Tonight's Game

The Clippers will send RHP **Rorik Maltrud** to the mound tonight, making his second start. Indianapolis will counter with LHP **Nick Dombkowski**. Columbus was 14-19 (.424) versus left handers last year. Dombkowski has faced the Clippers six times in his career, going 0-1 with a 4.60ERA (15.2IP, 17H, 9R, 8ER, 9BB, 15K), including once in Columbus (lost on 9/6/25; 4.0IP, 7H, 6R, 6ER, 4BB, 3K).

vs. the Indians

Columbus was 9-9 against Indianapolis last year, despite owning a +13 in run differential (12-5, +45 in 2024; 10-8, -23 in 2023; 12-8, +53 in 2022). Since the start of the 2022 season, the Clippers are 16-6 (.727) in games against Indianapolis that are decided by at least five runs. Individually, **Travis Bazzana** has hit .314 (11x35) with 4HR (all HR in Triple-A career) and 9RBI against Indy in his career (9G).

What a Week

The Clippers went 5-1 through the opening week (eighth time going 5-1 or better, first since 2021) and a win tonight would make them 6-1 or better for the fifth time, first since 1997 (advanced to the Governors' Cup each prior time, winning three: '79, '80 and '91). The 3-0 start in Huntington Park is the best since starting the home slate 7-0 in 2022. Dating to 9/3/25, Columbus has the IL's best record (16-7).

Slow Starts

Through the first 6G, the Clippers have plated just 12 runners across innings 1-6 (a third of those came in last night's 4-run 6th inning). From the 7th on, they have outscored opponents 19-5 (gave up 5-run 7th last night, last team in the IL to allow a run after the 6th). They have been beaten to the punch in every game this year (one of two IL teams to not score first) and own the most comeback wins (5).

Left Behind

Tonight will mark the first time this year that Columbus will face off against a southpaw starter (33G last year). Last season, 19.9% of Clipper plate appearances came against lefties (7th highest rate in the IL) and they hit .228/.307/.390 in such situations (worst average and OBP, 7th worst SLG). Columbus did hit 26HR off left handers (8th fewest), thanks to a power surge in September (6HR in 132AB).

Rule of Threes

Nearly half of the team's plate appearances end in one of the three true outcomes (46.7%, highest rate in the IL), as the Clippers rank 2nd in walks (44, -4), 3rd in homers (9, -4) and 5th in strikeouts (61, -11). However, only **Nolan Jones** (3/29) and **Kahilil Watson** (4/1) have done all three in one game. On the mound, only 36.4% of opponents' plate appearances end with a true outcome (5th lowest rate).

Double Rehab

Hunter Gaddis joined the Clippers on rehab over the weekend (strained right forearm) and has fired a pair of scoreless innings (1H, 1BB, 2K) in his first games with Columbus since 9/24/23 (151G with Cleveland in between). **George Valera** began rehab on Wednesday (strained left calf), going 0x4 (BB, K) in his 234th game with Columbus (missed 148G for Columbus due to injury from 2023-25).

Always Halpin Out

Petey Halpin nailed two runners at the plate on Tuesday, giving him his first outfield assists of the year (14 in last 49G in the IL, dating to 7/22/25). Since the start of the 2025 season, his 21 outfield assists (129G) pace all of minor league baseball and are 10 clear of 2nd place in the IL. He is also riding a 118G errorless streak, dating to 4/11/25 (committed 10E and had 150FA in 196G of Double-A career).

On the Upswing

After a slow start to his Triple-A career (.183/.299/.402 with 5HR and 11RBI in 25G), **Kahilil Watson** has hit safely in 20 of his last 24G, since 8/28/25 (.311, 28x90) while reaching base in each of his last 29G (.411OBP since 8/19/25). He has been active on the basepaths in that time, collecting 11SB (2CS) and scoring 19 runs. Wednesday's leadoff homer snapped a 31AB streak without an XBH (9/17/25).

Filling In

Game seven will find a catcher starting at 1B for the fourth time this year, with **Dom Nunez** getting his second start of the year (16th of career, all with Columbus; **Kody Huff** has 2GS this year and 6GS in his career). **Juan Brito** started at 1B last night (32nd career start, all with Columbus; 417 starts elsewhere in the field) and **Dayan Frias** started opening night (47th of 498 career starts).

This Date in Clipper History

4/3/2024

Seven Clipper pitchers combined for a 3-0 shutout vs. Omaha, scattering a trio of hits while punching out 18 StormChasers (**Xzavion Curry** had 7K in 2.2IP). In the batter's box, **Kyle Manzardo** homered and drove in all the runs, while **Jhonkensy Noel** doubled twice. On the basepaths, **Bryan Lavastida** picked up the first of 27SB on the season (most for an IL catcher in over 20 years).

Huntington (Small) Park

In each of the first 11 seasons after the move downtown (2009-19), Huntington Park ranked among the top two in the IL in homers per game. With the arrival of six new parks to the IL in 2021, Huntington Park finished 4th, 6th and 10th from 2021-23, respectively. The 2024 season saw a return to the top (2.96; 108HR hit by the Clippers, most for the home team in HP's existence), but it dropped back to 7th last year (2.31). Including the postseason, the Clippers have been out-homered over the life of the park (1,407 to 1,351).

Challenging Times

The Clippers were 132-174 (.431, 2nd worst in the IL) in pitch reviews last season, with batters going 79-117 (.403) and pitchers/catchers going 53-57 (.482). They ran out of challenges in 57G and did not challenge in 13G.

Extras, Read All About Them

Columbus was 5-5 in extra innings last season, following a 9-loss campaign in 2024 (most losses since 2013, 12). Since the start of the 2018 season, when baserunners started appearing at second base, the Clippers are 50-33 when playing past regulation (.602, best in the IL; no other team above .570), including 26-16 at home (.619, but 4-6 in last 10G). Of the 83G to require extra play, 66 have needed only one frame (including seven DH games) and only one has gone past the 12th (5-4 loss in 13 innings on 9/20/22 at Toledo). From 7/31/19-6/26/21, Columbus played 85 straight within the allotted innings.

Didn't Add Up

The first half of the 2025 season saw the Clippers finish 12th with a 34-38 record (.472), despite ranking 10th in run differential (+3), 10th in pitching (4.61ERA) and 2nd in defense (.984; ranked 13th in batting, .250). Such a result was the product of a league-high 27 losses by three runs or fewer (22-27, .449, 13th), as they played in the fewest games decided by at least four runs (12-11, .522, 9th). In the second half, they went 19-21 in close games, while going 11-22 in blowouts.

Hits the Spot

When turning in as many or fewer hits than their opponents last season, the Clippers went 18-64 (.220), coming in 13th out of 20 in the IL. The 2024 season saw them post an IL-worst .185 (12-53) winning percentage in such games. When allowing at least 10 hits last year, Columbus was 7-41 (.146, 20th in the IL; started the season 1-20).

Juiced is Loose

In the Huntington Park Era (since 2009), Columbus leads the IL with 76 grand slams and 1,872RBI (led IL in RBI in 2010, '11, '12, '17, '18 and '22). Collecting an IL-best 10 grand slams last season, it marked their fifth straight season with at least four (118RBI last year; had only 97RBI in 2024, worst in a 140+G season since 2016).

Not So Fast

On the basepaths, the 2024 Clippers established a franchise record of 200SB, (80% success rate) with four players topping 20 for the first time in club history. As a team, they were successful on 30 consecutive attempts (6/16-6/30/24) and 36 straight tries (7/23-8/7/24, including 8SB on 7/31/24 vs. Syracuse). Last season was a different story entirely, as they finished with the worst stolen base percentage in the IL (72%, 127SB and 49CS).

Three True Outcomes

While not breaking records last season, the Clipper pitching staff topped 660BB for the third time ever (all in last three years, franchise record of 767BB in 2023) and cleared 1,300K for the fourth time (all in the last four years, franchise record of 1,392K in 2024). The homer rate was down considerably last year, but the three true outcome rate still ended around 39% (the 2024 season saw franchise high of 40.5%; last six seasons have all been at least 37.0%, no seasons above 33.4% prior).

Return of the Defense

The Clippers were 1st in the IL in defense (.985), a season after turning in their worst fielding percentage (.978) since 2009. They had only two series with more than 5E (8/26-8/31 at Louisville, 9/17-9/21 vs. Omaha), topping out at 3E in a game twice and playing flawlessly 86 times on the year (44-42, .512; 16G errorless streak from 6/20-7/8, longest in the IL over the last 20 years). Behind the plate, Clipper catchers did not have a passed ball from 9/22/24-5/28/25 (53G; 3,949 pitches with men on base between).

Key to Victory

From 2022-23, Columbus owned the best record in the IL when holding opponents to three runs or fewer, going 95-8 (.922, no other team was above .880). The Clippers were 43-10 in such games in 2024 (.811, 13th in the IL), accumulating four losses by 4/14, and were just 47-10 (.825, 9th) last year, collecting four losses over 14G from 4/23-5/9 (had four losses total in both 2022 and 2023).

Good Baseball

Christian Cairo moved a pair of runners into scoring position with a bunt single on 9/16/25 vs. Omaha and those men came around to score in the win. Since the start of the 2018 season, Columbus is 83-21 (.798) in games in which a run is scored after a good bunt attempt, including a 14-6 (.700) mark last season (went 23-2 in 2018).

To the End

The Clippers had the 6th most last at bat losses this season (17), after pacing the circuit with 23 in 2024 (tied with Toledo). They also suffered the 4th most walk-off losses (8), watching three in a row slip away at Rochester from 5/29-5/31. The 2024 season saw 41G decided in the last at bat (tied for 2nd most in the IL, one off lead), with Columbus going 18-23 in those contests (t-17th, .439).

Manager Profile

Andy Tracy made his Clippers debut in 2021, following **Tony Mansolino's** championship rookie year in 2019 (sixth Clipper skipper to win Governors' Cup in first season; **Gene Michael**-'79, **Joe Altobelli**-'80, **Frank Verdi**-'81, **Bucky Dent**-'87 and **Mike Sarbaugh**-'10). This season marks Tracy's sixth year as a manager (first was with Williamsport in the Philadelphia system), as he holds a career record of 391-407 (.490), 361-361 with Columbus (.500).
