**MUDCATS SHUSH SHOREBIRDS AGAIN:** The Delmarva Shorebirds were held in check just about all night against the Carolina Mudcats as the Milwaukee Brewers' affiliate topped them for the third time this week by a score of 7-1. After grabbing a first inning lead on an RBI single by **Creed Willems**, the Carolina pitching staff shut down Delmarva by allowing just one base runner from the third inning and on, including a stretch where the Mudcats retired 18 consecutive Shorebirds. Carolina scored seven unanswered runs with the last four being unearned as they guaranteed at least a series split after Friday's victory.

**TODAY'S OPPONENT: Bradley Brehmer** makes his fourth start of the season and fifth total appearance on Saturday night against Alexander Vallecillo for the Mudcats who has been off to a terrific start this season for the Mudcats as the right-hander has allowed just 2 total runs in 14 innings to earn him an ERA of 1.29 across four starts. Vallecillo tossed his longest start of the year last Saturday against the Kannapolis Cannon Ballers, covering five innings with six strikeouts and one hit allowed in a 1-0 victory.

**FEELING YOUNG:** Carter Young has started to get it going offensively for the Shorebirds after a slow start to the season. Young has a hit in five consecutive games and has driven in a run in four-straight after a leadoff home run on Thursday night. The infielder from Vanderbilt also has 13 walks which is third-best on the team.

**GO LONG: Creed Willems** continues his excellent season in Delmarva by going deep for the sixth time on Wednesday night to add his already impressive slugging percentage of .692 through 19 games. Willems has already passed his home run total from 2022 and is on pace to shatter all his offensive numbers from last season after just one month of action.

**HITS IN BUNCHES: Stiven Acevedo** has been a regular at collecting multi-hit games as he delivered his teambest, seventh following his career performance on Tuesday. Acevedeo now has three 3-hit games, and four 2-hit games. He has collected at least one hit in 16/20 games this season.

**PROCEED WITH CAUTION:** The Delmarva catchers have been tough to run on this season for opposing base runners as they are tied for the Carolina League lead by catching 22 would be base stealers and have denied their opposition on 38% of their attempts through the first 23 games of the season.

**MORE THAN DEFENSE: Adam Crampton** has become more than a defensive specialist for the Shorebirds as's been hot at the plate over his last ten games with 12 hits in his last 33 at-bats with 3 doubles, 3 RBI, and 7 runs scored. His .375 average in that stretch is the best on the team.

**TEACH ME HOW TO DOUGIE: Douglas Hodo** has made become one of the most reliable bats in the Delmarva batting order over the last ten games as has the best batting average (.300) and OBP (.400) thanks to six walks in that span. The former Texas Longhorn picked up his first career triple on Wednesday night versus Carolina and has reached base in 13/16 games he's played in this season.

**MUDCAT MATCHUP:** The Shorebirds and Mudcats will face off in a series for the third consecutive season after the two franchises were in different leagues since their respective inceptions until 2021 when both were moved to the Carolina League. The Mudcats have been in the Carolina League since 2012 while Delmarva was formerly in the South Atlantic League. The Shorebirds hold the all-time series edge 14-10 with the two teams splitting their 12 games last season.

**TODAY'S STARTER:** Bradley Brehmer gets the call as the starter on Saturday night as the Shorebirds look to get back in the series. Brehmer is making his fifth appearance and fourth start of the season, dealing four innings in each outing.

**LAST OUTING (4/29 vs SAL):** Brehmer last appeared a week ago against the Salem Red Sox in the second game of the doubleheader and went four innings allowing just one run on six hits in a no-decision. The Shorebirds would go on to win by a score of 4-2.

vs. CAROLINA: This will be the first time Brehmer faces the Carolina Mudcats.

**2022 SEASON HIGHLIGHTS:** Pitched his final year of college at the University of Indiana after three seasons at Wright State. Made 17 appearances, 14 as a starter and earned a 5-4 record with a 5.30 ERA. The sinker baller collected 77 strikeouts with 33 walks across 74.2 total innings with his top performance of the season coming on April 23 versus Nebraska where he dealt 6 innings on the mound and stuck out a season-best 11 Corn Huskers. Allowed just 1 run on 3 hits as his quality start led the Hoosiers to an 8-1. Was selected by the Orioles in the 12th Round of the 2022 Draft.

**STAYING GROUNDED:** The ground ball specialist has been effective at keeping the ball down as he currently holds a 2.63/1 ratio of ground ball/fly balls. Of the 48 total outs Brehmer has recorded, 21 have been on the ground for a total of 43%



# MANAGER



Felipe returns to the Shorebirds for his second season as manager and his 16th in the Orioles organization. Previously, he served as the Director of the Orioles' Dominican Republic Academy. He was a 40th round pick by the Kansas City Royals in the 1998 amateur draft, he played in the minor leagues for the Royals from 1998 to 2001, and in the short-lived Canadian Baseball League in 2003. His father, Felipe, played in the Majors for 15+ years before managing the Expos ('92-'01) and Giants ('03-'06). Alou's brother, Luis Rojas, was the manager of the Mets and is currently on the Yankees coaching staff. This will be Felipe's 16th season in the Orioles organization.

## **PITCHING COACH**



Bleday enters his first season as the Shorebirds Pitching Coach in 2023 after spending last season as a O's Pitching Coach in the Florida Complex League. Bleday played his college days as a Left-handed Pitcher for the University of Pennsylvania before being drafted in the 27th round of the 2017 MLB Draft by the Houston Astros. From there, Bleday spent two season in the Astros minor league ranks before making the jump to coaching in 2019.
