 RBI have been on the road, as well...As a team, the Cyclones are hitting 25 points better in visiting parks (.220) than on Coney Island (.195).

**'DASH' LOS SANTOS:** In addition to his 14 stolen bases in 15 attempts in 2023, OF **Omar De Los Santos** remains among the best base stealers in Minor League Baseball since the beginning of 2022...The 23-year-old has accumulated 84 stolen bases in that span, which is 5th most in MiLB...Only Red Sox prospect INF **David Hamilton** (91), Aberdeen OF **Luis Valdez** (89), Marlins farmhand INF **Nasim Núñez** (88), and Athletics OF **Esteury Ruiz** (85) have swiped more...De Los Santos has also snagged 49 more bases than any other Mets prospect in that time...Fellow Cyclone IF/OF **Jaylen Palmer** is 2nd with 35...Omar is already 18 swipes shy of matching INF **Walter Rasquin**'s franchise record for single-season stolen bases (32) which was set back in 2017.

**ATOP THE WONDER WHEEL:** Prior to Opening Day, *Baseball America* ranked the Brooklyn Cyclones as having the fourth most-talented roster in all of Minor League Baseball...The 'Clones are the highest rated non-Triple-A squad, falling just behind the Norfolk Tides (1), Durham Bulls (2), and Columbus Clippers (3)...Brooklyn is the lone South Atlantic League team and A-level club to be recognized within the Top 10.

**MEET THE 'NEW' BOSS:** Chris Newell takes over as the manager of the Brooklyn Cyclones in 2023 after serving as the team's bench coach in 2022...Newell served as skipper of the Birmingham-Bloomfield Beavers of the United Shore Professional Baseball League from 2016-19...The 49-year-old won consecutive championships (2017-18) and was named Manager of the Year three times (2016-18).

**PROSPECTS:** Brooklyn hosts 3 of the Mets Top 10 prospects, according to *MLB Pipeline* and *Baseball America* and 5 of the Top 30...They include C **Kevin Parada** (No. 2 *MLB Pipeline*/No. 4 *Baseball America*), OF **Alex Ramírez** (3/5), and RHP **Blade Tidwell** (6/9)...INF **William Lugo** (26/26) and RHP **Christian Scott** (29/26) also appears on both lists...OF **Stanley Consuegra** ranks as the organization's No. 20 farmhand per *MLB Pipeline*.

**PROSPECT RADAR:** While not currently ranked, Suárez was deemed the Mets' No. 30 prospect entering the 2022 season by *Baseball America*...Considered the No. 25 farmhand entering 2021.

**2022:** Placed on Single-A St. Lucie's 60-day injured list to start the season...Sent on a rehab assignment with the Florida Complex League Mets on August 12...Tallied a 1-1 record with a 3.97 ERA (5 ER in 11.1 IP) and 12 strikeouts in 6 games (3 starts)...Returned to St. Lucie on August 23...Registered an 0-2 mark with a 7.20 ERA (8 ER in 10.0 IP) and 13 K's in 4 appearances (2 starts).

**COMEBACK TRAIL:** Suárez is participating in his first full season since the 2019 campaign...The 23-year-old made 6 starts with Single-A St. Lucie in 2021 before undergoing Tommy John surgery in June...Made his return to play in game one of a doubleheader with the FCL Mets vs. the FCL Cardinals on July 14, 2022.
