RIDERS HANG ON LATE TO DOWN TRAVS:

The Frisco RoughRiders built a big lead and staved off a late comeback from the Arkansas Travelers in a 5-4 win on Friday from Dickey-Stephens Park. The Riders (15-22, 53-52) found the scoreboard first in the top of the third when **Aaron Zavala** cracked a three-run home run off Travelers (19-18, 54-52) starter Marcelo Perez (2-2) to put Frisco up 3-0. It was Zavala's 10th home run of the season for the Riders. In the top of the fifth, Frisco added on with a **Cam Cauley** RBI triple and a Zavala sacrifice fly to balloon the lead to 5-0. Arkansas began their return in the bottom of the fifth when Brock Rodden homered and they added on three more in the bottom of the sixth to pull to within 5-4. From there, the Frisco bullpen locked it down with **Avery Weems** (1-1) taking home the win despite allowing three runs, **Bryan Magdaleno** firing a scoreless frame and **Eric Loomis** closing it out with a six-out save for his second of the series.

POP, POP, FIZZ, FIZZ, OH WHAT A RELIEF IT IS:

Frisco's bullpen has struggled this season, but has been great to start August. In seven games, the Riders bullpen is second in the Texas League with a 2.41 ERA and they are 4-for-5 in save opportunities.

ROTATION ROTATING:

With the RoughRiders' recent promotions of **Trey Supak** and **Ben Anderson** and the trade of **Mitch Bratt**, Frisco only has one remaining starter from the opening rotation of the year (**Josh Stephan**). Frisco's starting ERA of 4.06 in the second half is second in the Texas League, while it is 3.77 since the start of July, which is also third in the league. In the last 10 games, Frisco has a 2.51 ERA for starters which is second in the league and Frisco leads the league with a 2.29 ERA in seven August games.

BROKEN BATS:

For the first time since midseason 2023, the RoughRiders were blanked in back-to-back games on offense on Sunday and Tuesday. Frisco ended their scoreless streak with **Aaron Zavala's** two-run double in the 10th on Wednesday, stopping the streak at 29 consecutive innings without a run. In the first seven games in August, Frisco has scored just 14 total runs while hitting .172/.264/.235/.499 at the plate as a team with one home run. Zavala has scored or driven in seven of the 14 runs in the month for Frisco.

THE BOYS ARE PICKIN' IT:

The RoughRiders have been fantastic on defense this season, owning the best fielding percentage (.982) in the Texas League while committing the fewest errors (67). After committing 20 errors in the first month of the season, Frisco owns a .984 fielding percentage since May 1st, which is the second-best in Double-A.

WALK IT LIKE I TALK IT:

Aaron Zavala walked twice on July 18th, collecting his 207th career walk in a RoughRiders uniform to break the all-time franchise record, previously held by **Guilder Rodriguez**. Making it much more impressive, Zavala accomplished the feat in 312 games with a 15.1 percent walk rate over four seasons (2022-2025) while Rodriguez needed 524 RoughRiders games from 2009-2015 and a 9.8 percent walk rate.

HOLD ME CLOSE AND DON'T LET GO:

In their last 24 games, the RoughRiders have had the lead or a tie game in the eighth inning in 17 of the 24 games, but they are 11-13. The Riders have blown seven saves during that span. Their bullpen ERA of 4.99 in July is last in all of Double-A and while they allowed 54 earned runs, they also surrendered 12 unearned runs.

CAULEY! CAULEY, CAULEY ANYTIME:

Cam Cauley has been solid for the RoughRiders on offense in 2025. In his last 72 games since May 7th, he is batting .266/.330/.453/.783 with 20 doubles, four triples, eight home runs, 30 RBIs and 17 stolen bases. In his last 36 games, he is slashing .275/.331/.483/.814 with 10 doubles, three triples, five home runs, 19 RBIs, 25 runs scored and 10 steals. He is seventh in the league in hits (93), tied for third in doubles (21), tied for second in triples (six), third in extra-base hits (36), fifth in total bases (153), fourth in runs scored (60) and sixth in steals (27).

WALLY'S WORLD:

Rangers top prospect **Sebastian Walcott** has showed off incredible consistency this season. In April, he hit .244 with a .766 OPS, in May, produced a .257 average and .811 OPS, but struggled with extra-base hits in June, hitting .239, but just a .640 OPS. This season, his walk rate of 12.4 percent is a career high while he is striking out at just 21.4 percent, a career low. This season, he is on pace for 34 steals over 124 games, which would best his prior career high of 27 last year. The only teenagers since 2005 to steal 30 or more in Double-A are **Elvis Andrus** (51, 2008), Jackson Chourio (43, 2023), Nelson Rada (35, 2024) and Mike Trout (31, 2011). Chourio was the only one on that list with 30+ stolen bases and double-digit home runs (22). Walcott participated in the Futures Game for the second season in a row over the All-Star Break, going 0-for-1 with a sacrifice fly and a groundout to shortstop while playing third base defensively.
