## LAST GAME

The Baysox dropped a 10-inning affair, 4-3, to the Somerset Patriots on Thursday night. Three straight singles in the bottom of the first, including an RBI knock from Jasson Dominguez gave Somerset an early 1-0, but that was the only run allowed through five frames for Bowie starter Alex Pham. The Baysox took a 2-1 lead in the top of the second on a two-run home run from Tim Susnara, stretching the lead to 3-1 on an RBI single from Shayne Fontana in the fourth. However, Bowie was unable to close the game out, as Josh Breaux tied the game with a two-run home run in the bottom of the ninth, before a walk-off single in the tenth by Mickey Gasper won the game for the Patriots. The loss marked the fourth time Bowie has been walked-off by an opponent this season

### TODAY'S OPPONENT

The Somerset Patriots enter today with a record of 55-36 - the second-best mark in the Eastern League. The Double-A affiliate of the New York Yankees, Somerset has already clinched a postseason berth as first half champions in the Northeast division, but have a current record of 13-10 in the second half. The Patriots took four of six from the Baysox at Prince George's Stadium to open the second half a little under a month ago Somerset continues to hold the best ERA (3.72) in the league, with the most strikeouts (946) as well. Offensively, they lead the league in home runs (139) and walks (453). The Patriots' roster includes eight of the Yankees' top 30 prospects, per MLB Pipeline, highlighted by OF Jasson Dominguez (No. 1 NYY / No. 41 overall), INF Trey Sweeney (No. 5 NYY), OF Elijah Dunham (No. 16 NYY), and IF Tyler Hardman (No. 18 NYY).

#### TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

Left-hander Nestor Cortes is set to start on the mound tonight for Somerset, on a Major League rehab assignment. Cortes has been on the injured list for the Yankees since early June with a left rotator cuff strain. Cortes has already made one start with Somerset on this Major League rehab assignment, as he pitched this past Sunday in Hartford, allowing one run on four hits with four strikeouts across 2.1 innings, firing 42 pitches (31 strikes) in the process. Cortes was originally signed by the Yankees in the 36th round of the 2013 MLB Draft. He's spent the bulk of his career with the Yankees' organization, most recently signing with the team in January of 2021 as a free agent. However, Cortes was claimed off waivers by the Orioles in December of 2017 and made his Major League debut with the Orioles in April of 2018. He made four relief appearances for Baltimore before being designated for assignment. Despite spending parts of three seasons in the Eastern League (2016-18) with Double-A Trenton (former Yankees' affiliate), Cortes has only faced the Baysox once in his career. He fired five, one-run innings against Bowie back on June 10, 2017. A native of Surgidero de Batabano, Cuba, Cortes features a 4-seam fastball, cutter, sweeper, changeup, slider, and sinker.

### AVOIDING THE TRAFFIC

While the Baysox sit with the fourth-most home runs in the Eastern League at 98. Bowie has struggled with the timeliness of its long balls. The Baysox have hit the third-most solo shots in the league at 60 total. However, in terms of portions, just over 61% of Bowie's home runs have been solo blasts. That is the highest portion of any team in the Eastern League.

### COMEBACK KIDS

The Baysox have been on their hottest stretch of the season as of late, as Bowie has won 11 of its last 15 games. In that span, the Baysox have faired particularly well with coming from behind. Six of Bowie's last seven wins have been in come-from-behind fashion, when trailing entering the sixth inning or later. The Baysox have a +5 run differential in the sixth inning or later during that stretch, while having a -20 run differential late in games on the season.

## ONE RUN REBOUND

Despite falling on Thursday, the Baysox have still turned a corner in one-run games this season. Thursday night was Bowie's first one-run loss in its last eight such contests. Dating back to June 2, the Baysox have faired incredibly well in one-run games, going 13-4. Bowie is 19-13 overall in games decided by one run in 2023, after going just 21-29 last season, giving them the most one-run losses in Minor League Baseball in 2022, along with the second-lowest winning percentage in the Eastern League in such games.

#### LET HIM COOK

Billy Cook has enjoyed a breakout at the Double-A level in the summer months. Cook has hit .310 since the calendar flipped to June - the eighth-highest average in the Eastern League among players with at-least 100 plate appearances. Cook's 19 extra-base hits in that stretch (10 doubles, a triple, eight home runs) are also fifth-most in the league, while his 13 stolen bases, in as many attempts, are fourth-most. Cook has hits in 12 of 13 games and leads active Baysox players in home runs (12), RBI (49), stolen bases (18), on-base percentage (.329), slugging percentage (.453) and OPS (.782).

# COACHING STAFF

Manager - Kyle Moore

2023 will be Kyle Moore's second season as the manager of the Baysox, and his 14th within the Orioles' organization. After leading Bowie to a division-best 41-28 through the back half of last season, Moore continues to display consistency at the helm of recent successful teams throughout the Orioles system. Moore led Class-A Delmarva to a minor league-best 90 wins as manager in 2019. The Shorebirds were named MiLB.com's Team of the Year and Moore won South Atlantic Manager of the Year honors. Moore's career managerial record sits at 254-216 (.540) entering the 2023 season. Prior to his managerial career, Moore also spent three seasons as a player/coach in the Orioles system (2013 Frederick Keys, 2014 Bowie Baysox, 2015 Delmarva Shorebirds). He then took a position as the Shorebirds hitting coach in 2016, before joining the Keys in the same role in 2017. Moore played collegiately at Alabama, before signing with Baltimore as an undrafted free agent in 2010. He currently resides in Sarasota alongside his wife Whitney, and his two daughters. Madilyn and Cameron.

Hitting Coach - Sherman Johnson

Sheman Johnson makes his coaching debut, as he joins the Baysox staff as the hitting coach in 2023. Johnson had a brief stint in the major leagues with the Los Angeles Angels back in 2018 and spent parts of nine minor league seasons across the Angels, Reds and Minnesota Twins organizations. Johnson's playing career most recently landed him in independent ball this past season with the Kane County Cougars. Johnson also played two seasons collegiately at Florida State.

Pitching Coach - Forrest Herrmann

Forrest Hermann joins the Bowie Baysox coaching staff in his second season with the Orioles organization. He served as the pitching coach of the Aberdeen Iron-Birds during the 2022 season, helping Aberdeen clinch a first-half division title and make it all the way to game three of the South Atlantic League Championship Series. Hermann guided one of the best staffs in the SAL last season, which led the league in strikeouts. Prior to joining the Orioles organization, Hermann spent two seasons as a pitching coach within the Cincinnati Reds organization. Hermann also served as a pitching strategist in 2019 for the Seattle Mariners organization at their facility in Peoria. Hermann also worked with current Orioles' left-hander John Means at P3 Premier Pitching Performance center in Missouri. He pitched for three seasons at the University of Evansville prior to his coaching career.

Fundamentals Coach - Tim DeJohn

Tim DeJohn returns to the Baysox in 2023 for a second season as Fundamentals coach. However, DeJohn also received a promotion this season and will also serve as the Minor League Infield Coordinator at all levels. DeJohn has been a part of the Orioles' staff since November 2019. Prior to joining the organization, DeJohn had an extensive background in the college ranks. He served as an assistant coach at the University of Memphis between 2017 and 2019 and was an assistant at the University of Hartford the two seasons prior. DeJohn played at Western Connecticut State from 2003-2008.

Development Coach - Ryan Goll

Ryan Goll, much like pitching coach Forrest Herrmann, is making a jump from High-A in 2023. Goll serves as the Baysox development coach for his first season in Bowie, after filling the same role for Aberdeen last season. Goll has also been promoted to Offseason Camp Coordinator entering 2023. Goll first served as a Player Development Intern for the Orioles organization in 2020, before joining the minor league staff full-time in 2021. Goll attended the University of Minnesota, where he began as a bullipen catcher and Head Student Manager from 2015-2018, before moving on to be a Student Undergraduate Assistant Coach in September of 2018.
