Tonight's Game

The Clippers will send RHP **Rorik Maltrud** to the mound tonight, followed by RHP **Trenton Denholm** (Denholm missed last piggyback because Maltrud threw 7.0IP). St. Paul will counter with RHP **Trent Baker**. Columbus is 16-9 (.640) versus right handers this year. Baker has pitched against Columbus twice in his career (last September), notching a save (2.1IP, 3H, 0R, 0ER, 0BB, 3K).

vs. the Saints

Columbus went 4-2 against the Saints in Minnesota last year, on the way to a 9-7 series record, and has won 45 of the last 72 overall opposing the Saints (389-307 run differential; 13 of 27 losses by a single run, only nine losses by more than two runs). Individually, **Stuart Fairchild** is the only Clipper hitting over .300 in his career against the Saints (.333, 7x21, in 6G).

Too Many Runs

Last night marked the seventh time this season that the Clippers gave up double figures in the run column, tied with three other teams for most in the IL, including St. Paul. Four of those games have come this month, as the Clippers own a 7.01ERA in May (3rd worst for the month; 87.1IP, 68ER). Removing **Rorik Maltrud's** 7.0IP, 0ER performance on 5/6 at Iowa, the team ERA jumps to 7.62.

Crazy Eighthths

Columbus had an 8th inning scoring streak snapped at 7G last night (12 runs in total), but embiggened the 9th inning streak to 4G (10 total). On the season, the Clippers have scored 72 runs from the 8th inning on (25 more than 2nd place), crafting a collective .965OPS (126 points ahead of 2nd). All those late runs have led to an IL-best 15 comeback victories, including four when trailing after the 7th.

Watch Out for Watson

Kahlil Watson is hitting .338/.464/.675 with 13XBH in his last 21G (1XBH in first 12G), having reached base in each of his last 12G (.458OBP since 4/23). Watson drew his 30th walk of the season Saturday and his 40th strikeout on Sunday (one of five in the IL with at least 30 of each) and, with his 7HR, he owns a three true outcome rate of 51.0% (7th highest among 113 IL hitters with at least 120PA).

Since the Option

Juan Brito is hitting .245/.351/.551 with 4HR and 14RBI in 12G since getting optioned on 4/28 (9G hit streak snapped last night: .316, 12x38). **George Valera** is hitting just .195 (8x41) with 2RBI in 9G since his option on 4/30 (.294, 10x34 with 12RBI in 8G rehab last month). Since the start of 2021, there have been 11 Clippers to hit 40 doubles (Brito, 55, Valera, 41, and **Nolan Jones** got 40 last night).

Eye is for Ingle

Cooper Ingle has drawn 23BB in his first 81PA (28%) this season, following 21BB in 107PA (20%) last season. Though Ingle has hit only .266 (37x139) in his Columbus career, he has a beefy .452OBP and a +11 differential in the walk to strikeout department (44 to 33). Since his Triple-A debut on 8/13/25, his 44BB are tied for 6th most (**Travis Bazzana** is 3rd, 47, and **Kahlil Watson** is 4th, 46).

Always On

Stuart Fairchild is one of five Clippers with an on base streak stretching back over a week, coming into tonight at 8G (.487OBP since 5/2; **Kody Huff** has a .585OBP over his 9G streak since 5/1). Fairchild has drawn 9BB in 43PA this month (21%) and his .437OBP for the year ranks 3rd in the IL (**Travis Bazzana** is 8th and **Kahlil Watson** is 12th, no other team has more than two in top 15).

Hot Huff

Kody Huff rebounded from a pair of hitless games to end April with hits in each of his first 9G this month (.485, 16x33, six multi-hit, 11RBI). His XBH streak was snapped at 5G on Friday, but he still owns 12XBH in his last 21G (.620SLG since 4/16). Huff is sitting at 25 runs and 30RBI through 34G (had 31 runs and a career high 47RBI in 101G last year; has tied career high with 7HR, 2024 with Akron).

POW Hangover

Since being named the IL's Batter of the Week for 4/14-4/19 vs. Iowa (10x20, 4HR, 10RBI), **Milan Tolentino** is hitting .169/.300/.237 with 0HR and 4RBI in 16G (3x4, 2RBI on Sunday). Of 35 IL batters with at least 20HR since the start of last season, Tolentino is one of two that has not homered off LHP (107AB; 27HR in 414AB vs. RHP), but he is hitting .370 (10x27) off lefties this year (.138 in '25).

This Date in Clipper History

5/13/1984

Clipper first baseman **Dan Briggs** went 4x5 with a triple, two doubles, two runs and an RBI in Columbus' 6-5 comeback victory over Rochester. The Clippers scored a run in each of their final five at bats with Briggs driving in the game-tying run in the 8th. After the game, Briggs was quoted by the Columbus Dispatch as saying, "Two days from now, no one will remember what I did today."

Huntington (Small) Park

In each of the first 11 seasons after the move downtown (2009-19), Huntington Park ranked among the top two in the IL in homers per game. With the arrival of six new parks to the IL in 2021, Huntington Park finished 4th, 6th and 10th from 2021-23, respectively. The 2024 season saw a return to the top (2.96; 108HR hit by the Clippers, most for the home team in HP's existence), but it dropped back to 7th last year (2.31). Including the postseason, the Clippers have been out-homered over the life of the park (1,423 to 1,372).

Challenging Times

The Clippers are 52-57 (.477) in pitch reviews, with batters going 31-41 (.431) and pitchers/catchers going 21-16 (.568). They have run out of challenges in 24G and have not challenged in 2G. Last season, they were correct 43.1% of the time (2nd worst in the IL).

Extras, Read All About Them

Columbus is 1-3 in extra innings this season, after having gone 5-5 in 2025 and 9-9 in 2024 (most losses since 2013, 12). Since the start of the 2018 season, when baserunners started appearing at second base, the Clippers are 51-36 when playing past regulation (.586, best in the IL; no other team above .570), including 26-17 at home (.605, but 4-7 in last 11G). Of the 87G to require extra play, 69 have been resolved after one frame (including eight DH games) and only one has gone past the 12th (5-4 loss in 13 innings on 9/20/22 at Toledo). From 7/31/19-6/26/21, Columbus played 85 straight within the allotted innings.

Didn't Add Up

The first half of the 2025 season saw the Clippers finish 12th with a 34-38 record (.472), despite ranking 10th in run differential (+3), 10th in pitching (4.61ERA) and 2nd in defense (.984; ranked 13th in batting, .250). Such a result was the product of a league-high 27 losses by three runs or fewer (22-27, .449, 13th), as they played in the fewest games decided by at least four runs (12-11, .522, 9th). In the second half, they went 19-21 in close games, while going 11-22 in blowouts.

Hits the Spot

When turning in as many or fewer hits than their opponents last season, the Clippers went 18-64 (.220), coming in 13th out of 20 in the IL. The 2024 season saw them post an IL-worst .185 (12-53) winning percentage in such games. When allowing at least 10 hits last year, Columbus was 7-41 (.146, 20th in the IL; started the season 1-20).

Juiced is Loose

In the Huntington Park Era (since 2009), Columbus leads the IL with 76 grand slams and 1,872RBI (led IL in RBI in 2010, '11, '12, '17, '18 and '22). Collecting an IL-best 10 grand slams last season, it marked their fifth straight season with at least four (118RBI last year; had only 97RBI in 2024, worst in a 140+G season since 2016).

Not So Fast

On the basepaths, the 2024 Clippers established a franchise record of 200SB, (80% success rate) with four players topping 20 for the first time in club history. As a team, they were successful on 30 consecutive attempts (6/16-6/30/24) and 36 straight tries (7/23-8/7/24, including 8SB on 7/31/24 vs. Syracuse). Last season was a different story entirely, as they finished with the worst stolen base percentage in the IL (72%, 127SB and 49CS).

Three True Outcomes

While not breaking records last season, the Clipper pitching staff topped 660BB for the third time ever (all in last three years, franchise record of 767BB in 2023) and cleared 1,300K for the fourth time (all in the last four years, franchise record of 1,392K in 2024). The homer rate was down considerably last year, but the three true outcome rate still ended around 39% (the 2024 season saw franchise high of 40.5%; last six seasons have all been at least 37.0%, no seasons above 33.4% prior).

Department of Defense

The Columbus defense is sitting at 11th in the IL this year (.977), following a 2025 that saw a franchise record (.985, led the IL). On 4/10 at Worcester, the defense collapsed for the first 5E game since 8/27/24 (topped out at 3E in a game twice last year and had fewer than 5E in 21 of 26 series). The Clippers have played flawlessly in 21G this season (12-9, .571), after doing so in nearly 60% of games last year (44-42, .512), including 16 straight from 6/20-7/8/25 (longest streak in the IL over the last 20 years).

Key to Victory

From 2022-23, Columbus owned the best record in the IL when holding opponents to three runs or fewer, going 95-8 (.922, no other team was above .880). The Clippers were 43-10 in such games in 2024 (.811, 13th in the IL), accumulating four losses by 4/14, and were just 47-10 (.825, 9th) last year, collecting four losses over 14G from 4/23-5/9 (had four losses total in both 2022 and 2023).

Good Baseball

Juan Brito moved a runner into scoring position with a sac bunt on 5/7 at lowa and that runner came around to score in a 2-run win. Since the start of the 2018 season, Columbus is 85-23 (.787) in games in which a run is scored after a good bunt attempt, including a 2-2 mark this season (.500, blew 7-run lead in one of the losses; went 23-2 in 2018).

To the End

The Clippers had the 6th most last at bat losses last season (17), after pacing the circuit with 23 in 2024 (tied with Toledo). They also suffered the 4th most walk-off losses (8), watching three in a row slip away at Rochester from 5/29-5/31. The 2024 season saw 41G decided in the last at bat (tied for 2nd most in the IL, one off lead), with Columbus going 18-23 in those contests (t-17th, .439).

Manager Profile

Andy Tracy made his Clippers debut in 2021, following **Tony Mansolino's** championship rookie year in 2019 (sixth Clipper skipper to win Governors' Cup in first season; **Gene Michael**-'79, **Joe Altobelli**-'80, **Frank Verdi**-'81, **Bucky Dent**-'87 and **Mike Sarbaugh**-'10). This season marks Tracy's sixth year as a manager (first was with Williamsport in the Philadelphia system), as he holds a career record of 406-426 (.488), 376-380 with Columbus (.497).

Efficiency is Key:

Through 35 innings started in 7G, Maltrud has retired the side with fewer than 10 pitches on seven occasions, including a 4-pitch inning on 4/3 vs. Indianapolis, while turning in seven innings of at least 20. He has hit 30+ twice, thanks to an 11-pitch battle vs. Iowa's **Pedro Ramirez** on 4/17 (walk, 34 in the inning) and a 14-pitch skirmish with Buffalo's **Yohendrick Pinango** on 4/23 (groundout, 30 total). He ranks 2nd in the IL with 14.3 pitches per inning.

Pitch to Contact:

Maltrud's Triple-A debut on 3/28 at Iowa was the 44th game of his career and marked his 37th consecutive start (reached 41GS before relief appearance on 4/30 vs. Toledo, all 6G in relief have come on starter's rest and been at least 3.0IP). He did not punch out any Cubs in that game (15BF), marking his second straight game without a strikeout (37BFwith 0K from, 9/10/25-4/3/26; had at least 1K in all 42G prior). Among 139 pitchers in the IL that have at least 80BF this year, Maltrud has the 20th best walk rate (7.4%; 10BB to 136BF), but the 43rd worst strikeout rate (19.1%, 26K; had worst rate, 11.9%, prior to 14K in last 2G).

Pitched the entire season with Akron... went 0-1 with an 8.64ERA (8.1IP, 7H, 8R, 8ER, 9BB, 9K) through first 3GS (4/8-4/19), including 2ER in 0.2IP of season-opening start vs. Altoona on 4/8 (33 pitches)... had 7GS prior to the All-Star Break (4/26-7/9), sandwiched around a DL stint for a strained right forearm (5/28-6/26), going 2-0 with a 0.79ERA (22.2IP, 11H, 2R, 2ER, 9BB, 24K)... hot streak included a quality start win at Altoona on 5/1 (6.0IP, 3H, 1R, 1ER, 1BB, 4K) and 9K in 5.1IP (0ER) vs. Somerset on 5/7... did not record 5.0IP in any of 7GS following the Break (7/20-8/29), going 0-2 with a 7.54ERA (22.2IP, 27H, 20R, 19ER, 10BB, 28K)... rebounded to finish the season with back to back wins on 9/4 vs. Binghamton (5.0IP, 2ER) and 9/10 at Harrisburg (5.0IP, 0ER)... appeared in 5G for Surprise in the Arizona Fall League (9.1IP, 16H, 11R, 10ER, 2BB, 10K).
