LAST TIME OUT: Brooklyn clinched a series victory thanks to a 7-3 win over Hudson Valley on Saturday night...LHP Felipe De La Cruz struck out a career-high 13 batters in the win, over 6.0 scoreless innings...The southpaw gave up only one walk and two hits while throwing 62 of his 90 pitches for strikes...CF Stanley Consuegra clobbered a home run for the second straight day - a leadoff solo shot to left field in Brooklyn's first at-bat of the contest...RF Karell Paz also launched a home run, a three-run blast as part of a fiverun fourth inning for Brooklyn...3B Nick Lorusso and DH William Lugo also finished with multi-hit nights...The Cyclones have now won six of their last seven games.

DR. DREW: RHP Drew Smith joins the Cyclones on a Major League rehab assignment on Sunday...The 30-year-old is the third different player to Brooklyn on MLB rehab in 2024... RHP Sean Reid-Foley and RHP Tylor Megill made one appearance each on April 14 vs. Asheville and April 27 vs. Wilmington, respectively...Smith was placed on the New York Mets' 15-day injured list with right shoulder soreness on April 27 (retro 4/24)...The Dallas Baptist alum joined Triple-A Syracuse for rehab on May 8 and made two appearances, allowing one run on one hit over 2.0 innings before being shut back down...In 10 relief appearances at the Major League level this year, Smith is 1-0 with a 2.70 ERA (3 ER in 10.0 IP) with one save, seven walks, and 11 K's...The Texas native was acquired by the New York Mets from the Tampa Bay Rays in exchange for former Cyclones INF Lucas Duda on July 27, 2017.

FELIP-IN' AMAZIN': LHP Felipe De La Cruz put together his best start in a Cyclones uniform on Saturday night against Hudson Valley...The 23-year-old celebrates his birthday after having shut out the Renegades for 6.0 innings with a career-high 13 strikeouts - one shy of the single game Brooklyn franchise record of 14 set by LHP Mike Cox (8/25/01 vs. HV) and RHP Brad Holt (7/24/08 vs. VER)...De La Cruz was the first Cyclone to strike out 13+ hitters in a single contest since RHP Rob Gsellman accomplished the feat on August 24, 2013, at Vermont...De La Cruz is the sixth Cyclones pitcher ever to hit the 13 punchout threshold and the third to strikeout 13 or more in 6.0 or fewer innings...De La Cruz enters play on Sunday with the eighth lowest ERA in the South Atlantic League (2.68)...The Dominican native is also tied for fifth in strikeouts (50) and seventh in the circuit in innings pitched (40.1).

HE'S THE HOME RUN KING: OF Stanley Consuegra has been on a tear lately...Brooklyn's all-time leader in extra-base hits (73), home runs (33), and RBI (108) has homered in back-to-back contests - a grand slam Friday and a leadoff home run Saturday...Over the past seven games, Consuegra is slashing, 333/,484/.917 with an OPS of 1.401, while launching four home runs and two doubles during that span to go along with seven runs and five walks...The 23-year-old is also one hit away (163) from matching OF Alex Ramírez's (164) franchise record for base knocks...He is also four doubles (34) from matching Ramírez's franchise mark (38)... On the final day of the 2023 regular season, he broke a tie with C Francisco Alvarez for Brooklyn's single-season home run record (23)...Consuegra also surpassed Alvarez (22) for the franchise record in career home runs on August 23 at Asheville...The Dominican native also broke the franchise's single-season record for extra-base hits (42) and tied the mark for RBI (63) set by Ronny Mauricio in 2021.

BASEBALK: The Cyclones' pitching staff set a dubious record on Saturday night, being charged with five balks...No team in Minor League Baseball has been charged with more than four...Since the MiLB stat portal began in 2005, no full-season team had ever been charged with 5+ balks in a single game...It has only occurred seven times in total and three times outside of the complex level...In 2023, the ACL Dodgers and DSL Pirates Blue were called for five on July 3 and June 8, respectively...The high-water mark is six by the DSL Cardinals on July 7, 2008.

GRAND SLAM-LEY: CF Stanley Consuegra blasted the Cyclones' first grand slam of the 2024 season in the fourth inning of Friday night's victory vs. Hudson Valley...The four-RBI blast was the first for Brooklyn in 2024 and the first since DH Omar De Los Santos clubbed one on July 23, 2023, at Hudson Valley...In fact, since the start of the 2023 season, the Cyclones' three grand slams have all been drilled against the Renegades...3B Mateo GII also smashed one in Hudson Valley on May 18, 2023...Consuegra's grand slam was the first by Brooklyn at Maimonides Park since CF Jaylen Palmer powered one vs. Aberdeen on June 12, 2022.

NICK THE QUICK: OF Nick Morabito has been as good as any offensive player in Minor League Baseball in 2024...The 21-year-old is second in Minor League Baseball in on-base percentage (.488), tied for second in batting average (.364), tied for seventh in stolen bases (23), and 12th in wRC+ (179)...Morabito stole three bases last Wednesday and did it again last Saturday...That mark is tied for the most by a Cyclone in the previous 23 years... The McLean, Va. native enters the day tied for 10th in the South Atlantic League in stolen bases (12) despite playing just 14 games.

**DO NOT ENTER:** RHP **Douglas Orellana** lowered his ERA to a minuscule 1.06 in Friday's win over Hudson Valley, spinning 4.2 shutout innings...Among arms with 34.0+ innings of work, Orellana leads the South Atlantic League in ERA (1.06) and is seventh in batting average against (175), and ninth in WHIP (1.06),...Orellana's 1.06 ERA (4 ER in 34.0 IP) is the fourth-lowest in Minor League Baseball among pitchers with 34.0+ innings of work.

LONG BALL LORUSSO: INF Nick Lorusso has quietly been one of the top hitters in the South Atlantic League in 2024...The 23-year-old launched two more home runs in Thursday's loss to Hudson Valley, marking his second multi-home run game of the year... Amongst South Atlantic League batters, the 2023 draftee is third in slugging (540), tied for third in extra-base hits (17), fourth in OPS (.925), tied for sixth in RBI (24), and tied for seventh in total bases (68)...His 159 wRC+ is also tied for third in the circuit...Among Mets' minor leaguers, Lorusso is third in slugging (.540) and OPS (.925), tied for third in extra-base hits (17), and tied for fifth in doubles (9) and home runs (6).

KADE YOU DIG IT: RHP Kade Morris put on a show in his High-A debut on Wednesday

vs. HUDSON VALLEY: Brooklyn returns home to play a six-game series against the Yankees' High-A affiliate...The Renegades possess six of New York-AL's top 30 prospects per MLB Pipeline: LHP Kyle Carr (11), INF Roc Riggio (18), INF Jared Serna (19), and OF Jace Avina (28)...INF Jorbit Vivas (15) and INF Tyler Hardman (25) have also joined the team this week on Minor League rehab assignments... The Cyclones went 14-10 against Hudson Valley in 2023, including a 6-6 record at Maimonides Park and a 8-4 mark at Heritage Financial Park in Wappingers Falls...Since 2001, Brooklyn is 144-145 all-time (.498) against Hudson Valley in 289 matchups.

afternoon against Hudson Valley...The 2023 third-round selection by the Mets tossed 6.0 innings, giving up only one run on four hits, while striking out seven and walking only one batter, all en route to earning his first career win...RHP **Jonah Tong** tossed 6.2 innings in a win vs. Hudson Valley on Tuesday, marking the first time Brooklyn has received quality starts in consecutive days since RHP **Tyler Stuart** (6.0 IP) and RHP **Blade Tidwell** (6.0) accomplished the feat on July 5 and 6, 2023, at Wilmington.

THE TONG SONG: RHP Jonah Tong earned his first High-A and South Atlantic League victory on Tuesday, tossing a career-high 6.2 innings of one-run ball...The 6.2 innings of work was the longest by a Brooklyn starter this year...It was the longest start by a Cyclone since RHP Jordany Ventura tossed 6.2 innings of one-run, one-hit ball in a win vs. Aberdeen on August 9, 2023...The 20-year-old's stretch of innings to start the year without allowing an earned run came to a close on May 8 at Rome at 26.0 frames...In nine appearances (even starts) between St. Lucie and Brooklyn, the 20-year-old is 2-0 with a 0.95 ERA (4 ER in 38.0 IP)...Tong is second among qualifiers in Minor League Baseball in ERA (0.95)...Only Arizona's LHP Spencer Giesting (0.66) at High-A Hillsboro has a lower mark...The Markham, Ont. native is fourth among qualifiers in MiLB in strikeout rate (38.3%) and his strikeout-to-walk rate (28.6%) is sixth...Tong's 59 strikeouts are tied for 13th-most in the minors.

**START ME UP:** The Cyclones' starting rotation has been one of the best in Minor League Baseball in 2024...Brooklyn holds the best ERA for starting pitchers in the South Atlantic League at 2.70..The Cyclones have the only starting staff with a sub-3.00 ERA in the circuit and hold a mark 0.54 runs better than the next team (Aberdeen; 3.24)...That ERA is also second at the High-A level and sixth among full-season MILB squads...Arizona's High-A Hillsboro holds the best mark in the minors and the level (2.26).

MAIMONIDES MAGIC: The Cyclones enter play on Sunday with a 16-7 record at Maimonides Park, but an 8-13 record in opposing ballparks...So far in 2024, Brooklyn holds the ninthbest home ERA (2.56) in Minor League Baseball...Arizona's High-A Hillsboro (1.96) has the lowest mark in Mil.B...In visiting parks, the Cyclones' ERA is 4.70.

WALK ON THE WILD SIDE: The Cyclones' offense worked a season-high 12 walks in last Saturday's win over Bowling Green...Brooklyn's previous season-high was 11 on April 21 at Jersey Shore and April 24 vs. Wilmington...Saturday's 12 free passes tied the Cyclones' franchise record...Brooklyn also coaxed 12 team walks on April 7, 2023, vs. Jersey Shore and on August 11, 2016, vs. Vermont...Individually, INF William Lugo has accumulated walks in droves in 2024...Lugo's 36 free passes are the second most in the league...Lugo's 21.8% walk rate is also second in the league and fifth in Minor League Baseball.

AND THEY'RE OFFI: Brooklyn swiped a season-high seven bases in last Saturday's triumph at Bowling Green...LF Omar De Los Santos and RF Nick Morabito each stole three bases, while CF Stanley Consuegra added a single swipe...The Cyclones' previous season-best was four on three occasions, most recently on May 8 at Rome...Brooklyn fell one stolen bag shy of matching the franchise record of eight set on August 2, 2017, vs. Tri-City...DH Walter Rasquin and RF José Miguel Medina each stole three bases in that affair, while 2B Edgardo Fermín and CF Quinn Brodey snatched the other two...The seven steals were the most in a game for the Cyclones since they also stole seven bases on August 15, 2018, vs. Vermont.

A THOUSAND VICTORIES: Brooklyn's 2-1 victory at Rome on May II marked the 1,000th in Cyclones' franchise history...Brooklyn has recorded a mark of 1,006-848 (.543) in 1,854 games since 2001...May 7's 6-2 victory in Rome marked the franchise's 200th since joining the South Atlantic League in 2021..The Cyclones are 208-217 (.489) in 425 games...Brooklyn captured its 900th franchise victory with a 6-5 triumph over Wilmington on August 14, 2022...Brooklyn's first win came in a 3-2 victory on June 19, 2001, at Jamestown.

**ATOP THE HEJ-ES:** RHP **Josh Hejka** earned his first save of the season on May 5 vs. Aberdeen, making his Cyclones' franchise-record-setting 48th pitching appearance in the process...The 27-year-old broke a tie with **Hunter Parsons** (47) for the most pitching appearances in Cyclones franchise history...In his 53 career outings for Brooklyn since 2019, Hejka has accumulated a 5-1 record with a 2.57 ERA (24 ER in 84.0 IP) and 5 saves, walking just 21 and striking out 72.

AMAZIN' STARTS HERE: The Brooklyn Cyclones have several Top 30 prospects according to Baseball America and MLB Pipeline...The 'Clones have three of the Top 30 per BA: Kade Morris (21), Jonah Tong (22), and Calvin Ziegler (29)...Ziegler is currently on the full-season injured list...Plus four of the Top 30 per MLB: Tong (20), Ziegler (23), Wilfredo

PROSPECT RADAR: Tong is considered the New York Mets' No. 22 prospect in 2024 according to Baseball America and No. 20 by MLB Pipeline...The 20-year-old is the highest-rated prospect on the Cyclones' roster.

TRAVELING MAN: A native of Canada, Tong's journey to professional baseball has included a lot of travel...After attending Bill Crothers Secondary School in Unionville, Ont., Tong moved on Georgia Premier Academy in Statesboro, Ga. for his final high school season...Prior to the 2022 draft, Tong participated in the MLB Draft League as a member of the Frederick (Md.) Keys...Accumulated an O-1 record with a 10.80 ERA (14 ER in 11.2 IP), 10 walks, and 14 K's in four outings (three starts)...Was a teammate of Aberdeen's RHP **Zachary Fruit** and former Cyclones and current Double-A Binghamton RHP **Jordan Geber**, whose rotation spot he is taking...He was also committed to North Dakota State University before signing his professional contract.
