SPRINGDALE, AR — Three home runs for the third game this week helped power the Northwest Arkansas Naturals to a 9-5 win over the Amarillo Sod Poodles, securing a series split for the Naturals.

- Michael Massey drove in his first of four runs on the afternoon in the first inning, as he brought home Maikel Garcia on a sacrifice fly to put Northwest Arkansas up 1-0.
- After Massey's sac fly, home runs powered the Naturals past the Sod Poodles, Logan Porter connected for his first of the season in the second, a two-run shot to left field. In the third, Robbie Glendinning blasted his third of the year, also a two-run shot to left that at the time cushioned the lead to 5-2.
- Massey added insurance in the seventh, connecting on his team-leading fifth long ball of the year three run shot that at the time furthered the Northwest Arkansas advantage to 8-2.
- At the top of the order, Garcia went 4-for-5, the first four-hit game of the year for a Naturals hitter. After scoring in the first, he came around on Massey's homer in the seventh and scored in the eighth as well, crossing on a wild pitch for a run of insurance.
- Starting pitcher **Drew Parrish** earned his second win of the season, allowing two runs across 5.0 innings with no walks and four strikeouts. Yefri Del Rosario followed Parrish with 2.0 scoreless innings and Zach Willeman finished the game with 2.0 more innings, allowing three runs in the eighth but with a scoreless ninth, striking out three in total.

## This Day in Naturals History

### The Naturals are 6-3 all-time when playing on May 3

On May 3, 2018, the Northwest Arkansas Naturals beat the Springfield Cardinals 9-2 at Arvest Ballpark, behind 8.0 innings on the mound from starting pitcher **Glenn Sparkman**. The fourth-year Natural surrendered two runs (one earned) across five hits and no walks, while striking out two over 96 pitches (69 strikes). Eight different Naturals collected hits, including three-hit nights from shortstop Nicky Lopez and designated hitter Nick Dini.

## THE CHAMPS ARE HERE!

Of the 28-man roster the Naturals rolled out for the Double-A Central Championship Series in 2021, six players are on the Naturals' 2022 active roster, with a total of 9 returning players with the Naturals this season.

- Pitchers Holden Capps, Yefri Del Rosario, Drew Parrish, Stephen Woods Jr. and Ángel Zerpa were all a part of the championship celebration last year, as was outfielder Seuly Matias.
- Additionally, catcher/infielder Gavin Stupienski and pitcher Alec Marsh both played for the Naturals in 2021, as did catcher Tyler Cropley, who is currently on the Injured List.

## FOLLOW THE LEADER

Manager Chris Widger enters his first season at the helm of the Naturals, after previous stops in *Advanced Rookie* Burlington (2019) and *High-A* Quad Cities (2021) managing Royals affiliates.

- 19 of the Naturals' 28 active players played for Widger with the Quad Cities River Bandits last season.
- 11 of the Naturals' 28 active players played under Widger with the Burlington Royals, then in Quad Cities and now in Northwest Arkansas: Dante Biasi, Jonah Dipoto, Maikel Garcia, Michael Massey, Jake Means, Drew Parrish, Zack Phillips, Logan Porter, John Rave, Patrick Smith and Ángel Zerpa.

## STAR-STUDDED ROTATION

All five of the Naturals starting pitchers to open the season are consensus top prospects in the Royals' organization, with all five listed in MLB Pipeline's Top-30 rankings for Kansas City.

- LHP Anthony Veneziano starts today and goes again Sunday for the Naturals ... MLB Pipeline lists him at No. 17 in the system, while Baseball America has him at No. 21.
- RHP Alec Marsh starts Friday for the Naturals ... MLB Pipeline lists him at
   No. 12 in the system, while Baseball America has him at No. 11.
- LHP Drew Parrish starts Saturday for the Naturals ... MLB Pipeline lists him at No. 29 in the system, while Baseball America had him at No. 38 in their preseason rankings.
- LHP Angel Zerpa has made four starts for the Naturals ... MLB Pipeline lists him at No. 13 in the system, while Baseball America has him at No. 20.
- LHP Asa Lacy has made two starts for the Naturals ... MLB Pipeline lists him No. 72 overall in baseball, No. 4 in the system and the No. 5 lefthanded pitching prospect, while Baseball America has him at No. 4 in the Royals' minor league system, the No. 4 left-handed pitching prospect.

### TOOLSY TEAM

Six active Naturals players were listed in *Baseball America*'s 2022 Best Tools Survey of the Kansas City Royals' organization.

- CF Nick Loftin is rated as having the "Best Strike-Zone Discipline" in the system.
- C Sebastian Rivero is rated as being the "Best Defensive Catcher" in the system.
- SS Maikel Garcia is rated as having the "Best Infield Arm" in the system.
- RF **Seuly Matias** is rated as having the <u>"Best Outfield Arm"</u> in the system.
- LHP **Asa Lacy** is rated as having the <u>"Best Slider"</u> in the system.
- LHP Ángel Zerpa is rated as having the "Best Control" in the system.

## Yo, You Wanna See Some Real Speed?

Through 21 games, the Naturals have stolen <u>34 bases in 39 attempts</u> (average 1.62 steals/game) and <u>pulled off a double steal 6 times</u>.

- 32 steals ranks second in the Texas League and tied for 19th in the Minors, while a 87.18% success rate on steals ranks fourth among MiLB teams with at least 30 successful steals.
- Maikel Garcia's 9 steals (in 11 attempts) ranks tied for third in the Texas League.

## NATE IS GREAT

Utility man **Nate Eaton** made a strong case last week to be the next Texas League player of the wee and has putting together a ridiculous eight-game stretch dating back to last week in Frisco.

- Eaton enters tonight's game on a eight-game hitting streak, the longest on the team this season ... since April 23, Eaton is 15-for-31 (.484 average) with two homers, six runs batted in, four steals and a 1.285 OPS.
- Last week, Eaton hit .417 against Amarillo, 20-for-24 at the plate with four runs batted in, three steals and a 1.087 OPS.
- With 11 starts (97.0 innings) at third base, 3 starts (27.0 innings) in left field, 3 starts (27.0 innings) in right field and one start at shortstop (9.0 innings), the VMI product is the only Naturals player who has spent time at more than two positions in the field.

## G'DAY ROBBIE!

Australian infielder **Robbie Glendinning** was a February free agent signing by the Kansas City Royals and has proven himself to be one of the best players on the 2022 Naturals.

- Entering Saturday, the native of Perth, Western Australia had reached base in all <u>15 games</u> he'd played started the season, but struck out while pinchhitting in the ninth inning to snap that streak.
- His 15-game on-base streak is the longest on the team this year and is tied for fifth-longest in the Texas League.
- Among 10 qualified Naturals hitters, Glendinning is the Naturals' team leader in on-base percentage (.464), slugging percentage (.630) and OPS (1.094), while ranking second on the team with 15 runs batted in, second in walks (14) and third in runs scored (15) ... his .464 OBP ranks third in the Texas League, while his .630 slugging percentage and 1.094 OPS rank seventh in the league ... 14 walks is tied for eighth.

### Gar-see ya on Base

Shortstop **Maikel Garcia** drew 10 walks through the season's first five games, and now has 19 on the season, which is tied for second in the Texas League and tied for fourth in Double-A.

- In 96 plate appearances, the Venezuelan has reached base 42 times, for a
   .438 on-base percentage (23 hits + 19 walks) ... he has reached at least
   once in 18 of the 20 games he's appeared in this season.
- Garcia ranks among the Texas League leaders, ranking tied second in walks (19) and tied for third in steals (9) and ninth in OBP (.438).
- Despite his on-base prowess, Garcia endured a five-game hitless streak from April 19 to 27, where he went 0-for-23 with five four walks, a span in which his batting average has dropped over 100 points, entering 4/19 batting .406, but was at .241 after April 26.
- Garcia drew at least one walk in each of the first five games he played, while walking twice or more on four occasions. He collected his first threewalk game on 4/13 in the Naturals' 8-5 win over Wichita.

- Chris Widger will manage the Naturals after guiding the River Bandits to a High-A Central championship in their first season as a Kansas City affiliate in 2021. In doing so, he was named the Minor League Manager of the Year by Baseball America following the 2021 season.

- He was the Royals first-round pick in the 2010 MLB Draft, scored the winning run in the 2014 AL Wild Card game and had the game-winning hit in the title-clinching Game 5 of the 2015 World Series.
