He also made a start with Milwaukee at Arizona back on April 12. Junk took a no decision in his last start on May 28 vs. Iowa. He yielded five runs (all earned) on six hits over 6.0 innings as the Sounds lost 14-9. Junk held a 1.31 ERA, 0.97 WHIP and .171 BAA through four April outings but has a 6.66 ERA, 1.64 WHIP and .314 BAA through his five starts in May. He was acquired by Milwaukee along with RHP Elvis Peguero and LHP Adam Seminari for RF Hunter Renfroe on November 23, 2022. Junk was selected in the 22nd round of the 2017 First-Year Player Draft out of Seattle University by the New York Yankees.

He pitched three innings in relief on May 28 at Jacksonville in a Charlotte 5-2 loss, allowing three runs (all earned) on seven hits. That was his return off the injured list, spending April 8-May 28 out of action. Parke's last start was on April 7 at Columbus in game one of a doubleheader. He went just an inning (H, 0 R, 0 BB, 2 K). He went 3-11 with a 6.90 ERA in 28 outings (25 starts) for the Knights in 2022. Parke made three appearances and two starts against Nashville last season, going 0-0 with a 6.92 ERA (13.0 IP/9 ER). On this day in 2021, the Sounds tied a franchise record with their 15th straight win in a 14-5 rout of Charlotte at Truist Field, matching the record set by the 1999 and 2018 Sounds. The team also set a franchise record with 14 walks in the game. The win streak would come to an end the next day.

The Future Brew Crew: Nashville currently has three players on the roster who are listed on MLB Pipeline's Top-30 Milwaukee prospects, which has been updated due to the recent graduations of INF Brice Turang and OF Joey Wiemer. Outfielder Sal Frelick is the No. 2 prospect, left-handed pitcher Robert Gasser is the No. 7 prospect and left-handed pitcher Ethan Small is the No. 11 prospect.

How Sweet It Is: Sounds manager Rick Sweet is in his fourth season overall and third consecutive season at the helm of the Nashville club. The reigning International League Manager of the Year, Sweet led the Sounds to a 91-58 record in 2022, 70-58 record in 2021 and a 77-67 record in 2014. He has served as the manager for Milwaukee's Triple-A club since the 2014 season and has compiled a 627-545 record during an eight-season span.
