NOTES AND NUGGETS

IN GOOD STANDINGS

Omaha enters today's game in 1st place in the 20-team International League, a season-high 28 games over .500 at 48-20 (.706) and the best team in MiLB.
48 wins are the most of any team in Minor League Baseball this season, two ahead of the 46-win Sugar Land Space Cowboys (Astros Triple-A).
Of 120 full season Minor League teams, Omaha's .706 winning percentage is also the best, just ahead of the Frisco RoughRiders (43-21 / .672 / Rangers Double-A).

PLAYOFF BOUND

Up by 5.5 games over the 2nd-place Syracuse Mets with 5 games to play, Omaha's 9-4 win over Louisville clinched the 1st Half title in the International League.
Winning the first half in the league secures the Storm Chasers home field advantage in the International League Championship Series, a best-of-three series that will be played at Werner Park from September 24 to 26.
This September will mark Omaha's first appearance in the playoffs since 2014, when the Chasers won their 2nd of back-to-back Triple-A National Championships.
The Triple-A Omaha franchise has 17 playoff appearances in the last 55 years, including most recently four straight seasons: 2011 to 2014.

IT'S CALLED A WINNING STREAK

Winners of 6 straight games (the final 5 games of last week's series in Toledo and yesterday's win over Louisville), the Storm Chasers are attempting to win a seventh straight games this evening.
Omaha has FIVE 5+ game winning streaks this season, a sixth straight win yesterday is the team's third 6+ game winning streak.
The Chasers' 9-game winning streak between May 29 and June 6 is still the longest in Triple-A this year, tied for the 4th-longest among the 120 full season MiLB teams.

COMEBACK KIDS

Trailing 1-0 after the third inning yesterday, the win marked Omaha's 27th comeback from behind win this season, meaning over half (56%) of this year's wins have been comeback victories.
The Storm Chasers have come back from down as many as five runs to win and 10 times, have overcome a 3+ run deficit to win.
Omaha has trailed for three innings or more in 10 of the 27 comeback wins, with four victories where the club had to overcome multiple deficits ... the team has 7 wins in games where they trailed after the 6th inning.

TOO CLOSE FOR COMFORT

Omaha has a 34-9 record over its last 43 games ... 28 of those 43 games have been decided by 3 runs or less, including 24 of the 34 wins in this stretch.
Omaha is 17-6 in 1-run games this season, the most wins in 1-run games of any Minor League team ... the Storm Chasers have won their last seven 1-run games and 10 of their last 13 games decided by just a run.
In total, 45 of Omaha's 67 games this year have been decided by 3 runs or fewer (67%), including 13 of 20 losses this season.
As a team, Omaha's 23 saves are tied for the most of any Minor League team ... Will Klein's 9 saves individually rank third in the International League, while six players have 2 or more saves this year.

I'M DIFFERENT, YEAH, I'M (RUN) DIFFERENT(IAL)

Omaha has outscored its opponents 396 to 307 this season, a +89 run differential.
A +89 run differential ranks as the best in the International League and is the 2nd-highest mark at the Triple-A level trailing Oklahoma City (Dodgers Triple-A) at +92.
Omaha ranks 5th in Minor League Baseball in run differential ... the Modesto Nuts lead the Minors at +154 (430 to 276).

YOU CAN COUNT ON ME

Two factors contributing to Omaha's success this season include the starting pitchers going deep into games and the offense providing their starters run support.
When Omaha's starter can get through at least 5.0 innings this year, the team has a 23-4 record (.852 winning %), compared to 24-17 (.585 winning %) when starters don't make it through the 5th inning.
When the offense can provide 3+ runs of support, the Storm Chasers are 28-5 (.848 winning %), while the team is just 20-15 when the offense offers 2 runs of support or less to the starting pitcher (.571 winning %).

RELIEF AID

Omaha's bullpen remains one of the best in the International League and even across the entire Triple-A level.
The Storm Chasers relievers lead all Triple-A bullpens with a .209 opponents' average (tied 5th in MiLB), .324 opposing on-base percentage and .673 opposing OPS, while a 3.64 ERA from Omaha bullpen's is 2nd-best in Triple-A.
Including Sunday's win in Toledo, Omaha's bullpen has combined to not allow a run in 17 games this year ... this is an average of once every 4.0 games this year of the relievers combining for a shutout.

TODAY'S START

- ♣ Bubic is making his **5th start with Omaha** and **10th rehab start** this season after opening this year on Kansas City's 60-day injured list, as he makes his recovery from Tommy John surgery early last season ... he was transferred to Omaha on May 27.
- ♣ On rehab since May 7, his assignment has been extended by 10 days twice of three possible times, an exception to the 30 days allowed to pitchers on rehab assignment, only for pitchers coming back from Tommy John ... must be approved by the player and MLBPA.
- ♣ This is his 7th season in the Royals organization ... skipped over the Double-A and Triple-A levels to make his MLB debut in 2020 and has almost exclusively pitched in the big leagues since, outside of a short stint in Omaha in 2022 ... since debuting with Kansas City in 2020, Bubic's 325.0 innings and 60 games started for the Royals rank third among the club's pitchers in that span.

LAST OUTING: FRIDAY, JUNE 14 @ TOLEDO

Made his 9th rehab start, his 4th with Omaha and his longest outing this year by pitches thrown (84), but only made it through 4.0 innings ... worked around a leadoff walk in the 1st inning for a scoreless frame, allowed a two-out, two-run single in the 2nd inning ... loaded the bases in the 3rd, but stranded them loaded, worked a 1-2-3 4th inning and did not come out for the 5th.

2024 HIGHLIGHTS

- ♣ Did not appear in any Cactus League games for the Royals ... opened the year on the 60-Day IL, sent to the Arizona Complex League to begin a rehab assignment on May 7, transferred to NW Arkansas on May 18, transferred to Omaha on May 27.
- ♣ Over 9 total rehab outings this year, is 0-3 with a 3.60 ERA (10 ER in 25.0 IP) with 9 walks to 28 strikeouts (3.1 K/BB).
- ♣ His first 8.2 innings with Omaha were scoreless, did not allow his first run until the 2nd inning last Sunday, June 9 vs. Memphis.

- ♣ Only made three starts in his fourth Major League season ... placed on the Injured List on April 16 with a left flexor strain and underwent Tommy John surgery in late April.
 - ♣ Threw 6.0 scoreless innings on April 9 @ SF ... allowed 2 hits and 0 walks while tying a Major League career-high with 9 strikeouts.
- 2022**
- ♣ In his third season with the Royals, made 28 appearances (27 starts) across two stints tied with **Daniel Lynch** for the most starts made by a Royal and ranked 5th on the staff with 129.0 innings pitched ... For the second straight year, induced a team-leading 19 double plays, which ranked 4th in the American League, with an AL-best 1.33 GDP-per-9.0 innings rate.
