SHUCKERS NEWS & NOTES

<u>SWIPING INTO THE RECORD BOOKS</u>: With four stolen bases on Tuesday, the Shuckers broke the franchise single-season record for stolen bases in a season... The Shuckers' 163 stolen bases broke the previous record of 162, set in 2022.

- The Shuckers broke the record with 47 games remaining in the season, which puts them on pace to steal 247 in 2023, 17 shy of the Southern League record, set by the Birmingham Barons (264) in 1989 over 144 games.
- The 247 stolen bases would be the most by a Double-A team since 2005, when the Northwest Arkansas Naturals stole 218 during the 2019 season.

THE SUMMER OF HOMERS: After three home runs on Tuesday, the Shuckers have smashed 32 in July, marking the sixth time the Shuckers have hit at least 30 home runs in a month in franchise history (since 2015), and the fourth time they've done so in July.

The Shuckers' 32 home runs in July are tied for the fourth-most in a month in franchise history... The franchise record for the most home run in a month is 43, set in July of 2018.

<u>SPEED DEMONS</u>: Entering today, **INF Tyler Black** (45), **OF Jackson Chourio** (29) and **INF/OF Isaac Collins** (20) each have 20 stolen bases in 2023, helping the Shuckers to a franchise record 163 stolen bases in 2023.

- It marks the first time at least three Shuckers' players have reached 20 stolen bases in a season since INF Orlando Arcia (25), OF Michael Reed (25) and OF Kyle Wren (20) reached the mark in 2015.
- The Shuckers have not had multiple players reach 30 stolen bases since 2017, when OF Johnny Davis (52) and OF/INF Mauricio Dubon (31) became the first pair to reach the mark in 2017.

IN THE AIR TONIGHT: INF/OF Isaac Collins enters today with a team-leading 1.152 OPS in July, going 22-59 (.373) at the plate with four doubles and a team-best five home runs... His 1.152 OPS is the fifth-best out of all qualified hitters in Double-A, and his five home runs are tied for the seventh-most.

HE'S ON THE MOVE: With two stolen bases on Thursday, INF Tyler Black has 45 stolen bases in 2023, seven away from tying OF Johnny Davis' franchise record of 52, set in 2017... Black enters today with 17 stolen bases against the Biscuits, the most by any opposing player this year... Black currently leads the Southern League and Double-A in the category.
