

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: Hudson Valley scored 11 runs on 16 hits en route to a big win Thursday night over Brooklyn 11-4. The Cyclones allowed a season-high 16 hits and walked a season-high-tying nine batters. RHP Tommy Hunter tossed two scoreless innings as the starter, but the Renegades scored in six of the final seven innings. 3B Tyler Hardman went 3-for-5 with a home run and four RBIs, and OF Jasson Dominguez went 3-for-6 with a home run and two RBIs. Brooklyn INF Jose Peroza pushed his on-base streak to 18 games, going 2-for-4 with a double and two RBIs.

SUBWAY SERIES: For the final time in 2022, the Cyclones face the Hudson Valley Renegades. Last series, at Dutchess Stadium, the Cyclones won four out of six, winning a series at the home of the Renegades for the first time since the 2019 season. This year, Hudson Valley has won 14 games and Brooklyn has won 13 with the run differential favoring Brooklyn by +2.

DIVISION ON THE LINE: Including today, the Cyclones have 21 games remaining and four series: three more vs. Hudson Valley, six at Jersey Shore, six vs. Wilmington, and six at Winston-Salem. Brooklyn is vying for a playoff spot with a second half division title in the North Division of the South Atlantic League, sitting tied with Aberdeen in second place behind Hudson Valley by a half game.

PEROZA PRODUCING: Since July 9, INF **Jose Peroza** has a OPS of .876 over his past 31 games with an 18-game on-base streak. The 22-year-old Venezuelan has been on base in 29 of the past 31 games, hitting .304 with a .394 OBP. The current active streak leader is Rome C **Tyler Tolve** who has a 24-game on-base streak.

LUGO LOVING LIFE: 3B **William Lugo** has posted a .843 OPS over his first nine games with the Cyclones, going 10-for-37 (.270) with two doubles, two

vs. HUDSON VALLEY: The New York Yankees affiliate host five of the Bronx Bombers' Top 30 prospects, including two in the top 10. OF Jasson Dominiguez ranks second in the system and 42nd in baseball. SS Trey Sweeney ranks No. 6, LHP Yoendrys Gomez ranks No. 12, LHP Edgar Barclay ranks No. 29, and RHP Juan Carela ranks No. 30. The Renegades finished the first half nine games behind division-winner Aberdeen.

home runs, seven RBIs, five walks, and seven runs scored. Lugo posted a 124 wRC+ with Low-A St. Lucie before the promotion on August 8.

MASTERS OF THEIR DOMAIN: The Cyclones have allowed the fewest runs in the league in the second half and overall. Brooklyn ranks first in the North Division with a +18 run differential with Hudson Valley. The Cyclones have allowed just 181 runs over 45 games (4.0 runs/game) in the second half. The next-closest team is Hudson Valley, allowing 4.3 runs per game in the second half.

THAT'S OFFENSIVE!: The Cyclones have scored just 437 runs in 111 games (3.9 runs/game) which ranks second-to-last in the South Atlantic League and fifth-worst in Minor League Baseball in fewest runs.

BRETT THE BAT: Former Brooklyn Cyclones 3B **Brett Baty** made his MLB debut Wednesday with the Mets in Atlanta, hitting a two-run home run in his first at-bat en route to a 9-7 Mets victory. Baty played with Brooklyn in 2019 and in 2021 and becomes the 91st former Cyclones player to make the major leagues.

HELLO: Mets No. 25 prospect Christian Scott makes his second High-A start and first against Hudson Valley.

WILMINGTON DEBUT: Scott tossed four scoreless innings at Frawley Stadium last week, departing with a 1-0 lead. Scott was held to his pitch count, throwing 49 pitches -- 32 for strikes.

GATOR BLUE TO MET BLUE: Scott was drafted by New York in the fifth round of the 2021 MLB Draft out of the University of Florida, signing for around the slot value of \$350,000. At Florida, pitched as a reliever for his three years on campus, sitting mid-90s while touching 98.

COPYING MAD MAX: Christian Scott emulated New York Mets starter Max Scherzer's slider grip. He uses his repertoire of fastball and slider while trying to incorporate a change-up.

CONTROL FREAK: The Floridian posted a 4% walk rate as a junior at Florida ahead of his draft selection. During his time with St. Lucie, Scott posted a 7% walk rate.

HIGH SCHOOL: Scott went undrafted out of Calvary Christian High School in Fort Lauderdale, FL -- a school that produced current No. 1 Philadelphia prospect Andrew Painter who is on the Jersey Shore roster.
