### THREE-RUN INNINGS PROVE MAGICAL IN 9-6 WIN:

The Frisco RoughRiders prevailed in a back-and-forth affair against the Midland RockHounds 9-6 from Momentum Bank Ballpark on Friday night. After Midland (28-21, 60-58) had scored in the first inning in each of the first three games of the series, Frisco (25-24, 56-61) jumped out in front in the first inning on Friday. **Liam Hicks** ripped a two-run single to right before **Aaron Zavala** added an RBI double to make it 3-0. The RockHounds then came back in the bottom of the second with six runs against Frisco starter **Ryan Garcia**, chasing him from the game. In the fourth, the Riders had another three-run inning. After the bases were loaded on three-straight walks to begin the inning, **Jax Biggers** laced an RBI single, **Keyber Rodriguez** coaxed another walk to force in a run and **Evan Carter** tied the game with a sacrifice fly to left. The 6-6 score held until the sixth when Biggers jogged home on a wild pitch to score the go-ahead tally against Midland reliever Jorge Juan (1-3). **Trevor Hauver** and **Kellen Strahm** then hit back-to-back RBI doubles to push Frisco ahead 9-6. Strahm was the only RoughRiders hitter with a multi-hit night. Though the offense shined, the relief pitching highlighted the RoughRiders' effort. **Aidan Anderson**, **Justin Slaten** (4-3), **Robby Ahlstrom**, **Matt Bush** and **Triston Polley** all combined to throw 7.1 scoreless innings from the bullpen. Polley earned his first save by recording the final two outs.

### HE'S DOING BIG(GERS) THINGS:

RoughRiders infielder **Jax Biggers** has been showing off in the power department this season for Frisco. Entering 2023, his career high in home runs was four and on Wednesday, he hit his 11th long ball of the season. In his last 24 games, he has clubbed six homers while hitting .303 (27-for-89)/.421/.562/.983 with three doubles, one triple, six home runs, 17 RBIs, 17 walks and 17 runs scored. In August, he has a .975 OPS, which leads the team.

### NEW MONTH, NEW ME:

The RoughRiders have struggled on the mound this season, but in the month of August, they have been fantastic. In the 22 games in August, (10-12 record) the RoughRiders are second in the Texas League with a 4.20 ERA while allowing a league-low 16 home runs and .241 BAA. **Ryan Garcia** was brilliant on Tuesday in Corpus, allowing just two base runners on walks over six no-hit innings with six strikeouts. **Nick Krauth** then followed up with a second quality start, giving the RoughRiders their first back-to-back quality starts since May 31st and June 1st when **Owen White** and **Jack Leiter** completed the feat. On the offensive side in the month, Frisco is second-to-last in the Texas League with a .717 OPS and last in runs per game with 4.5 per contest.

### WINS AND LOSSES WITH RISP:

The RoughRiders won four in a row in Corpus Christi before losing nine of their last 12 entering Saturday's game. Over the four wins in a row, the Riders allowed just three runs on the pitching side (0.75 ERA) while scoring 4.8 runs per game and hitting .250 (8-for-32) with runners in scoring position. Over the last 12 games, Frisco has allowed 77 runs (6.13 ERA) while scoring 3.6 runs per game and hitting .232 (29-for-125) with runners in scoring position.

### HAUV YOURSELF A YEAR:

**Trevor Hauver** has been fantastic recently for the RoughRiders on the offensive side. On June 16th, he was hitting .218/.337/.368/.705, but in the 51 games since, he is batting .295/.411/.474/.885 with 14 doubles, six home runs, 30 RBIs and 39 walks. In those games, he has raised his average 40 points and his OPS 94 points.

### CARTER WALKS SO THE ROUGHRIDERS CAN RUN:

**Evan Carter** has been fantastic at drawing walks and getting on base this season. Carter's 72 walks are second in the Texas League despite only playing in 77 percent of the RoughRiders games this year. His 15.9 percent walk rate this year is fifth-highest in the league as well. He has walked 21 times in his last 23 games. His .409 OBP on the season is eighth in all of Double-A and among all 11 players in Double-A with a .400 OBP or better, Carter is the youngest at 20 years old.

### HICKS IS THE CORRECT PICK:

**Liam Hicks** has been as hot as anyone at the plate for the RoughRiders. Over the last 32 games, Hicks is batting .321 (35-for-109)/.440/.422/.862 with six doubles, a triple, a home run, 16 RBIs, 20 walks and 15 runs scored. In his last 19 games, he is batting .333 (21-for-63) with a .885 OPS.

### K'S BY KELLY:

RoughRiders reliever **Antoine Kelly** has been incredible out of the Riders bullpen recently. He allowed an earned run for the first time on Thursday in his last 21.2 innings. During that stretch, he had 25 strikeouts to three walks while recording four saves. He has converted on all 10 save opportunities this season. He was named Texas Rangers Minor League Reliever of the Month for July.

### ONE HOME RUN, PLEASE. AND MAKE IT GRAND:

The RoughRiders have had a knack for grand slams this year with **Evan Carter** hitting Frisco's ninth grand slam of the season. They are one of two teams with at least nine grand slams in all of Minor League Baseball. Seven different players have accounted for the grand slams (**Liam Hicks**, **Luisangel Acuña**, **Jax Biggers**, **Dustin Harris**, **Trevor Hauver**, **Thomas Saggese** (3) and **Evan Carter**). On July 5th, the Riders allowed their first grand slam this year, becoming the final Texas League team to do so.

### ABOUT NICK

-Went to Northgate High School in Walnut Creek, California (across the Bay from San Francisco, east of Berkeley). His senior season, he went 6-5 with a 2.20 ERA over 11 games.

-Krauth then went to the University of New Mexico for the 2018 season, where he was teammates with current RoughRiders pitcher Justin Slaten.

-After New Mexico, transferred to Diablo Valley College in Pleasant Valley, California where he went 5-4 with a 2.20 ERA. Following that strong season, he transferred again, this time to the University of Connecticut, where he was one of the best pitchers in the country for the 2020 season before it was cut short due to COVID. In his four starts, he went 4-0 with a 0.36 ERA and a .167 BAA. This included five one-run innings against the No. 1 Michigan Wolverines on February 23rd.

-Due to the 2020 MLB Draft getting shortened to five rounds, Krauth went undrafted and signed with the Rangers as a free agent on June 15th.

-Brother, Ben Krauth, pitched for the San Antonio Missions in 2022, making nine starts and recording a 7.18 ERA. In two starts against Frisco, the RoughRiders touched him up for a combined seven runs, six earned, over 7.2 innings while handing him two losses. Ben was released by the Padres organization at the end of the year and retired after six seasons of MiLB experience.

### 2023 SEASON

-Krauth made first appearance of the season out of the bullpen on Friday, April 7th, allowing three runs over four innings.

-In his first start, Krauth went shutout five innings at San Antonio on April 14th to earn the first win among RoughRiders starting pitchers.

-Threw four scoreless innings on April 20th before game was suspended due to rain in the top of the fifth with the Riders up 9-0, ending his night early. The Riders and the Travelers went on to finish the game on April 21st with Frisco winning 13-5.

-Allowed a run in the fourth inning against Amarillo on April 26th, snapping a 14.2-consecutive innings scoreless streak dating back to April 7th.

-Joined Triple-A Round Rock on May 2nd for a spot start and make two appearances. In his start, he went 3.2 IP, 2 H, 0 R, 0 ER, 3 BB, 1 K. Allowed a grand slam to David Freitas of Oklahoma City in relief appearance.

### 2022 SEASON

-Spent time as both a starter and reliever, going 4-7 with a 5.38 ERA in 17 starts and 1-0, 2.25 ERA out of the bullpen.

-An extreme groundball pitcher, Krauth rolled groundballs at a 50.2% clip with the Crawdads.

### 2021 SEASON

-Showing his durability, Krauth led the Low-A East and the Rangers organization with 102.2 innings pitched. He also made a team-high 20 starts.

-Earned Low-A East Pitcher of the Week twice, including once for a complete-game, one-hitter on August 28th vs. Fayetteville (9.0 IP, 1 H, 1 R, 1 ER, 2 BB, 9 K).
