NOTES AND NUGGETS

GOOD TIMES, BAD TIMES

The Storm Chasers opened the 2026 season 0-4, won 3 straight series and then lost back-to-back series, but are trending up, coming off a series split in Indianapolis.

After suffering a season-opening weekend sweep in Louisville, the Storm Chasers went 12-5 between April 1 and 21, with series wins over Buffalo, Iowa and Indianapolis ... Omaha proceeded to lose 7 straight games, from April 22 to 29 and since April 22, the Chasers are 5-13.

Omaha had a winning April, with a 13-12 record on the month ... last year, the Chasers had just one winning month, going 15-11 in August.

CATCH ME IF YOU CAN

Stealing bases has been one of the strongest areas for the Storm Chasers this season, led by one of the league's best baserunners.

Omaha's 84.6% stolen base rate (44-for-52) ranks 1st in the International League, 3rd at the Triple-A level and is 14th among the 120 full-season Minor League teams.

John Rave leads Omaha in steals (10) ... Gavin Cross has 8 steals, while Kameron Misner has 7 stolen bases and Tyler Tolbert has swiped 6 bags ... Tolbert joins Cross as 2 of 4 Storm Chasers who have stolen multiple bases without being caught this year.

PITCH, PLEASE

A constant in 2026 has been Omaha's ability to go deep in plate appearances.

The Storm Chasers are seeing 3.398 pitches per plate appearance, 5th-most in the International League and 8th at the Triple-A level.

Among 231 Triple-A players with 100+ plate appearances this year, John Rave ranks 7th in pitches seen/PA (4.448) while Kameron Misner ranks 14th (4.361).

CAUGHT CLEAN-HANDED

The Storm Chasers are tied for the 7th-best fielding percentage in the International League with a .980 mark (1st: Rochester, .986), committing just 27 errors in 39 games.

The clean play extends throughout the roster - 5 of Omaha's 16 qualified fielders (min. 60.0 inn.) have a perfect 1.000 fielding percentage, while another 6 of those 16 have committed just 1 error on the season.

Omaha's 38 double plays turned are the 4th-most of any Minor League team ... 4 Storm Chasers infielders have participated in 10 or more double plays, led by Abraham Toro's 24, tied 7th-most of any Minor League player.

GENTRY GIANT

This week, former Storm Chaser outfielder Tyler Gentry returns to Werner Park for his first games as a visitor, after playing the last 3 seasons with Omaha.

Released by the Royals in March, Gentry signed a Minor League deal with the Tigers on April 11 ... his 364 games with Omaha between 2023 and 2025 rank 4th-most in the club's Storm Chasers era (since 2011) ... since 2011, he ranks 3rd for Omaha in walks (162), 6th in doubles (69), 6th in homers (41) and 7th in RBI (164).

PITCH, PLEASE

Last week in Indianapolis, Omaha's pitching staff worked one of the club's best pitching series since the Storm Chasers joined the International League in 2021.

Omaha's pitching staff held Indians hitters to a .150 average (24-for-160), the best by a Storm Chasers pitching staff since 2021 ... last week's 1.98 ERA (10 ER in 47.1 IP) and 0.96 WHIP (17 BB + 26 H) were the 2nd-best.

Last week was the 4th time for Omaha in its International League era that the staff worked multiple shutouts in a single series ... the Chasers beat the Indians 5-0 in the 1st game of Wednesday's doubleheader, before winning 9-0 Sunday.

QUALITY CONTROL

Not only was last week one of Omaha's best pitching weeks in recent history, it was also one of the best weeks for the club's starting pitchers, including the Chasers' first two quality starts of the year.

Storm Chasers starting pitchers worked a 0.58 WHIP (7 H + 8 BB) and .084 opponents' average (7-for-83), both the club's best in the International League era ... a 1.38 ERA last week ranks 2nd-best for Omaha pitchers since 2021.

Mitch Spence and Aaron Sanchez worked quality starts in consecutive games ... Thursday, Spence allowed 2 runs on 1 hit over 6.2 innings ... in Game 1 of Saturday's doubleheader, Sanchez threw 6.0 innings of scoreless, 1-hit ball with a season-high 8 strikeouts to earn IL Pitcher of the Week honors ... additionally, Ryan Ramsey threw 5.0 scoreless innings in Game 1 of Wednesday's doubleheader and Ethan Bosacker threw 3.2 hitless and scoreless innings to open Sunday's bullpen game.

CAREER REVIEW

- Benjamin Henry Sears is entering his fifth year with the Kansas City Royals organization after being drafted in 2022 out of Houston ... he reached Triple-A for the first time in June 2025 but has not yet made his Major League debut.
- Has exclusively pitched out of the bullpen in his professional career, with all 129 career Minor League appearances coming in relief ... 79 of 129 (61%) have lasted longer than 1.0 inning, while 60 of his outings (47%) have been 2.0 innings or more.
- Across the last three seasons (2023-25), his 121 appearances rank 4th among Royals Minor League pitchers ... among 31 arms in the system that have thrown at least 150.0 innings over the last three years, Sears' 2.44 BB/9 ranks 3rd, a 3.26 K/BB is 4th and his 3.92 ERA ranks 9th.

2025 HIGHLIGHTS

- Spent much of the season with Northwest Arkansas (AA), but also had a stint with Omaha from June 28 to August 4 ... between the two levels, went 3-3 with 5 saves and a 4.33 ERA (30 ER in 62.1 IP).
- 16 of 32 appearances with the Naturals in Double-A were scoreless, with a career-high 11.2-inning scoreless streak from April 19 to May 16 that spanned parts of 7 outings.
- Earned 5 saves with NWA, including 3 in a 6-outing span from August 14 to 29 ... pitched to a 2.63 ERA (4 ER in 13.2 IP) with 11 strikeouts in August.
- 4 of his 9 outings with the Storm Chasers were scoreless ... did not allow an earned run in his 3 longest Triple-A appearances, all longer than 2.0 innings, including 3.0 scoreless innings of relief on August 1 vs. Louisville (CIN).

- Earned a save in 4 consecutive appearances, between May 17 and 26 ... also successfully converted a save in his final 5 save opportunities, between July 4 and August 8.
- Did not allow a home run in a season-high 45.1-inning stretch from April 16 to July 19, making 21 appearances without allowing a home run.

- Assigned to the Arizona Complex League after being drafted by Kansas City and made 1 appearance for the ACL Royals (R) before finishing the year with Columbia (A) ... combined to work a 2.87 ERA (5 ER in 15.2 IP) across 8 games, with 6 scoreless appearances.
