



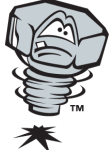

Today: It's a Tacos and Tallboys Night with \$4 tacos and \$4 cervezas, as the Lansing Lugnuts, the High-A affiliate of the Oakland Athletics, open a six-game series with the Cedar Rapids Kernels, the High-A affiliate of the Minnesota Twins. The Nuts are coming off dropping four of six games at Fort Wayne while the Kernels spent the last two weeks at home, winning four of six against Peoria before losing the first three of games of their series against Wisconsin before coming back with three wins in a row to split the series.

Starting Matchup: Lugnuts right-hander **Mitch Myers**, the A's 2021 12th-round selection from Pitt, makes his eighth appearance and his seventh start of the year, opposes Kernels southpaw **Jaylen Nowlin**, drafted by the Minnesota Twins in the 19th round in 2021 from Chipola Junior College, who is making his ninth appearance and eighth start.

Sunday: Lugnuts 2, TinCaps 1. Junior Pérez twice singled in **Jack Winkler**, **Christian Fernandez** tossed five innings, and the Nuts salvaged the series finale at Parkview Field.

LUGNOTES

Home / Road Splits: The Nuts are outperforming the opposition by a .255 to .235 avg at Jackson Field, led by strong showings from **Danny Bautista, Jr.** (.315 batting average in 22 home games), **Daniel Susac** (.329 average in 22 home games with a .404 OBP and .544 SLG), **Sahid Valenzuela** (.371 in 11 home games) and **Jack Winkler** (.301 avg and .402 OBP in 21 home games).

2022 Retrospective: The Soul Cycle. When the Lugnuts and Kernels met up in 2022, **Alerick Soularie** hit for the cycle on June 4 (single, double, triple, home run plus a walk in a 4-for-5, 3-run, 2-RBI showing in an 8-5 victory over the Nuts); he is the most recent player to hit for the cycle in a game involving the Lugnuts. Soularie is currently batting .205 with one double, no triples and one home run in 15 games for Double-A Wichita.

Master Noda: As first reported by Jason Burke (Locked On A's), 2018 Lugnut **Ryan Noda**, the second pick in the 2022 Rule 5 Draft from the Dodgers system, is leading the Oakland Athletics' qualified hitters in average exit velocity (92.4 mph). Noda is slashing .241/.400/.467 in 51 games for the A's with 11 doubles, one triple, six home runs and 33 walks.

Brisk Baseball: Ten of the last 12 Lugnuts games have been completed in 150 minutes or less, including eight games completed under two hours and 20 minutes.

Among the MWL Leaders: Outfielder **Jonny Butler** is tied for first in the Midwest League with five triples. Starting pitcher **Jack Perkins** is fifth in the league with a .193 batting average allowed, sixth with 40 2/3 innings pitched and eighth with a 2.88 ERA. Infielder **Jack Winkler** is tied for sixth with 11 doubles. Catcher **Daniel Susac** is ninth with a .281 batting average.

First-Round Pedigrees: The Lugnuts' roster boasts the A's last two first-round selections. 20-year-old **Max Muncy** was the 25th overall selection in the 2021 draft and enters the season ranked the A's No. 1 shortstop prospect by MLB Pipeline. 21-year-old **Daniel Susac** was taken 19th overall in 2022 and is the A's No. 2 catching prospect behind 1B/C Tyler Soderstrom.

TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2011: In 93-degree heat in Kentucky, the Lugnuts pounded nine extra-base hits (6 2B, 1 3B, 2 HR) among 15 total hits in an 11-7 win over the Hot Rods.

2015: Sean Reid-Foley struck out 10 Dayton Dragons in 5 2/3 innings of one-hit ball, and the Lugnuts blanked the host Dayton Dragons, 4-0. Anthony Alford went 1-for-4 to extend his on-base streak to 33 games. The streak ended the next day.

2018: Ryan Noda's first home run of the year was a dramatic go-ahead two-run tape-measure blast into the Chevy Terrace in the bottom of the eighth, and the Lugnuts beat the Lake County Captains, 3-2, at Cooley Law School Stadium. Teenage starter Maximo Castillo struck out nine in five innings in a no-decision.

In a Nutshell: Making eighth appearance, seventh start, tonight for Lansing... before Myers, the last Pitt Panther to start a game for the Nuts was also the only other Panther to play for the Nuts: T.J. Zeuch (pronounced "Zoyk"), the 21st overall pick in 2016, who made two starts in the Midwest League for Lansing in 2016, spent last season with the Cincinnati Reds, and is currently in Lehigh Valley (Triple-A - Philadelphia)... @mitch_myers9 on social media.

Hometown Hero: Hometown of Lanett's motto is "The Gateway to Alabama," since it sits directly on the Eastern border to Georgia, directly bordering West Point, Georgia... pitched for Valley High School as a freshman and sophomore and Opelika High School as a junior and senior, posting a career 1.22 ERA with a fastball/curveball mix, playing third base, and batting third... father Barry starred in baseball at Jacksonville State.

The Buc Starts Here: Initially committed to University of Alabama, joining juco Florida Southwestern State instead, making 15 appearances, 14 starts, in both 2017-18 and 2018-19... as a freshman: 5-6, 4.28, 2 CG, 73 2/3, 35 BB, 62 K, 1 HR... as a sophomore: 7-2, 3.29, 3 CG, 79 1/3, 23 BB, 88 K, 3 HR... became one of 10 Bucs to sign on with a D-I program (not including Ryan Gusto, who was drafted in the 11th round by the Astros).

Onward to Pitt: Upon transferring to Pittsburgh, made four starts in 2020 (2-2, 3.52, 23 IP, 4 BB, 30 K, 0 HR) before the season was shut down, with 10 strikeouts in six shutout innings vs. Lehigh... followed in 2021 as Pitt's Friday starter: 13 GS, 5-5, 3.21, 1 CG, 81 1/3, 23 BB, team-leading 83 K, 6 HR... tossed 9-IP CG at Virginia, 3/20/21, allowing three hits, one run, and whiffing five.

2022 Professional Debut: After signing for \$125,000 as the Athletics' 12th-round selection in 2021, did not appear in a Minor League game until 2022, spent entirely with Stockton... led Ports in starts (22, six more than the closest teammate), innings (124 1/3, 28 1/3 more innings than the closest teammate), and double plays (10)... worked seven innings five times, 6 2/3 innings once, 6 1/3 innings twice, and six innings four times: 12 starts of 22 starts lasting at least six innings... struggled in 12 games, 11 starts, at home (7.11 ERA, .304 avg, 16 HR, in 57 innings) compared to 11 starts on the road (4.14 ERA, .269, 10 HR in 67 1/3 innings)... lefties and righties hit nearly identically: .286/.355/.536 for lefties, .285/.339/.525 for righties, though righties hit 17 of the 26 home runs allowed... struggled mightily in first innings, allowing .353/.402/.627 slash line and six home runs... opposing base stealers swiped 10 bases in 16 attempts.

2023 with the Lugnuts: Opened season as the Nuts' Wednesday starter... tossed first quality start of the year on April 27, allowing two runs (both in the 5th) in six innings vs. Quad Cities April 27... followed up with a second quality start on May 4 vs. Dayton, though once again received a no-decision... has a 4.79 ERA in four home starts (20 2/3 IP) compared to a 2.13 ERA in three road appearances (12 2/3 IP)... struggling with leadoff hitters in innings: .455/.486/.545 with 15 hits, two walks.
