LAST TIME OUT

The Bowie Baysox were shutout on Tuesday night by the Binghamton Rumble Ponies by a final of 2-0. Bowie was limited to just six hits on the evening. Mets rehabbing left-hander David Peterson scattered five of Bowie's six hits through five and a third innings, while striking out eight. Right-hander Joander Suarez pitched the final three and two-thirds for Binghamton, allowing just a single hit to the Baysox. Bowie starter Ryan Long allowed just one hit through four innings and struck out five in the loss.

SADDLING UP THE PONIES

Entering this week, the Binghamton Rumble Ponies own the best record in the Northeast Division at 18-13. Before their loss on Sunday, they had won a league-best eight in a row. The Rumble Ponies pitching has been a strong suit with the fourth-best ERA in the league (3.76). Eight of the Mets' top 30 prospects, per MLB Pipeline, are on the active roster-OF/1B Ryan Clifford (No. 4), C Kevin Parada (No. 9), RHP Blade Tidwell (No. 10), RHP Brandon Sproat (RHP), OF Alex Ramirez (OF), RHP Tyler Stuart (No. 18), RHP Joander Suarez (RHP), and OF Rhylan Thomas (No. 30).

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

RHP Brandon Sproat makes his Double-A debut today for the Rumble Ponies. Sproat was promoted to Double-A on Monday from High-A Brooklyn. In six appearances (five starts) with the Cyclones, the righty threw 25.1 innings and struck out 33 to an ERA of just 1.07. This is the 23-year-old's first professional season after getting drafted in the 2nd round of the 2023 Draft by the Mets. The Pace, Florida native spent four seasons at the University of Florida, including three with current Baysox OF Jud Fabian. Sproat was the starting pitcher in the Gators' College World Series opener last season.

SCORING STRUGGLES

For the third time in the last four games, the Baysox were held scoreless. Over the last 40 innings, the Baysox have managed to score just five runs. Bowie is still in the top three in runs scored (162) this season but has batted just .209 in the month of May, which is the third-worst average in the league.

ON-BASE BOWENS

After going 1-for-4 yesterday, 1B **TT Bowens** continues to own a batting average of .333, good for second in the Eastern League behind Hartford's Zac Veen (.341). After playing just 47 games last year due to injuries, Bowens is amongst the league leaders in several offensive categories. The 25-year-old is fourth in RBI (22), is fourth in slugging percentage (.567), fifth in OPS (.963), and tied for fifth in XBH (13).

WELCOME BACK WAGS

INF **Max Wagner** made his return to the Baysox yesterday after missing the first 32 games with an injury. The Orioles No. 14 prospect played in six rehab games (five with High-A Aberdeen) before rejoining the Baysox. Wagner debuted with Bowie last August and batted .252 with three homers and 18 RBI in 27 games of action.

RELIEVERS STAY READY

After four more innings and six more strikeouts from Baysox relievers yesterday, Bowie's bullpen continues to lead the Eastern League and all of Double-A in innings thrown (158.0) and strikeouts (200). 16 of the 17 wins accumulated by Baysox pitchers have been credited to the relievers. Opposing hitters are batting just .211 against the Baysox bullpen, which is good for the seventh-lowest average in all of Double-A.

BRIGHT AND EARLY

RHP **Trace Bright** makes his seventh start this season and the 10th of his Double-A career. The Orioles No. 16 prospect is coming off his longest scoreless start of the season where he went 4.1 innings with five strikeouts against Akron on May 9 in a no decision. The O's 5th rounder in 2022 has punched out six or more batters in four of his six starts this season. The 23-year-old makes his first career start against Binghamton this afternoon.

2024: Named to Bowie Opening Day roster. **Delivered 4.1 scoreless innings in most recent start on 5/9 vs AKR. Struck out five over three hits and two walks in a no decision. Has punched out five or more batters in five of six starts. Finished month of April with a 2.41 ERA over 18.2 innings pitched with 23 strikeouts. Went five innings each in three straight starts from 4/14 - 4/26.**

2023: Began first full season in minors in High-A Aberdeen. Made 22 appearances (18 starts) and struck out 127 batters in 82.2 innings. Led IronBirds in strikeouts. Finished four in South Atlantic League in strikeouts. Punched out a career-high 10 batters in just 3.1 innings in 2023 season debut against Wilmington. Posted a 5.04 ERA in the first half but pitched better in second half of season, posting a 3.55 ERA with 62 strikeouts over 38 innings. Earned promotion to Double-A Bowie on August 22. Made Double-A debut on August 26 at Erie. Struck out five over four scoreless innings on the road. Went at least four innings and struck out at least four batters in each of his first four Double-A appearances. Completed first Double-A stint with a 2.12 ERA in 17 innings over 20 strikeouts.

2022: Debuted professionally with FCL Orioles. Assigned to Single-A Delmarva on August 27. Struck out three over three shutout innings in Delmarva debut against Lynchburg. Finished first professional season with a 1.86 ERA in 9.2 innings.

College: Pitched three seasons at Auburn. Best season was his junior year in 2022 where he struck out a career-high 94 batters in 80.2 innings over 18 appearances (17 starts). Led team in starts, innings and strikeouts. Was only Auburn pitcher to start all 17 weekends of the season. His 94 strikeouts were fourth most by an Auburn pitcher since 2000. Helped Auburn reach Men's College World Series and earned the win in Tigers first CWS win since 1997.

Personal: Drafted in the 5th round of the 2022 MLB Draft by the Baltimore Orioles out of Auburn. Highest drafted pitcher signed by Baltimore that year after not coming to terms with third round pick Nolan McLean. Full name is Bob Ike Bright. Grew up an Orioles fan because he has family that lives in Havre de Grace.

During select games during the 2024 season, the Baysox will take the field as the Cangrejos Fantasmas De Chesapeake, as the Baysox look to continue to embrace the culture of local U.S. Hispanic communities.

Boasting a desire to better represent the Chesapeake Bay area, Bowie’s “Cangrejos Fantasmas de Chesapeake” identity came to light after research presented the existence of the small, yet active Atlantic Ghost Crab species in the bay.



CHESAPEAKE BAYSOX

On Sunday, May 26, the Bowie Baysox will take the field as the “Chesapeake Baysox.” This alternate identity was created to celebrate and learn about the conservation of the nearby Chesapeake Bay. The uniform tops are detailed with stenciled outlines of local wildlife, design, and architecture around the Chesapeake Bay.

In addition to activities around Prince George’s Stadium promoting the conservation of the Chesapeake Bay, the jerseys will be auctioned off following the May 26 contest, with proceeds benefitting the Chesapeake Bay Foundation.

BOWIE PIT BEEF

The “Bowie Pit Beef” is an alternate identity of the Bowie Baysox that pays tribute to the culinary culture of Maryland. The Baysox will take the field as the Bowie Pit Beef on both June 23 and August 4.

Pit Beef consists of top round cuts of beef, thinly sliced and prepared over a charcoal fire. The meat is cooked quickly at high temperatures and has a slight smoked flavor. The sandwich got its name on Baltimore’s east side in the 1970s, before being popularized by the 1980s.



COACHING STAFF

ROBERTO MERCADO

Manager

The 17th manager in Baysox franchise history, Mercado spent each of the past two seasons as the manager of the High-A Aberdeen IronBirds. He was honored with the Orioles organization’s Cal Ripken, Sr. Player Development Award following his first season with Aberdeen in 2022. Prior to the start of his professional career, Mercado spent 17 years on the coaching staff at New Britain High School in Connecticut. He began as an assistant coach in 2004 before being promoted to head varsity coach in 2011. In addition to coaching the New Britain baseball team, Mercado served as the Dean of Students for over 18 years. He also spent time as an assistant coach of the Yarmouth Dennis Red Sox in the Cape Cod Baseball League from 2014-2022 and was a coach in the Goodwill Series, where high school baseball players from the United States competed overseas in both Australia and New Zealand in 2017 and 2018.

AUSTIN MEINE

Pitching Coach

Meine joins Mercado in the move from High-A Aberdeen. Meine served as the IronBirds pitching coach in 2023, where he helped Aberdeen post the third-lowest ERA (3.81) and second-most strikeouts (1,363) across the South Atlantic League. He previously spent two seasons on staff at the University of North Carolina at Charlotte, where he guided the 49ers to the two highest single-season strikeout totals in program history. Meine has also worked on staff at the Premier Pitching and Performance facility in Missouri. He pitched collegiately at Lindenwood University.

JOSH BUNSELMAYER

Hitting Coach
