TODAY'S GAME

The Round Rock Express and El Paso Chihuahuas (San Diego Padres affiliate) are set for the final two games of their six-game series at Dell Diamond. Saturday night's game between the Round Rock Express and El Paso Chihuahuas was suspended due to unplayable field conditions following heavy rain. El Paso and Round Rock were tied, 1-1, as the game was heading to the top of the third. Prior to the suspended game, El Paso 1B Pablo Reyes drove in RF Jase Bowen with a single to left. In the bottom of the second, Round Rock RF Aaron Zavala led off with a single and later scored on CF Alejandro Osuna's base hit through the left side.

THE RUNDOWN

The suspended game will be picked up today, beginning at 12:05 p.m. with Chihuahuas RF Jase Bowen up to bat in the top of the third inning. The continuation of Saturday's game will be played to a complete nine innings. Sunday's regularly scheduled contest will begin approximately 30 minutes after the conclusion of the suspended game. Per Major League Baseball protocols for the 2026 season, the regularly scheduled contest will now be seven innings in length.

SBORZ ON THE SLAB

Round Rock RHP Josh Sborz is set to take the mound as we resume Game Five on Sunday afternoon. Sborz has made eight relief appearances for the Express, posting a 4.32 ERA (4 ER/8.1 IP) without a decision this season. The right-hander has tallied eight scoreless outings and hasn't allowed more than a hit in any appearance this season. He has struck out 11 batters and walked six while holding opponents to a .167 batting average.

TREY DAY

RHP Trey Supak is slated to start game two on Sunday afternoon, for his fifth outing (4 GS) of the year. Supak ranks second among Express pitchers with 14.1 IP this season. He holds a 6.91 ERA (11 ER/14.1 IP) without a decision. The right-hander's last appearance came in Tuesday's series opener as the starting pitcher against the Chihuahuas. Supak threw 3.2 innings and allowed four earned runs on six hits. He surrendered two home runs and issued two walks with six strikeouts.

LONE STAR CLASH

With a 3-1 series lead, Round Rock has the chance to clinch their first series of the season on Sunday. Their last win came in the penultimate series of the 2025 season, when the E-Train took six out of eight games over the Sugar Land Space Cowboys at Dell Diamond. The Express are also seeking their first series victory over the Chihuahuas since June 18, 2023 when they won five out of six games here in Round Rock.

ON THIS DAY IN NOLAN RYAN HISTORY - FRIDAY, APRIL 19, 1968

In his first outing at Shea Stadium in 1968, Nolan Ryan struck out 11 over 7.1 innings of work but was tagged with the loss after allowing two earned runs on six hits and four walks. In the third inning, Ryan recorded one of only two immaculate innings in his professional career.

The Mets took a 1-0 lead on an Art Shamsky sacrifice fly in the second inning. Tom Haller answered for the Dodgers with a solo home run in the seventh. Ryan returned for the eighth and allowed a one-out single to Willie Davis before Bill Short replaced him. Short then surrendered an RBI double to Jim Lefebvre, and a Rocky Colavito single added another run to make it a 3-1 game. Ron Swoboda led off the ninth with a home run for the Mets, but New York fell, 3-2.

After the game, Ryan departed for Houston for meetings with the Army Reserve.

George Vecsey of Newsday summed up the outing well: "He starts so beautifully, this slim young Texan with 53 professional games behind him and perhaps 500 ahead of him. He throws strikes and major league batters swing and miss. Then they shake their heads."
