YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels lost to the Somerset Patriots, 4-3. The Patriots took a 4-0 lead in the top of the first inning with a two-run single by Anthony Siegler and a two-run double by Jared Wegner. **Brandon Martorano** cut the deficit in half with a two-run double in the bottom of the fourth. **Will Wilson** closed the score to 4-3 with an RBI single in the seventh. **John Michael Bertrand** started and worked four scoreless innings after surrendering four runs in the first, finishing his day with seven strikeouts. **Nick Swiney** pitched three scoreless frames and struck out three. **Eric Silva** worked a 1-2-3 ninth. Brock Selvidge started for Somerset and allowed two runs (one earned) over six innings. Kevin Stevens closed out his third save.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels face the Somerset Patriots, Double-A affiliate of the New York Yankees, in the third of a six-game series. The two teams met in a three-game set in New Jersey to open the season in April, with the Patriots taking two-of-three games. This series is the Patriots' only visit to The Diamond this season. The Flying Squirrels are 14-9 this year against teams from the Northeast Division.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have gone 7-4 dating back to June 14. They had gone 4-10 in their previous 14 games from May 29-June 11 and 11-2 in the previous 13 games from May 25-28. That stretch came following a span where they went 1-12 over a 13-game span from April 28-May 12, including 1-11 on their road trip to Akron and Erie. They have won four-of-their-last-six series, taking five-of-six in back-to-back series against Reading from May 15-19 and on the road at Bowie from May 21-26, before dropping four-of-six against Erie at The Diamond from May 28-June 2 and again against Altoona from June 4-9. They followed by winning four-of-six June 11-16 at New Hampshire and four-of-six last week in Portland.

THE PATRIOTS had lost five consecutive games, all last week at home against the SeaWolves, before taking the first two games of this week's series. They finished the first half with a 32-37 record, which was fourth in the Northeast Division. The Somerset offense leads the Eastern League in homers (78). There are five Somerset players ranked MLB.com's top-30 Yankees prospects list, including OF Spencer Jones (No. 2), LHP Brock Selvidge (No. 10), RHP Zach Messinger (No. 21), RHP Trystan Vrieling (No. 22), 3B Tyler Hardman (No. 25) and RHP Danny Watson (No. 27). Baseball America's top-30 Yankees prospects list includes three Somerset players, including Jones (No. 2), Selvidge (No. 11) and Vrieling (No. 23).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander Will Bednar makes his Double-A debut. He last pitched on Friday for High-A Eugene at Spokane and threw two scoreless innings, striking out four. Bednar began the season with Low-A San Jose and made five appearances, going 1-0 with a 3.60 ERA. In his six games for High-A Eugene, going 0-2 with a 3.18 ERA. Bednar was selected with the 14th overall pick in the 2021 MLB Draft out of Mississippi State, where he helped lead the Bulldogs to a national title that year. He was named the College World Series Most Outstanding Pitcher after throwing six hitless innings in Mississippi State's Game 3 clincher that year against Vanderbilt.

FOR SOMERSET: Right-hander Zach Messinger makes his 13th start of the season and his second against the Flying Squirrels. Last time out, he allowed five runs over 4.2 innings in a loss against the SeaWolves last Friday. He pitched against the Flying Squirrels on Opening Day at Somerset on April 5 and allowed four runs in 5.2 innings. Last year, he spent most of the season with High-A Hudson Valley, going 1-10 with a 4.36 ERA in 21 outings. He was promoted to Somerset and made his Double-A debut on September 14, allowing two runs over 4.1 innings at New Hampshire. Messinger also started Game 1 of the Northeast Division Series at Binghamton and allowed three runs over four innings. Messinger was selected in the 13th round of the 2021 MLB Draft by the Yankees out of the University of Virginia. He is rated by MLB.com as the No. 21 Yankees prospect.

KOSS-SOME: After leading the minors with a .647 batting average (11-for-17), Christian Koss was named Eastern League Player of the Week on Monday. In his return to Portland to face his former team, Koss posted a league-leading 1.591 OPS and also led the circuit in hits (11) and doubles (5). He was tied for the league lead in extra-base hits (5), ranked second in OBP (.650) and SLG (.941) and tied for second in runs scored (6). Koss played for the Sea Dogs the last two seasons and was named the team's MVP in 2022. In those two seasons, he played 163 games for the Sea Dogs, batting .252. Koss started the season with Richmond and played three games before an injury placed him on the injured list from mid-April through early-June. In his 21 games for the Flying Squirrels this year, he is batting .433 (29-for-67), which is highest in the Eastern League (min. 50 PA) this season.

HIT PARADE: Over the last 13 games since June 12, the Flying Squirrels offense is leading the league in batting average (.303), runs (87), hits (140), total bases (208), OBP (.375) and OPS (.825) while ranking tied for first in doubles (28), RBIs (80) and walks (48). In those 12 games, the Flying Squirrels are averaging 6.7 runs per game and 10.8 hits per game.

BERICOTO BASHING: In his last 15 games dating back to June 6, **Victor Bericoto** is hitting .397 (27-for-68) with three homers, five doubles, five walks and 14 RBIs. After leading the Giants organization in homers (27) last year, Bericoto hit just one homer in his first 34 games this season through May 21. From May 22-28, he homered three times in five games. He went deep again on June 14 at New Hampshire and added a homer on June 18 at Portland. In his last 24 games since May 22, Bericoto is batting .350 (35-for-100) with six homers, six doubles, 11 walks and 23 RBIs. His 11-game hitting streak was snapped on Saturday night. Bericoto has picked up multiple hits in seven-of-eight games dating back to June 15 and is batting .485 (16-for-33) in that stretch.

WILL POWER: Will Wilson is batting .394 (13-for-33) with a homer, a double and eight RBIs over his last eight games dating back to June 16. He has picked up multiple hits in five-of-his-last-eight games, including three hits on June 16, June 19 and in the second game of last Friday's doubleheader at Portland. He hit a solo homer in the second game of Friday's doubleheader, the 27th of his Flying Squirrels career. He is tied for fourth in franchise history with his 27 home runs, even with Shane Matheny, Sean Roby and Devin Harris while trailing only Ricky Oropesa (37), Jacob Heyward (33) and Jarrett Parker (30).

TO THE MUNGUIA: Since being assigned to Richmond on June 19, **Ismael Munguia** is batting .346 (9-for-26) and has added two stolen bases. He has at least one hit in each of his six games played, including three two-hit games. He played 50 games with Triple-A Sacramento to open the year and batted .250 (36-for-144) in the Pacific Coast League. Munguia played 75 games for the Flying Squirrels last year and hit .282 (83-for-294), which led the team (min. 200 PA).

PACKING THE HOUSE: The Flying Squirrels drew an average of 7,113 fans in April for their home games at The Diamond to open the season, their highest April average in franchise history. The previous high was 6,891 in 2014 followed by 6,571 in 2019. This season, the Flying Squirrels are leading all 30 Double-A teams and are ranked fifth among the 120 minor league clubs in average home attendance (6,938).

PROSPECT WATCH: Four of Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects are on the Richmond roster, including OF Vaun Brown (No. 10), RHP Eric Silva (No. 20), C Adrián Sugastey (No. 23) and RHP José Cruz (No. 28). On Baseball America's Best Tools list, Sugastey is rated as the best defensive catcher and John Michael Bertrand is rated as having the best control. MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects list includes four Richmond players, including Brown (No. 15), OF/1B Victor Bericoto (No. 19), Sugastey (No. 23) and OF Jairo Pomares (No. 26).

THIS DATE IN SQUIRRELS HISTORY

In 2011, the Flying Squirrels beat the Harrisburg Senators, 9-3, at The Diamond. Chris Dominguez hit a grand slam in the seventh inning to cap the scoring, the first grand slam in Flying Squirrels history. He finished the game with six RBIs, which tied the single-game franchise record at the time. Charlie Culberson had three hits and scored two runs.

IN OTHER WORDS...
