TODAY'S GAME: The M-Braves continue a six-game home series with their first doubleheader of the season against the Montgomery Biscuits at Trustmark Park. This is the first of five series between the two clubs, who will meet a total of 30 times. They will meet 18 times at Trustmark Park and 12 times at Riverwalk Stadium.

- ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The M-Braves dropped their seventh in a row in a 3-0 loss to the Biscuits on Thursday night.
- RHP Tanner Gordon posted the M-Braves first quality start this season. He went six innings and allowed two runs with one earned run and a season-high seven strikeouts to one walk.
- The M-Braves collected six hits, five of which came with two outs. The M-Braves only had multiple baserunners on once in the second inning.
- Montgomery scored two runs in the second and another in the eighth. Five different Biscuits pitchers combined for the shutout.
- THE RETURN OF THE SLUGBAUER: 1B Drew Lugbauer, the M-Braves all-time and single-season home run leader, returns for a third season. Lugbauer entered the season with a club record 46 home runs over two seasons. He hit 18 home runs in 2021 and led the Southern League and Braves minor league system with 28 homers in 2022. On September 9, 2022, he surpassed Ernesto Mejia's (2011) and Mike Hessman's (2001) single-season M-Braves franchise record (26)
- The first baseman currently ranks as Atlanta's No. 29 prospect in Baseball America. He added to his own club record with his 49th M-Braves home run on Saturday at Chattanooga. He has three homers in 2023, tied for third in the Southern League
- MILLI ROCK: The versatile OF/IF Cody Milligan has hit in nine of 11 games. He currently ranks in the top 10 in the Southern League in batting (.341, 6th), OBP (.491, 3rd) hits (14, T-2nd), doubles (6, T-2nd), OPS (1.052, 5th), walks (9, T-4th), and runs (14, 1st)
- Milligan played in 68 games for the M-Braves last season. He slashed .271/.345/.326 with one home run, 10 doubles, and 21 RBI.
- THE GORDON MOBILE: RHP Tanner Gordon has a 3.00 ERA over 15 innings in three starts this season. He is currently ranked as Atlanta's No. 28 prospect
- Gordon posted the first quality start for the M-Braves this season. He went six innings, allowing two runs, one earned run with a walk and season-high seven strikeouts against Montgomery on April 21.
- EVEN STEPHENS: After a slow start to the season, OF Landon Stephens has seven hits and two homers in the last four games. After homering in back-to-back games, Stephens went 3-for-5 with an RBI on Wednesday
- Stephens played in 23 games for the M-Braves last season. In 88 games for High-A Rome, slashed .224/.357/.455 with 19 home runs and 70 RBI...when promoted, his 70 RBI ranked 1st in the South Atlantic League and 2nd in High-A, his HR ranked T-2nd in SAL and T-5th in High-A.
- "YOU CAN KISS IT GOODBYE": The M-Braves are third in the Southern League with 12 homers. Eight different players have at least one home run with Drew Lugbauer (3), Arden Pabst (2), and Landon Stephens (2) homering multiple times.
- BIG WHEELS KEEP ON TURNING: The M-Braves have already had several roster moves early in the season, with four players being promoted to Triple-A. RHP Kyle Wilcox, RHP Beau Burrows, IF Luke Waddell, C Hendrik Clementina, and LHP Domingo Robles have all been promoted to Gwinnett this sesaon. Robles was transferred back to Double-A Mississippi on Thursday.
- Tuesday Roster Moves: RHP Kyle Wilcox to Triple-A Gwinnett from Mississippi. RHP Daniel Martinez to High-A Rome from Mississippi. RHP Austin Smith (ROM) and RHP Scott Blewett (GWN) to Mississippi


