JUMBO SHRIMP BLANK NORFOLK 1-0

Braxton Garrett, Alexander Guillen and Brett Eibner combined to shut out the Norfolk Tides Friday and help the Jumbo Shrimp hold up a first-inning run to win 1-0 at Harbor Park. With one out in the top of the first inning, Lewin Diaz singled. Two batters later, Diaz moved to third on a base hit from Jesús Sánchez before scoring on an RBI base knock by Luis Marte. The Jumbo Shrimp would only put four other baserunners on for the remainder of the game, but luckily, the club received great pitching. Garrett scattered four hits without a walk in his six innings, the longest a Jacksonville starter has gone. Guillen tossed two scoreless frames before Eibner picked up the save in a scoreless ninth.

'PEN PALS

In Friday's 1-0 triumph at Norfolk, Jacksonville relievers Alexander Guillen and Brett Eibner combined to pitch 3.0 perfect innings out of the bullpen, continuing a recent trend of dominant relief pitching for the Jumbo Shrimp. In fact, the Jacksonville bullpen has now gone 21 innings in a row without allowing a run. During this span, Jumbo Shrimp relievers have ceded just 13 hits, fanning 22 against only two walks.

25 OR 6 2004

The Jumbo Shrimp beat Norfolk 1-0 on Friday to reach 12-4 on the season - Jacksonville's best start to a campaign since beginning 12-4 in 2004. This year's Jumbo Shrimp have already taken the first four games in their six-game set with Norfolk, meaning Jacksonville has opened a campaign with at least three series victories for the first time since five straight set triumphs to begin the 2004 season.

JESÚS WALKS

Jacksonville outfielder Jesús Sánchez has gotten off to a scorching start at the plate this season. The native of Higuey, in the Dominican Republic has at least one hit in 13 of the 14 games he has appeared in, going 28-for-56 at the plate. Entering play on Saturday, Sánchez ranks first in Triple-A East in batting average (.500), slugging percentage (1.000), OPS (1.533), hits (28), RBIs (20) and triples (3), tied for first in home runs (7) and extra-base hits (11) and second in on-base percentage (.533). Nearly one-quarter of Jacksonville's 86 runs have been plated by Sánchez.

HIGH FIVE

Jacksonville enters play on Saturday on a season-best five-game winning streak. During these five games, the Jumbo Shrimp have yielded just 10 runs for a 1.96 ERA (42 H in 46.0 IP). Jacksonville pitchers have combined for 44 strikeouts against 11 walks during this span. Offensively, the Jumbo Shrimp have been buoyed by big innings; they enjoyed a season-best six-run third inning on Sunday, followed by a four-run third on Wednesday and four-run fourth on Thursday, outscoring opponents a total of 22-10. Stretching their victorious roll to six would mark the club's first six-game winning streak since July 7-12 of the 2018 season.

MUSICAL CHAIRS

Right-handed pitcher Luis Madero will make the start for the Jumbo Shrimp in Saturday's contest at Norfolk. Despite the season slate reaching just its 17th game in the matchup, Madero will be the 10th-different starting pitcher for Jacksonville this season. Even with the game of musical chairs being performed at the bottom of the lineup card, the Jumbo Shrimp have received effective starting pitching. Jacksonville starters have totaled 70.2 innings pitched, the sixth-most of any staff in Triple-A East. Jumbo Shrimp lid-lifters have also excelled at getting ground balls, posting 1.36 ground outs for every air out, the fourth-highest such ratio in the league. The club's starters have also initiated eight double plays, tied for the third-most in the circuit.

THE BRIAN KING

Jacksonville catcher Brian Navarroto smashed a bases-clearing double in Wednesday's 5-2 victory over Norfolk, continuing an early-season surge. The native of Levittown, Puerto Rico has collected hits in five of the last six games, going 6-for-19 (.316) with two doubles, one home run, five RBIs and one walk during that span. On the season, Navarroto ranks leads all Triple-A catchers in wRC+ (179), OPS (1.078) and isolated power (.378). Among the 213 Triple-A players with at least 40 plate appearances, Navarroto owns the seventh-highest fly ball rate (60.7 percent).

SHRIMP TAIL

Jacksonville has issued the fewest walks in Triple-A East (44), including just 11 over the last five games.

ABOUT LUIS

-Madero was originally signed as an international free agent by the Arizona Diamondbacks in 2013 for \$160,000. At the 2017 trade deadline, he was traded by Arizona to the Los Angeles Angels in exchange for RHP David Hernandez.

-Following the 2018 season, the Angels protected Madero from the Rule 5 draft by placing him on the 40-man roster. However, the right-hander was designated for assignment in January 2020 and claimed by the San Francisco Giants. After becoming a free agent following the 2020 season, Madero signed with the Miami Marlins on December 20, 2020.

2021 SEASON

-Madero made his major league debut on May 10 at Arizona, firing two scoreless innings and scattering a hit and walk against one strikeout. He pitched again the following day before Miami designated him for assignment. After the right-hander cleared waivers and was outrighted on May 16 to Jacksonville.

2019 SEASON

-After posting a 1.13 ERA in four outings with High-A Inland Empire, earned a promotion to Double-A Mobile on April 27, 2019.

-Madero yielded no more than three earned runs in five of his first six appearances with Mobile, including a 1.67 ERA in the month of May. After the All-Star Break, Madero made 12 starts, but was stung for a 7.30 ERA with 77 hits allowed in 49.1 innings.

-With Mobile, left-handers hit nine home runs in 172 at-bats (19.1 AB/HR). However, he held right-handed hitters to just two homers over 202 at-bats (101 AB/HR).

2018 SEASON

-Earned a promotion on July 6, 2018 from Low-A Burlington to High-A Inland Empire. Madero gave up three earned runs or fewer in 11 of his 14 starts prior to his promotion.

-The right-hander was named a Midwest League Midseason All-Star while pitching for the Bees. In his first outing with Inland Empire, Madero worked six shutout innings on July 10, 2018 at Lake Elsinore.

-Left-handed hitters posted a .320 average against Madero while he pitched for Inland Empire. Conversely, he held right-handed batters to a .214 mark.

-In Burlington, opponents batted .317 in the first inning, and in Inland Empire, that mark rose to .324. Outside of the fifth inning with Inland Empire (.320), Madero held opponents' below .300 in each frame he pitched in.
