BAYSOX DROP SERIES OPENER

The Chesapeake Baysox dropped game one of their six-game home series to the Harrisburg Senators by a final of 7-6 in 11 innings. Chesapeake received offensive contributions from Max Wagner, who hit a bases clearing triple in the third, and Reed Trimble, who hit his second homer of the season in the eighth. Anthony Servideo tied the game in the 10th with a single up the middle. A wild pitch by Yaqui Rivera on a swinging strike three plated home the winning run for the Senators in the 11th.

ENRIQUE ELECTRIFIES

OF Enrique Bradfield Jr. has reached base in 17 of 22 games played to start the season after missing 32 games from April 11 - May 19 due to a left hamstring injury. The Orioles No. 2 prospect hit his first homer of the season on Wednesday, June 4 in Akron, which was the first Baysox extra inning homer of the season and the first extra inning homer since September 6, 2023.

CREED CRUSHES

C Creed Willems has been one of the best performers in the Orioles system this year. Amongst O's minor leaguers, the Orioles No. 11 prospect is third in doubles (11), tied for fourth in home runs (7), tied for fifth in extra base hits (19) and total bases (78). Willems leads the team with 22 RBI.

RETZ CAN RAKE

C Adam Retzbach was one of the Eastern League's best offensive players in the month of May. The 24-year-old posted the third-best on-base percentage (.457) and the sixth-best batting average in the league (.327). Retzbach has reached base in 14 of his last 17 games.

TEACH ME HOW TO DOUGIE

OF Doug Hodo is tied for seventh in the Eastern League in walks (30) and leads the team in OBP (.365). After a slow start to the season, Hodo's bat heated up in the month of May, posting a slash line of .294/.380/.426 with three doubles, two homers and eight RBI.

IF Anthony Servideo has been Chesapeake's best hitter so far in the month of June. The former third rounder is batting .318 (7-for-22) with a double, triple and four RBI in seven games this month. Servideo tied the game in the 10th last night with a single.

WALK THIS WAY

C Silas Ardoin leads the Eastern League in walks (40). Ardoin drew the most walks in the league in the month of April with 18. Last season, he drew 47 walks in 104 games.

BULLPEN BEASTS

Chesapeake's bullpen holds a 2.86 ERA, which is fourth-best in Double-A and sixth-best in MiLB. Baysox relievers have punched out 300 hitters, which is thirdmost in all of Double-A and the most in the Eastern League.

SIZING UP THE SENATORS

The Harrisburg Senators enter this week with a 28-29 record, good for third in the Southwest. The Double-A affiliate of the Washington Nationals won four of six vs Reading and have won seven of their last 10. Chesapeake won five of six in Harrisburg in the most recent series meeting May 20 - 25. The Senators roster features four members of the Nationals Top 30 prospect list (per MLB.com) - IF Seaver King (No. 4), IF Cayden Wallace (No. 10), RHP Tyler Stuart (No. 14) and IF Kevin Made (No. 25).

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

RHP Tyler Stuart makes his second start of the season for the Senators. Stuart began the season on Triple-A Rochester's injured list and was sent on rehab assignments to FCL-Nationals and High-A Wilmington before being activated and transferred to Harrisburg. The Nationals No. 14 prospect holds a 4.11 ERA in three career starts vs the Baysox, including a career-high 13 strikeout performance on August 8, 2024.

Ranked the Orioles No. 25 prospect (via MLB.com)

Delivered 1,305th Baysox strikeout last year, setting new franchise single-season record

2025: Struck out season-high seven batters in season-high 6.0 innings on 6/4 @ AKR. Holds a 4.32 ERA in six career appearances vs HBG. T-1st in EL in BB (33). Recorded a 4.96 ERA in month of May over 16.1 IP. Earned first Double-A win in 32 career starts after delivering first hitless start of AA career on 4/12 vs ERI (Gm 2) with 5.2 IP. Enters third stint (second full season) with Chesapeake.

2024: Completed third season in Orioles organization and first full season in Double-A with Bowie as a full-time starter. Eclipsed 100.0 IP for first time in career with 112.0 IP but allowed a career-high 60 BB. 2nd on team in IP and K (120). Led Eastern League in walks but finished 8th in K. Delivered 1,305th strikeout of the season in final start of year, which set a new Baysox single-season franchise record. Threw 4th-most IP, struck out 8th-most batters, and allowed 2nd-most BB in O's system. One of two winless starters in all of Double-A (minimum 20 starts). Went 5.0+ IP in only four starts. Baysox went 9-18 when Bright started. Started season strong with a 2.41 ERA in month of April (9th-lowest in EL) over 18.2 IP with 23 K. Ended season strong with a 1.93 ERA in 14.0 IP in September.

Career Notes: Began '23 in High-A Aberdeen and struck out 127 batters in 82.2 IP. Led IronBirds in K. Finished 4th in South Atlantic League in K. Earned promotion to Double-A Bowie on August 22. Went at least 4.0 innings and struck out at least four batters in each of his first four Double-A appearances. Completed first Double-A stint with a 2.12 ERA in 17 innings over 20 strikeouts.... Debuted professionally in '22 with FCL Orioles. Assigned to Single-A Delmarva on August 27.

College: Pitched three seasons at Auburn. Best season was his junior year in 2022 where he struck out a career-high 94 batters in 80.2 innings over 18 appearances (17 starts). Led team in starts, innings and strikeouts. Was only Auburn pitcher to start all 17 weekends of the season. His 94 strikeouts were 4th- most by an Auburn pitcher since 2000. Helped Auburn reach Men's College World Series and earned the win in Tigers first CWS win since 1997.

Personal: Drafted in the 5th round of the 2022 MLB Draft by the Baltimore Orioles out of Auburn. Highest drafted pitcher signed by Baltimore that year after not coming to terms with 3rd round pick Nolan McLean...Full name is Bob Ike Bright. Grew up an Orioles fan because he has family that lives in Havre de Grace.

COACHING STAFF

ROBERTO MERCADO

Manager

Roberto Mercado returns for his second season as Baysox Manager in 2025 after completing his first year at the Double-A level last season. The 17th manager in franchise history, he led the Baysox to a 62-75 overall record, oversaw 18 player promotions to Triple-A and coached two former Baysox who would go on to make their Major League debuts in the same season. The New Britain, CT native also managed the Surprise Saguaros of the Arizona Fall League this past offseason, where he led them to a league-best 18-10 record and a Fall League Championship Game appearance.

Before the Baysox, Mercado spent two seasons as manager of the Aberdeen IronBirds - the Orioles' High-A affiliate. Mercado received the Cal Ripken, Sr. Player Development Award in 2022 by the Orioles.

Prior to joining the O's, Mercado spent 17 years on the coaching staff at New Britain High School in Connecticut and served as Dean of Students for over 18 years.

Pitching Coach

Jordie Henry enters his first season as Baysox Pitching Coach in 2025 and his third season as a member of the Orioles' system. Previously, Henry served as the pitching coach at High-A Aberdeen where his staff recorded 1,357 strikeouts last season – 2nd-most in the South Atlantic League and 2nd-most in IronBirds franchise history. Before joining the Orioles, Henry was the Director of Pitching at Prime Sports Performance in Baltimore – a private athletic development training facility. He also worked as a pitching coach and instructor at the high school and summer collegiate levels. Henry pitched collegiately for four seasons at Wayland Baptist University.

CHESAPEAKE OYSTER CATCHERS



For select home games, the Chesapeake Baysox will take the field as the Chesapeake Oyster Catchers as a tribute to the Chesapeake Bay's rich heritage and thriving ecosystem.

Inspired by the American oystercatcher, the prominent patterned shorebird can be found along the Chesapeake Bay year-round. With its bold black-and-white plumage, orange beak, and knack for hunting shellfish, the oystercatcher is a symbol of strength and ingenuity—qualities that define both the Chesapeake region and its passionate baseball fans.

The Oyster Catchers name also pays homage to the Chesapeake Bay's rich maritime traditions and oyster restoration efforts, celebrating the region's deep connection to its waters.

CANGREJOS FANTASMAS DE CHESAPEAKE



The Cangrejos Fantasmas De Chesapeake (Chesapeake Ghost Crabs) are a part of MiLB's "Copa de la Diversión™" or "Fun Cup™"- a season-long event series specifically designed to embrace the culture and values that resonate most with Minor League Baseball™ teams' local U.S. Hispanic communities.

Boasting a desire to better represent the Chesapeake Bay area, Bowie's "Cangrejos Fantasmas de Chesapeake" identiy came to light after research presented the existence of the small, yet active Atlantic Ghost Crab species in the bay.

BOWIE PIT BEEF



The "Bowie Pit Beef" is an alternate identity of the Chesapeake Baysox that pays tribute to the culinary culture of Maryland.



Pit Beef consists of top round cuts of beef, thinly sliced and prepared over a charcoal fire. The meat is cooked quickly at high temperatures and has a slight smoked flavor. The sandwich got its name on Baltimore's east side in the 1970s, before being popularized by the 1980s.
