LAST TIME OUT...

MOOSIC, Pa. (July 6, 2021) – Big innings in the fourth and fifth and a solid performance from the pitching staff lifted the Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders to an 8-3 win over the Syracuse Mets on Tuesday night at PNC Field.

The Mets took the lead in the top of the fourth when Wilfredo Tovar hit a solo home run against Luis Gil. That was the only hit and run allowed by Gil (2-0) in his 5.0 innings of work. The right-hander walked five and struck out seven.

The RailRiders answered back with three runs in the bottom of the fourth without a hit against Thomas Szapucki (0-4). Syracuse committed two errors in the inning and the RailRiders stole four bases in taking a 3-1 lead.

Scranton/Wilkes-Barre tacked on five more runs and sent 10 to the plate in the fifth. Ryan LaMarre had a two-run triple in the inning and scored on a throwing error, while Andrew Velazquez and Kyle Holder both added RBI singles against the Mets bullpen to grow the advantage to 8-1.

Braden Bristo worked around two hits in the sixth to spin a scoreless frame. Stephen Ridings allowed two runs in the seventh during his Triple-A debut, but only one was earned as the Mets clawed back to 8-3.

Reggie McClain closed out the win with 2.0 scoreless innings of relief. The victory broke a two-game losing streak for the RailRiders, and was the 11th straight over Syracuse this season.

KINGS OF THE HILL: Despite dropping the final two games of the weekend to Worcester, Scranton/Wilkes-Barre enters Tuesday's matchup with Syracuse with the best record in Triple-A at 35-16 (.686). This season, the RailRiders have set club records for best record through 40 games and 50 games. The RailRiders are on pace for an 89-41 season in 2021's 130-game Triple-A schedule, which roughly projects to a 96-44 season in a normal 140-game schedule. The RailRiders finished a franchise best 91-52 (.636) in 2016, when SWB captured its first and only Triple-A National Championship. SWB's .680 winning percentage is the third-best of any team in the majors or minors, with Charleston (37-16, .698) has the best record in baseball. At +94, the RailRiders have the second-best run differential in Triple-A, trailing only Durham's +122. Sugar Land (HOU) is third in Triple-A at +67.

BEAT THE METS: PNC Field is quickly turning into a house of horrors for the Syracuse Mets. In the first series between the clubs in Moosic this season, the RailRiders completed a five-game sweep of the Mets, a series which included two walk-off wins and four come-from-behind victories. Overall, under the Mets affiliation, Syracuse is just 2-13 at PNC Field, and has lost 12 straight contests to the RailRiders in NEPA, including the legendary Game 141 of the 2019 regular season. Overall, the RailRiders have won 14 of their last 15 games against Syracuse, dating back to 2019.

CAN'T STOP, WON'T STOP (REACHING BASE): RailRiders outfielder **Trey Amburgey** made RailRiders history this season, reaching base safely three times to extend his on-base streak to 33 games. In doing so, he passed **Brandon Drury**, who had a 32-game on-base streak in the 2018 season for the longest such streak in the RailRiders era (2013 - Present). Here is a look inside the numbers during Trey's incredible run:

- The streak began on August 26, 2019, when Amburgey went 1-for-3 with a HBP at the Pawtucket Red Sox.
- He has hit .333/.421/.590 during the now 39-game streak, with 30 R, 14 2B, 1 3B, 7 HR, 39 RBI, 19 BB, 40 K and 5 HBP.
- The streak has included 10 multi-hit games and 12 multi-RBI games.
- During the streak, Amburgey has only gone hitless five times, including in each of the final three games at Worcester (6/30-7/3).
- That is the first time Amburgey has been held hitless in three straight games since 6/9 (1) - 6/11/2019, when he went 0-10 across 3 contests.
- Amburgey had a 20-game hitting streak from 9/1/19 to 6/13/21 as part of the longer on-base streak, snapped on 6/15 vs Syracuse. He then hit in eight straight games, and has a hit in 29 of his last 34 games played.

BUT WAIT, THERE'S MORE!: In addition to Trey Amburgey's impressive stretch, the RailRiders offense features three other players with double-digit on-base streaks. Outfielder **Estevan Florial** carries a 17-game on-base streak into play on Wednesday night, infielder **Hoy Park** has reached base safely in 29 consecutive games, and outfielder **Ryan LaMarre** is the owner of a 13-game streak. Park sports a .510 OBP during his streak, which has propelled him to the Triple-A East lead in OBP (.497), SLG (.609), and OPS (1.106), and second in the league in AVG (.343). Both **Greg Allen** (22 games) and **Rob Brantly** (10 games) saw their on-base streaks snapped in last Thursday's quasi-doubleheader in Worcester.

HIGHWAY ROBBERY: After stealing just 39 bases in their first 45 games, the RailRiders have been on a roll since the start of the series at Worcester last Tuesday. In its last six games, SWB is 19-for-21 (.904) in stolen base attempts, including a team-record tying seven on 6/29 at Worcester and another five on 7/6 vs Syracuse. Seven steals in a game tied a franchise mark set by the SWB Yankees on June 6, 2008 against the Norfolk Tides. **Andrew Velazquez** accomplished the rare feat of stealing three bases in one inning, while **Estevan Florial** (2), **Hoy Park** and **Ryan LaMarre** (1 each) all stole bags against the Red Sox. The barrage has SWB up to 58 steals on the year, fourth in Triple-A East, with Syracuse and Worcester leading the way with 68.

BULLS ON PARADE: Since **Kyle Barraclough** relieved **Albert Abreu** in the sixth inning of the RailRiders game at Buffalo on Friday, June 11, the SWB bullpen has performed at an amazing clip. In the last 24 days, the bullpen has combined for a 2.19 ERA (25 ER/102.2 IP), while allowing just 77 hits, 29 walks and recording 123 strikeouts. The current stretch has lowered SWB's bullpen ERA to 2.88 on the season, tied for the third-best in MiLB (1st, Harrisburg, 2.41). The bullpen's 29 wins are tied for second-most in the minors behind only Tampa's 35.

LAST TIME OUT: After being bounced to the bullpen for his last two appearances, Koerner returns to the RailRiders starting rotation for tonight's doubleheader with the Syracuse Mets. The right-hander last appeared in a game on Saturday, July 3 at Worcester, where he threw two scoreless innings. After setting the WooSox down 1-2-3 in the sixth, he allowed back-to-back singles to Jarren Duran and MLB rehabber Christian Arroyo in the seventh, before retiring the next three batters.

WELCOME BACK, KOERNER: After not playing in the 2020 season due to the COVID-19 pandemic, Brody Koerner returns to the RailRiders for his third season with the club. He has the distinction of being the longest-tenured pitcher on the team who has stayed within the Yankees organization, with 41 appearances (30 starts) spread out since the start of the 2018 season. Only teammate Adam Warren (69 G) has made more appearances with SWB than Koerner, but left the Yankees organization on multiple occasions. Warren (56 GS) also has more starts with the RailRiders/SWB Yankees than Koerner.

STAFF WORKHORSE: During the 2019 season, Koerner logged 138.2 innings between Double-A Trenton and Triple-A Scranton/Wilkes-Barre, tying him for most among Yankees minor leaguers (Miguel Yajure -- Charleston, Tampa). The right-hander also finished 3rd in GS (22), 6th in AVG (.289) and Winning Percentage (4-8 combined), 7th in ERA (5.00) and WHIP (1.53), and 10th in K (109).

HEADING OVERSEAS: Following the 2019 season, Koerner left the country to play for the Gigantes del Cibao in the Dominican Winter League. It was the first time in his career that he played in a foreign winter league after the regular MLB season. Koerner went 1-3 with a 2.17 ERA in seven starts with the Gigantes, striking out 21 and walking 17 in 29.0 innings. The right-hander was teammates with several former SWB RailRiders in the DWL, including Abiatal Avelino, Greg Bird, José DePaula, Anyelo Gómez and Adonis Rosa. Also appearing for the team were Wander Franco (No. 1 prospect in baseball) and Eloy Jimenez. Syracuse starter Jesus Reyes also played for the Gigantes.

- Has allowed 2-or-fewer earned runs in 10 of his 11 appearances this season.

- Graduated from Jay M. Robinson HS (NC) where he lettered three years in baseball, three in basketball and one in football. Was a two-time All-State selection in baseball.
- Born in Winchester, VA but grew up in Concord, NC, a suburb of Charlotte.

LAST TIME OUT: After beginning the season as a member of the starting rotation, Keller has made his four appearances for the RailRiders out of the bullpen. Those stints have seen him pitch to a stingy 1.17 ERA, and he has been trusted to finish games in three straight appearances. On Saturday, July 3, Keller allowed a walk and struck out two in the bottom of the eighth at Worcester, keeping the game at 4-3 Red Sox. In his last 4.0 innings (3 G), Keller has walked only one and struck out four while allowing two hits.

WALK IT OFF: Brian Keller has the dubious distinction of leading Triple-A East pitchers in walk rate (min. 15.0 IP) entering play on June 9. In 17.0 innings, Keller's 10.59 BB/9 is more than Garrett Williams' (Memphis) 9.98 BB/9, while Stephen Gonsalves (Worcester) 7.77 BB/9 rates third. By BB%, Keller still paces the circuit at 24.7%, while Williams and Gonsalves check in at second and third again, respectively. The right-hander also leads all upper minor league (AAA and AA) pitchers in both categories.

JOINING THE NO-NO PARADE IN 2019: Keller began the 2019 season on the I.L. due to an elbow injury, and made his season-debut on 6/17 with Staten Island. After one rehab appearance, he was transferred to Double-A Trenton. The highlight of his season came on August 1, when he threw a 7-inning no-hitter against the Altoona Curve, allowing only one walk and needing only 70 pitches. It was the second no-hitter for the Thunder in the season and the 8th in the Eastern League.

LATE ROUND GEM?: The Yankees drafted Keller in the 39th round of the 2016 First-Year Player Draft, a round which no longer exists (MLB shortened draft to 20 rounds for 2021). While it is uncommon for a 39th-round pick to even make it as far as Triple-A, there is precedent for success from the late rounds. Four-time AL All-Star Kenny Rogers was taken in the 39th round in the 1982 draft and accumulated 50.7 bWAR. Mark Buehrle (59.3 bWAR) was a 38th round pick, and current RailRiders LHP Nestor Cortes was chosen in the 36th round of the 2013 draft by the Yankees.
