THURSDAY: The Flying Squirrels rolled the Hartford Yard Goats, 12-6. In the second, starting pitcher **Sean Hjelle** opened the scoring with a two-run single in the first plate appearance of his professional career. **Heliot Ramos** followed with a three-run homer to open the lead to 5-0. **Vince Fernandez** capped the six-run frame with an RBI single. Hartford scored three runs on a pair of homers in the third inning, but the Flying Squirrels put up five more runs in the bottom of the inning. Hjelle brought in his third RBI with a groundout, Ramos clubbed an RBI double, **Andy Sugilio** brought Ramos in to score from second on an infield single and **David Villar** added a two-run homer in the frame. Hartford scored three runs in the fourth to close the score to 11-6. **Frankie Tostado** closed the scoring for the game with a sacrifice fly in the bottom of the fifth. Relievers **Matt Seelinger**, **Frank Rubio**, **Joey Marciano** and **Patrick Ruotolo** combined for 5.1 scoreless innings out of the bullpen. Ramos finished the game 3-for-4, a triple shy of the cycle, with four RBIs and three runs scored. Fernandez also had three hits.

TODAY'S GAMES: The Flying Squirrels play the fourth and fifth games of the 2021 season and the fourth and fifth of six in this series against the Hartford Yard Goats, Double-A affiliate of the Colorado Rockies. This series marks Hartford's only visit to The Diamond in 2021. The Flying Squirrels will visit Connecticut's capital city from June 22-27 for a six-game series.

A BUNCH OF SELLOUTS: The Flying Squirrels have sold out the first four games of the 2021 season, including today. While adhering to guidelines set forth by the Commonwealth of Virginia and Major League Baseball, maximum capacity is currently capped at 30 percent, which is 2,943 fans. Although a bit below the standard sellout of 9,845, the four games marked the 51st, 52nd, 53rd and 54th sellouts in franchise history. The Flying Squirrels are 35-21 all-time in sellouts (including double-headers). The Flying Squirrels have sold out all 11 of their home openers in the franchise's history.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS finished the 2019 season with a 55-84 record, the worst in the franchise's history, and finished in last place in the Eastern League's Western Division for the second consecutive year. Seven players from the 2019 team are back in Richmond to start the 2021 season, including **Jacob Heyward**, **Sean Hjelle**, **Ryan Howard**, **Peter Maris**, **Heliot Ramos**, **Frank Rubio** and **Raffi Vizcaino**. Reliever **Patrick Ruotolo** did not appear with the Flying Squirrels in 2019, but he did pitch in Richmond in 2018. Outfielder **Vince Fernandez** played in the Eastern League with Hartford in 2019.

THE YARD GOATS return four players from their 2019 team and welcome 24 newcomers. Six players from the 2019 Yard Goats have gone on to reach the majors. The 2021 Hartford roster includes four players ranked by MLB.com in the Rockies' Top-30 prospects, including RHP **Ryan Rolison** (2), 3B **Elehuris Montero** (9), OF **Jameson Hannah** (13) and RHP **Tommy Doyle** (22). The Yard Goats went 73-66 in 2019 and finished in third place in the Eastern League's Eastern Division.

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander **Matt Frisbee** makes his Double-A debut tonight. He spent most of the 2019 season with the San Jose Giants of the California League, going 9-8 with a 3.17 ERA in 22 outings (20 starts). He went 4-2 with a 1.91 ERA in his last 10 appearances (56.2 IP) of the season while picking up 60 strikeouts. Following the season, Frisbee was named a Giants Organizational All-Star by MLB.com. He was drafted by the Giants in the 15th round in 2018 out of UNC Greensboro. **For more on Frisbee, see page two.**

Right-hander **Gerson Garabito** makes his Giants organizational debut in Game 2. He was with the Kansas City Royals organization from 2013-2019, reaching as high as Double-A. He spent 2019 pitching in the Texas League with the Double-A Northwest Arkansas Naturals, going 6-12 with a 3.77 ERA in 26 starts. Garabito's performance in 2019 earned him a selection as a Texas League Mid-Season All-Star. He signed as a minor league free agent with the Giants on November 20, 2020. **For more on Frisbee, see page three.**

FOR HARTFORD: Right-hander Matt Dennis takes the mound for his first start of the 2021 season. He started 2019 with A-Adv. Lancaster, going 2-3 with a 5.60 ERA over 16 outings (7 starts) in the hitter-friendly circuit. He was promoted to Hartford on June 20, 2019 and went on to make 14 starts with the Yard Goats, going 5-4 with a 3.29 ERA. Dennis was selected in the 14th round of the 2016 MLB Draft by the Rockies out of Bradley.

Right-hander Jake Bird will start on the mound in the second game. He made an appearance out of the bullpen on Tuesday's opener for the Yard Goats, working 2.0 scoreless innings. Bird spent 2019 with Single-A Asheville, going 7-2 with a 3.62 ERA in 40 appearances, including eight starts. He was drafted by the Rockies in the fifth round in 2018 out of UCLA.

PLAY THE HITS: The Flying Squirrels are batting .327 as a team, which ranks first in all of Double-A through the first four days of the season. The team was also ranked second in Double-A in runs (21), second in hits (35), third in total bases (51), second in RBIs (21) and fifth in team OPS (.863) prior to Friday's rainout. **Andy Sugilio** is currently ranked second among qualified hitters in the Double-A Northeast in batting average (.500) and tied for third in OBP (.545).

RAMOS RAKING: For the fifth time in his professional career, **Heliot Ramos** has homered in back-to-back games. Ramos hit a solo home run on Wednesday and a three-run shot on Thursday in the opening series against Hartford. Ramos has now collected five homers at the Double-A level and 35 during his career in the minor leagues. Ramos is currently ranked tied for third in the Double-A Northeast in batting average (.462), tied for second in home runs (2), tied for fifth in RBIs (5), tied for third in SLG (1.000), tied for second in OPS (1.500), tied for second in hits (5), tied for second in total bases (13) and tied for second in runs scored (5).

PITCHERS WHO RAKE: Right-handed pitcher **Sean Hjelle** is currently tied for second on the team with three RBIs. The Flying Squirrels are the only team in the Double-A Northeast to have a pitcher register hits (2), runs (1), RBIs (3) and walks (1). **Sam Long** also picked up a single in his first Double-A at-bat on Wednesday and **Norwith Gudino** reached on a walk later in that same game.

WELCOME BACK, AUGGIE: **José Alguacil** returns to manage the Flying Squirrels after leading the team to a 72-68 record in 2015, the most recent season the team has posted a winning record. Alguacil is in his 15th overall season with the Giants organization and worked at the Alternate Training Site in 2020. He previously served as the first base coach and oversaw bunting instruction while assisting with infield defense and baserunning in San Francisco from 2017-2019 on Bruce Bochy's major league staff.

ALL OVER THE MAP: The Flying Squirrels roster contains 18 players from 11 different states across the United States: California (5), Georgia (3), Florida (2) and one player from North Carolina, Minnesota, Illinois, Massachusetts, New York, Missouri, Washington and Ohio. Nine players grew up in four countries and territories outside of the 50 states, including the Dominican Republic (4), Puerto Rico (2), Venezuela (2) and Colombia (1).

THE MORE THE MERRIER: Under the new Player Development License structure, Double-A active rosters include 28 players, up from 25 in the previous system. The Flying Squirrels initial roster includes 15 pitchers and 13 position players.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have three players included in *Baseball America's* Top-30 Giants prospects: **Heliot Ramos** (3), **Tristan Beck** (12) and **Sean Hjelle** (13). Ramos is also rated by *Baseball America* as the No. 83 overall prospect. Ramos (3), Hjelle (11) and Beck (20) are also ranked in MLB.com's Top-30 Giants prospects.

BULLS REUNITED: Richmond's **David Villar** and Hartford's **Coco Montes** were teammates while at University of South Florida during the 2016-2018 seasons. As a junior, Villar was an 11th round selection by the Giants in the 2018 MLB Draft while Montes was selected in the 15th round by the Rockies. This season marks the first time the pair have been in the same league/level in the minors with one another as professionals.

THE SAME BUT DIFFERENT: Prior to the 2021 season, Major League Baseball realigned its player development structure, eliminating the Eastern League, which was the home of the Flying Squirrels for ten seasons. Under the new alignment, the Flying Squirrels play in the 12-team Double-A Northeast, which includes 11 of the former E.L. teams. The Somerset Patriots are the only new opponent on Richmond's schedule this year. The Flying Squirrels are in the Double-A Northeast Southwest Division, which includes its former foes from the E.L. Western Division, including Akron, Altoona, Bowie, Erie and Harrisburg. The Northeast Division includes Binghamton, Hartford, New Hampshire, Portland, Reading and Somerset.
