RANCHO CUCAMONGA QUAKES (21-20, 57-50)

AT

Lake Elsinore Storm (22-19, 62-45)

RHP Carlos De Los Santos (4-0, 4.98 ERA) vs. RHP Jared Kollar (0-0, --- ERA)

TODAY'S GAME: The Quakes complete a critical road trip tonight in Lake Elsinore (San Diego Padres) with the final game of a six-game series at The Diamond. Rancho returns home Tuesday to face Modesto. Tickets are available at rcquakes.com.

VS THE STORM: Today's game is the 24th of 30 head-to-head meetings between the two teams and the last of 18 here at The Diamond. The Quakes are 10-7 here in Lake Elsinore and 13-10 overall against the Storm in 2022.

LAST GAME: Rancho posted their season-best fourth straight road win, as they held on to defeat the Lake Elsinore Storm, 7-4 on Saturday night at The Diamond. Jake Vogel, Yeiner Fernandez and Kyle Froemke all had two hits each, while Griffin Lockwood-Powell collected a clutch three-run double to help lead the way for Rancho, offensively. On the hill, reliever Gabe Emmett (1-1) tossed 1.2 innings of scoreless, hitless baseball to notch his first pro win. Reinaldo De Paula worked a 1-2-3 ninth for his third save and second in the series. Lake Elsinore starter Victor Lizarraga (6-3) was saddled with the loss, as he allowed six runs over 4.2 innings of work.

UNCHARTED TERRITORY: By winning four straight games in this series, the Quakes have now won four consecutive road games for the first time all year, surpassing the previous mark of just two straight. Rancho's road record is still three games under the .500 mark (25-28), while they're ten over .500 at home (32-22).

CHALK UP A SERIES WIN: By taking four of the first five in the series so far, the Quakes have already clinched a series victory over the first-place Storm. The Quakes have only won four road series this year, but two have those have come in Lake Elsinore. Their first road series win actually came here in Lake Elsinore back in May. Rancho's last road series win was in Visalia in July, when they took two of three in the first series after the All-Star Break.

DRIVER'S SEAT?: With four straight wins in this series, coupled with Inland Empire dropping the first three games of their series against Fresno, the Quakes are in a solid position. While there's 25 games left in the season, the Quakes are currently just two games out of first place in the second-half standings and still have a two-game lead over Inland Empire overall. Currently, the Sixers have a one-game lead over the Storm and two over the Quakes. If the Quakes can't win the second half, they'll be rooting for the First Half Champion Lake Elsinore Storm to do so, as that would mean the Quakes would need to finish with the next best overall record. Currently Rancho is 57-50, with Inland Empire at 55-52. The Quakes and the 66ers meet six more times this year, as Rancho finishes up their regular season road schedule with six games in San Bernardino.

RECENT ROSTER MOVES: The Quakes' most recent roster move came on Wednesday afternoon, as right-hander Huei-Sheng Lin was released by the Los Angeles Dodgers. Lin was 1-2 with a 6.71 ERA over 17 games and 52.1 innings. Taking his spot on the roster is RHP Yamil Castillo, who joins the club from the Arizona League, where he rehabbed twice over the last two weeks. Castillo was 3-1 with a 3.15 ERA this year for Rancho over 12 games and 20 innings.

YUNIOR'S STREAK ENDS: Yunior Garcia saw his personal 11-game hitting streak come to an end on Saturday night, after going 0-for-4 with a walk. Last week against Inland Empire, Garcia hit .571 (12-for-21) with two homers and eight RBIs in five games. In August, he's hit safely in eight of nine games he's played in. In July, he hit .308 with two homers and 18 RBIs in 21 games. Garcia is tied with Luis Rodriguez on the active roster with ten home runs and has a team-high 67 RBIs.

CARLOS DE LOS SANTOS: Right-hander Carlos De Los Santos makes his second start of the year, as he's expected to serve as the "opener", with RHP Orlando Ortiz to follow. De Los Santos made two relief appearances last week in the Inland Empire series, allowing just one run on five hits over 3.2 innings of work, striking out four and walking two. De Los Santos held the Storm scoreless over two innings earlier this week, taking a no-decision on Wednesday. De Los Santos is making his eighth appearance this year against the Storm, as he's 0-0 with a 4.70 ERA, allowing five runs (four earned) on five hits over 7.2 innings. De Los Santos was signed by the Dodgers out of the Dominican Republic in 2017.

JARED KOLLAR: The Storm send right-hander Jared Kollar to the hill in his pro debut. Kollar signed with San Diego after going undrafted out of Rutgers just a few weeks ago after the 2022 draft.
