"FUN IS GOOD" FACTOIDS

LAS TIME OUT: In a superb matchup between dueling starters, it was Allan Winans who had the edge on the Twins' No. 9 prospect Andrew Morris as Scranton/Wilkes-Barre handed the Saints a 5-1 defeat in front of a packed house of 8,006 Friday night at CHS Field. Morris faced the minimum through the first five batters of the ballgame before allowing a solo blast to right fielder Bryan De La Cruz, giving the RailRiders a 1-0 lead. Scranton would add to their advantage with a sloppy fifth inning that included a throwing error by Morris, a wild pitch, and a balk that brought home the second run. On the other side, Winans retired the first eight Saints he faced before giving up a two-out double to Tanner Schobel, but retired Eeles to leave him stranded. Winans would get into hot water his third trip through the order when he conceded back-to-back hits to Eeles and Mickey Gasper in the fourth, but reliever Leonardo Pestana came on and struck out Carson McCusker looking in a big spot to hold a 2-0 lead after six. Winans lowered his ERA to a ridiculous 0.23 mark with just one earned run allowed in 39.0 innings to start the year. Danny Coulombe looked sharp on rehab with a 1-2-3 seventh and Cody Lawerson recorded a scoreless eighth in his season debut before Scranton got Alex Spears for three runs in the ninth. McCusker bombed one out the other way for his 12th of the season and second in as many games to lead off the ninth. The Saints drew back-to-back walks, but couldn't bring the tying run to the plate.

McCRUSHER KEEPS McCRUSHIN': Recently returned from his first-ever stint in The Show, Saints outfielder Carson McCusker currently ranks 5th in Triple-A in average exit velocity (see below). After homering in back-to-back games for the first time this season, the Sparks, Nevada native ranks 1-3rd in the league in homers (11) and leads all qualifiers in slugging% and OPS. On Thursday vs Scranton, he demolished a 463 foot homer that jumped off the bat at 115.2 mph, marking the third-hardest batted ball in Saints franchise history (Matt Walner-115.6 mph & Trevor Larnach-115.5 mph). It was the 7th-longest tracked homer in the history of CHS Field, the fourth-furthest hit by a Saints batter. McCusker has the four hardest hit balls by a St. Paul hitter this season and five of the top-10, including three batted balls that rank among the top-10 in exit velocity in Saints history.

IF THE SH(E)WMAKE FITS: RailRiders shortstop Braden Shewmake has done damage against the Saints this week at CHS Field, going 7-for-16 (.438), 2 HR and 5 RBI through the first four games this week. Entering the series, he had been 12-last-73 (.164) since hitting his first two home runs of the season on back-to-back games on April 3-4. It's not the first time Shewmake has put up big numbers against the Saints; two years ago while with the Gwinnett Striped (ATL), he hit for the second-ever cycle at CHS Field in the Saints' Triple-A era on June 28, and finished that series 8-for-18 (.444). Shewmake now leads all visiting players with a career 1.366 OPS in nine career games at CHS Field, and ranks second in batting average (.441, 15-34) among all opposing hitters with at least 25 at-bats in Lowertown the last five seasons.

ED(WALK) JULIEN: After drawing another free pass on Friday, Saints second baseman Edouard Julien now has the most walks in all of baseball (majors & minors) with 25 free passes since May 11. In that stretch, Julien has drawn at least one free pass in 15 the 22 games he's appeared in, all with St. Paul, and owns a .436 on-base percentage.

COMEBACK KIDS: Following Wednesday's win in which they trailed by a run in the middle of the sixth, 18 of St. Paul's 29 wins this year have been in come-from-behind fashion this season, tied for the most in the International League with Charlotte and trailing only nine teams in all of baseball (majors or minors, the Los Angeles Dodgers and three MiLB teams lead the pack with 21 comeback wins each). Since the start of May, the Minnesota Twins are tied for the lead in all of baseball with 13 come-from-behind victories, with the Saints ranking 1-7th in that span.

GOING, GOING, GONE: After hitting just 7 homers in their first 12 games of the season, which ranked tied for the 2nd-fewest in the Int'l League at the time, the Saints have touched off for 65 round-trippers in their last 46 games since April 14, which ranked 3rd in the minors in that stretch, trailing only Charlotte (70) and Greensboro (69). The Saints' streak of homering in consecutive games came to an end at 10 straight on Wednesday night, marking the longest stretch for the club since they homered in 11 in a row from April 27-May 10 last year. The Saints have gone deep at least once in 26 of their last 31 games since May 2. The Saints are 15-5 this season when they hit more homers than their opponents and 6-13 when being outscored.

HEY MICKEY YOU'RE SO FINE: Since being optioned to Triple-A St. Paul on May 5, Saints utility man Mickey Gasper has hit .350 (36-103) with 10 doubles, 7 HR, and 18 RBI in 27 games. Gasper leads the Int'l League in hits (36) and extra-base hits (17) since that date and his OPS ranks 5th in the International League (min 50 AB) in that stretch. Gasper has quite simply been one of the best hitters in the minors the last two years. Since the start of 2024 with the Boston org, he ranks as the 2nd best hitter in the minors by wRC+ (weight runs created plus, where 100 is league average, a ballpark and league adjusted measure):

PITCHING PARTICULARS: Despite some recent strong pitching performances, the Saints have struggled on the mound recently as they've yielded 136 runs across their last 22 games going back to the start of their road trip at Iowa. Since the start of May, St. Paul pitching has produced a 6.15 ERA (180 ER, 263.1 IP), the 3rd-worst mark in Minor League Baseball in that span. Despite the pitching struggles, the Saints' team OPS of .826 as an offense is the 4th-highest in MiLB since the start of May, and the best in the International League.

TWINS REPORT: The Twins (34-29) lost their homestand opener 6-4 to Toronto after leading 3-0 at End 3. Bailey Ober allowed five runs, the most given up since his first start of the season on March 30. Down on the farm, Double-A Wichita (29-26) topped Northwest Arkansas (SEA) on the road 8-2. High-A Cedar Rapids (32-22) have still won 7 of the previous 9 games falling 3-2 at Wisconsin (MIL). Twins No. 4 prospect Kalen Culppepper has hits in 8 of his last 10g, a stretch where he is 11-for-41 (.268) with 3 HR, including leading off both games of a doubleheader on Wednesday with home runs. Low-A Fort Myers (25-30) won 6-2 hosting Palm Beach (STL).

LAST APPEARANCE: Pitched in relief on Friday night at Werner Park after his previous two outings came in the St. Paul rotation. Followed Marco Raya out of the bullpen and immediately allowed a two-run homer to former St. Paul Saint Diego Castillo and allowed three straight hits to the first three batters faced. Pitched around baserunners in each of the four innings he pitched in and was the benefactor of a Saints comeback from down 6-3 and 7-5 to rally for three runs in the eighth, garnering McCaughan his third win of the year. Threw 31 sinkers (34%), 24 sweepers (27%), 20 changeups (22%), and 15 four-seamers (17%) while inducing seven swings-and-misses on the night, led by four on the sweeper and two on the change. Recorded two of his five strikeouts on the sinker, two on the sweeper, and one on the changeup.

I'VE BEEN EVERYWHERE, MAN: Last season was a tumultuous year for the veteran right-hander, McCaughan. After spending the first seven years of his professional career with the Mariners, he was traded for cash after being designated for assignment in February 2024, and spent the season on the Triple-A/Major League shuttle. He was optioned to Triple-A on five separate occasions, and also recalled to the Majors five different times, splitting the season between the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp and Miami Marlins, as well as the Columbus Clippers and Cleveland Guardians. After he was DFA'd by Miami and traded to Cleveland on May 9, the Guardians DFA'd him on June 30 and he was claimed off waivers on July by the Marlins, the same organization that had designated him for assignment less than two months earlier (he was optioned to Jacksonville and finished out the year appearing for both the Jumbo Shrimp an the Marlins). After signing with the Twins as a Minor League free agent in December, the Saints will mark the 10th different team that McCaughan has suited up for between the Majors and Minor Leagues.

A MEMORABLE FIRST GAME IN THE BIGS: Making his Major League debut as a 25-year-old, McCaughan realized a dream, making his Major League debut. The right-hander came on in extended relief for the Mariners on July 21, 2021 at Coors Field vs the Rockies. McCaughan managed to give up a run despite throwing five hitless innings: he worked around three walks without recording a strikeout, becoming only the third pitcher since the mound was moved to its current distance in 1893 to throw five hitless innings in his MLB debut, and the first in 54 years to do so (per the Elias Sports Bureau). The others to accomplish the feat were Bill Dillman on April 14, 1967 for the Orioles against the Kansas City A's, and Hank Borowoy on April 18, 1942 for the Yankees vs the Red Sox. McCaughan retired Raimel Tapia for a lineup in the Bot 2 for his first Big League out, and faced the minimum through his first two innings of work with the help of a double-play. He took a no-decision as the M's lost 3-6.

THIS GUY'S A REAL DIRTBAG, AND WE MEAN THAT AS A COMPLIMENT! Before being drafted in the 12th round of the 2017 Draft by the Mariners, McCaughan had a remarkable career for Long Beach State, where he pitched three seasons from 2015-17, accruing a 23-5 record and a sparkling 2.31 ERA with 234 strikeouts in 280.2 innings. McCaughan appeared on the Golden Spikes Award mid-season watch list as a sophomore in 2016 and earned 2nd-team All-American honors in both 2016 & 2017 from multiple outlets, becoming the first Long Beach State pitcher since Jared Weaver (2003-04) to do so in consecutive seasons. Long Beach's program compete in the Big West and are nicknamed "The Dirtbags," a moniker that dates back to 1989, when the then-head coach Dave Snow inherited a program in the doldrums. He put an emphasis on finding "hard-nosed players with something to prove" and drove his players to take a tough and gritty approach that included making diving plays, sliding hard into second, and generally dirtying the uniform. The nickname has stuck to this day. McCaughan is one of more than 60 former "Dirtbags" that have appeared in a Major League game, a list that includes Jason Giambi, Evan Longoria, Troy Tulowitzki, Jeff McNeil, and Jered Weaver.
