WSH AFFILIATE NOTES

Double-A Harrisburg dropped a low-scoring pitcher's dual against Akron (CLE) last night, 2-1..1B **ETHAN PETRY** clubbed his 13th Double-A homer, and 22nd of the season in the losing effort...22 homers are fourth-most among Nats Minor

EYE OF THE STORM: The Rochester Red Wings defeated the Omaha Storm Chasers for the third consecutive night, this time by a score of 13-3...an errant throw off the head of LF **SAM PETERSEN** sparked a four-run second inning, and two-run homers from both Petersen and red-hot SS **SEAVY KING** contributed to another four-run inning for Rochester in the seventh...seven pitchers saw time on the hill for the Red Wings, with LHP **MATT KROOK** earning his second win of the season...Rochester looks to make it seven-straight wins and pick up their 14th series victory of the season tonight, sending right-hander **CHANDLER CHAMPLAIN** to the mound against Omaha southpaw Ryan Ramsey...

The Red Wings have now homered in a season-high 14 consecutive games dating back to 8/5, the longest active streak in professional baseball, and second-longest by an International League team this season.

CHAMPLAIN POETRY: RHP **CHANDLER CHAMPLAIN** returns to Omaha tonight to make his 17th start of the season...the righty pitched as a Storm Chaser for the previous two seasons before coming to Rochester...the former ninth-round draft pick of the New York Yankees in 2021 has not allowed more than two runs in his last five appearances...among qualified International League pitchers this season, Champlain ranks second in WHIP (1.09), fourth in BAA (.243), and fifth in ERA (4.00)...tonight will mark the California native's 118th career start, which will tie RHP Casey Lawrence for the most in Minor League Baseball since he began his professional career in 2022...

As a starter this season, the righty holds a 3.35 ERA and a 0.91 WHIP in 83.1 innings of work.

KING'S COURT: SS **SEAVY KING** went 4-for-6 with three runs, two home runs, a stolen base, and a career-high six RBI Thursday night...he established career highs in hits and total bases (10), while tying his career high in runs scored...the multi-homer performance was the second of his career and first since 4/18 with Double-A Harrisburg...King has homered in a career-best four consecutive games, going deep five times during the run, and is riding an 11-game hitting streak dating back to 8/8...during the streak, he is slashing .489/.547/1.043 with eight multi-hit efforts, eight homers, 17 runs and 14 RBI...among International League hitters with at least 40 at-bats during that span, King leads in average, OBP, SLG, OPS, hits (23), total bases (49) and home runs, while ranking second in RBI...since being activated from the Injured List on 7/30, he is slashing .400/.481/.800 with a 1.281 OPS, eight homers, 28 hits, 22 runs and 17 RBI across 17 games...

The 2024 first-round pick entered 2026 with six career homers and has hit 18 in 85 games this season...he has established career highs in homers, RBI (68), runs (72), and total bases (191).

TREY'S THE LIMIT: CF **TREY LIPSCOMB** went 1-for-5 with a solo home run Thursday night, extending his hitting streak to 16 games and his on-base streak to 22...during the hitting streak, which began on 8/2, Lipscomb is slashing .368/.377/.750 with a 1.127 OPS, eight homers, 28 hits, 20 runs and 22 RBI...among International League hitters with at least 60 at-bats during that span, he leads in hits, total bases (57) and RBI, is tied for the lead in home runs and ranks second in average, OBP, SLG and OPS...his 16-game hitting streak is the longest by a Red Wing since Darren Baker hit safely in 17 straight in 2024...Thursday's homer was Lipscomb's 300th hit with Rochester, making him the second Red Wing to reach the mark in the Statcast era, joining Baker (321)...

Last night marked Lipscomb's first professional appearance in center field.

OFF THE WALL: DH **CAYDEN WALLACE** went 2-for-5 with two runs and his first Triple-A triple Thursday, extending his hitting streak to four games...his two hits raised his season total between Harrisburg and Rochester to 118, second-most in the Nationals' system...the triple was his 47th extra-base hit, matching his single-season career high, and increased his career-best total bases mark to 215, second-most in the organization...his 74 runs are one shy of matching another career high.

SAM I AM: LF **SAM PETERSEN** went 2-for-5 with two runs and a two-run homer Thursday night...his 371-foot blast in the seventh marked his second Triple-A homer and extended his single-season career high to 15 between Harrisburg and Rochester...Petersen's five total bases set a Triple-A career high, while his two hits and two RBI matched his best at the level...both of his Rochester homers have come on the road...

13 of Petersen's 15 homers this season have come against right-handed pitching.

MAD MAX: C **MAXWELL ROMERO JR.** extended his hit streak to four games admista 2-for-4 showing at the plate in Rochester's blowout 13-1 win over Omaha...it was his 18th multi-hit game of the campaign between Double-A Harrisburg and Rochester and sixth as a Red Wing...the former 2022 ninth-round pick of the Nationals is slashing .378/.472/.822 with six round trippers and 14 RBI, his OPS (1.294) is good for first among International League hitters who have at least 45 at-bats in road games this season...since being elevated from Double-A on 7/17, the former Miami Hurricane has reached base in 18 of 23 games, while launching seven long balls and knocking in 21.

Entering his fourth professional season, all with the Nationals organization after he was selected in the seventh round of the 2022 MLB Draft out of Texas Christian University.

- Optioned to Rochester on 8/4 after pitching 10.5 innings for the Nationals since his recall to the team on 6/29...allowed just one hit in his last four appearances with Washington.
- Since returning to the mound for Rochester on 8/4, the right-hander has tossed 9 innings across five appearances, only allowing one run, striking out 17.
- Recalled by Washington on 4/24 for his MLB debut the same day at Chicago-AL...allowed two earned on two hits across 2.0 innings of relief, striking out one and walking four.
- Named Nationals Minor League Pitcher of the Year in 2025 with a 6-7 record, 3.28 ERA (49 ER/134.1 IP), 135 strikeouts, and 55 walks across 27 games (26 GS) between High-A Wilmington, Double-A Harrisburg and Triple-A Rochester, setting career marks in nearly every category.
- Began the season with High-A Wilmington...transferred to Double-A Harrisburg on 5/23, and Triple-A Rochester on 8/6.
- Matched his career-high three times with 7.0 innings pitched (4/23, 5/17, 6/19)...set a career-high with 10 strikeouts in game one of a doubleheader on 4/12 against Hub City (TEX).
- Across seven appearances (6 GS) from 6/8-7/27 with Double-A Harrisburg, allowed just five earned across 39.2 innings (1.13 ERA) while holding batters to a .163 BAA.
- Made Triple-A debut on 8/7 at Norfolk, striking out seven across 5.0 innings.
- Has compiled 68 MiLB appearances (67 GS) in his professional career, surpassing 300 career strikeouts in his Triple-A debut.
- 2025 pitch mix; Sinker - 92.6 MPH, 58% usage; Changeup - 85.9 MPH, 18% usage; Slider - 85.0 MPH, 24% usage.

Entering his 11th professional season, first with the Nationals organization after he was acquired from New York-AL with RHP Ben Grable, RHP Jack Cebert, and RHP Jake Bird in exchange for INF Luis Garcia Jr. on August 3, 2026...originally signed with Chicago-NL as an international free agent on 8/29/2016.

- Opened the season with SWB...had his contract selected on 5/18...optioned back to SWB on 5/22, recalled on 6/30, optioned on 7/2, recalled on 8/1 before he was traded to Washington on 8/3.
- Made his Nationals debut, 8/5 at PHI (0.1 IP, 2 H, ER, BB, SO)...earned his first career hold on 8/7 vs. CIN (1.0 IP, BB, SO).
