Charleston RiverDogs (10-14) vs. Augusta GreenJackets (12-13)

Today's Game: The Charleston RiverDogs (affiliate of the Tampa Bay Rays) remain on the road for their second week as part of the lone 12-game road trip of the season. The team currently possesses a 4-6 record through the first 10 games of the trip. This is the first meeting between the RiverDogs and Augusta GreenJackets (affiliate of the Atlanta Braves) in 2024. **RiverDogs-GreenJackets Season Series in 2024**: Overall: RiverDogs 2, GreenJackets 2. At SRP Park: RiverDogs 2, GreenJackets 2.

Last Time Out: A comfortable lead faded quickly as the RiverDogs suffered a 6-5 loss in walk-off fashion on Friday night. The visitors built a 3-0 lead in the third inning. Narciso Polanco began the scoring with a ground-rule double that bounced over the right field wall. Tre' Morgan drove in two more with a single up the middle two batters later to make it 3-0. That advantage grew even larger in the fifth inning when Morgan and Angel Mateo drove in runs with back-to-back two-out singles. Owen Wild cruised into the sixth inning without allowing a run to that point. However, he could not get an out in his final frame, departing after Drew Compton blasted a three-run home run. Augusta moved one run closer in the seventh, but still trailed by one entering the final frame. Adam Boucher walked Jace Grady to start the inning and Luis Sanchez tied the score immediately with a triple to right field. Boucher loaded the bases with two more walks, one of them intentional. He then missed with a 3-2 breaking ball to Robert Gonzalez, forcing in the winning run.

Beleaguered Bullpen: The RiverDogs starting rotation has consistently provided excellent work during the current road trip. However, the bullpen has struggled mightily to sustain that standard. During the 10 games on the road swing, the starting pitcher has delivered a quality start eight times and departed the game with the lead or the score tied in each of those contests. The bullpen has posted a combined 6.20 ERA during the same span and allowed 36 total runs, 28 earned, in 40.2 innings. The RiverDogs have led at some point in 10 of their 14 losses this season.

Ducks Stuck on the Pond: The RiverDog have put plenty of men on base in the first four games of this series, combining to post 35 hits and 21 walks. However, their production has been limited to 18 runs because of struggles with runners in scoring position. Following a 4-16 showing with RISP on Thursday, the team is now 10-61 (.164) this week. The RiverDogs have not scored more than seven runs in a game this season.

Several Players Streaking: The current two-city road trip has not been helpful to the RiverDogs won-loss record but has been key for three members of the lineup finding a rhythm at the plate. Tre' Morgan and Angel Mateo each enter play tonight with an active eight-game hitting streak. Morgan is hitting .424 with three doubles during his and Mateo is swinging it at a .324 clip. Narciso Polanco is currently batting .375 on his own sevengame streak, cementing himself in the leadoff spot.

King of Thieves: The RiverDogs have been one of the most prolific base stealing teams in Minor League Baseball this season. The team's total of 70 stolen bases is six more than any other team in the Carolina League and third in MiLB as a whole, behind only the Jupiter Hammerheads and Aberdeen Ironbirds. 12 different players have stolen a base this season and eight of them have five or more. The Dogs have stolen eight bases in two different contests and seven in another. Noah Myers leads the team and is tied for sixth in the league with 10.

Don't Test Me: Catcher Bryan Broecker has thrown out eight of 14 attempted base stealers this season. That number has him tied for 13th among all catchers in Minor League Baseball. Among the top 15 catchers in MiLB in runners caught stealing, he has allowed the fewest successful stolen bases (6). A 13th round pick from Michigan State, Broecker closed the 2023 season with the RiverDogs, starting a pair of playoff games.

Prized Pups: The RiverDogs opening night roster contains four members of MLB Pipeline's Top 30 Rays prospects list entering the 2024 season. The highest-rated is 18-year-old shortstop Adrian Santana who slots in at #6. Sitting at #9, pitcher Santiago Suarez returns to the Holy City after making his full-season debut with the RiverDogs late last season. Finally, former LSU standout Tre' Morgan (#14) figures to be a regular at the top of the lineup after a brief appearance with the Dogs following the 2023 draft. Finally, pitcher Andrew Lindsey rounds out the list at #29.

Running it Back: 11 players who played a part in last year's championship run are currently on the team's roster. The pitching staff features returnees Gary Gill Hill, Samuel Mejia and Santiago Suarez. Catchers Bryan Broecker and Raudelis Martinez are on the Opening Night roster after suiting up in the Holy City for the second half last season. Three infielders (Carlos Colmenarez, Tre' Morgan and Odalys Peguero) and two outfielders (Cristopher Barete and Angel Mateo) are also back to defend the Carolina League title.

RIVERDOGS FIELD STAFF

Manager: Sean Smedley

Smedley's coaching career began when he was the video coordinator for the rookie-level Princeton Rays in 2016. In 2017, he returned to Princeton, this time as the bench coach. For the next two seasons, Smedley was part of Blake Butera's staff as the bench coach for the Hudson Valley Renegades. The native of Colorado was announced as the manager in Princeton for the 2020 season, but COVID-19 canceled the season and, when play resumed, he joined Butera in Charleston. During his playing days as a catcher, Smedley was a prep standout at Desert Vista High School in Phoenix, Arizona. He played one year of junior college ball at Yavapai College before transferring to Division II Texas A&M International. He went undrafted at the end of his college career but was signed as a free agent by the Rays shortly after the draft's conclusion. In three professional seasons, he appeared in 24 games total between the Gulf Coast League Rays and Single-A Bowling Green. This is Smedley's second season managing the RiverDogs.

Pitching Coach: Levi Romero

Romero returns for a second year as the RiverDogs pitching coach after serving in the same role with the FCL Rays in 2021. Romero was the pitching coach for one of the Rays two entries in the Dominican Summer League in 2021. His professional career began in 2003 when he was signed out of Venezuela by the Houston Astros. In all, he pitched for five years in Minor League Baseball with the Astros and Texas Rangers before embarking on a seven-year international career that included stops in Venezuela and Japan and ended in 2015.

Hitting Coach: Brett Schneider

Schneider heads to the Lowcountry as the RiverDogs hitting coach in his first year as a member of the Rays organization. He spent the previous four years as a hitting coach in the Seattle Mariners farm system, including with the Arizona Complex League Mariners in 2023. His roster in the ACL finished with the most home runs in the 17-team circuit and hit a combined .263. Prior to coaching in the professional ranks, Schneider was a volunteer assistant coach at Florida Atlantic University. He also served as hitting coach for the Green Bay Bullfrogs of the Northwoods League in 2016 and managed the Great Lakes Collegiate League's Richmond Jazz in 2017.

Coach: Ronnie Richardson

Richardson is embarking on his fourth season with the Rays, and second with Charleston, following two years in the Florida Complex League. Richardson previously coached in the Miami Marlins organization, with Hillsborough Community College and in the Northwoods League with the Madison Mallards and Wisconsin Woodchucks. He was selected out of Central Florida University in the 16th round of the 2012 MLB Draft by the San Diego Padres. He played three seasons in their farm system, posting a .262 career batting average.

Athletic Trainer: Halee Williams

Williams begins her fifth year with the Rays and second with the RiverDogs. She served in the same role with the Florida Complex League Rays in 2022. Williams graduated with her bachelor's degree in athletic training from Indiana Wesleyan University. While in school, she interned with the Arizona Diamondbacks and, after graduating, spent a season with the Oakland Athletics. She began working with the Rays in 2019 while completing her Global master's degree in Sports Management and Legal Skills through Instituto Superior de Derecho y Economía and FC Barcelona in 2020. This winter, Williams worked for the Bravos de Margarita of the Venezuelan Professional Baseball League.

Strength Coach: Gio Caraballo

This will be Caraballo's first season as the RiverDogs Strength & Conditioning coach after a brief stint working in Charleston last summer. Caraballo was hired by the Rays in late 2022 and spent last season in the same role with the Florida Complex League Rays at their facility in Sarasota. A New Jersey native, Caraballo began his career with the Houston Astros after graduating from Montclair State University with a Bachelor of Science with a major in Physical Education.
