LAST GAME

The Baysox dropped the finale of their six-game set with the Akron RubberDucks, 5-4 on Sunday evening. A four-run top of the fourth powered Bowie to the lead, highlighted by a Donta' Williams three-run home run, in addition to a Noelberth Romero RBI single. Akron would get a run back in the bottom half against Baysox starter Cade Povich, when Bryan Lavastida doubled home Juan Brito to make it a 4-1 contest. Povich, who had struck out six across his first four frames, eventually ran into trouble in the fifth, when the first four Akron batters reached in the frame, including a two-run single from Michael Amditts to cut the Baysox lead to 4-3. Povich was lifted with one out in the frame for right-hander Tyler Burch, who allowed both inherited runners to score on RBI knocks from Lavastida and Angel Martinez to give the RubberDucks a 5-4 lead they would not relinquish, as Bowie managed just two base runners after the fourth inning in the defeat.

TODAY'S OPPONENT

The Senators enter play this week with a record of 22-22 - good for third place in the Southwest division and a game-and-a-half out of first. The Double-A affiliate of the Washington Nationals, Harrisburg split a six-game series in Reading last week, losing each of the last three contests. The Senators won five of six in Harrisburg against the Baysox back in the second week of May. Harrisburg has the fewest home runs (31) and road home runs (14) hit in the Eastern League, and the second fewest in Double-A, while the Bowie staff has allowed the second-most home runs at home (35) in the league. The Senators' roster is highlighted by the Nationals' top two prospects, according to MLB Pipeline - James Wood (No. 1 WSH/No. 7 overall) and Robert Hassell III (No. 2 WSH/No. 44 overall) patrolling the outfield. RHPs Jackson Rutledge (No. 11 WSH) and Gerrardo Carrillo (No. 27 WSH) alongside LHP Mitchell Parker (No. 23 WSH) feature on the Harrisburg pitching staff.

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

Right-hander Michael Cuevas is scheduled to get the start on the mound for Harrisburg tonight. Cuevas last started this past Wednesday against Reading, where he took the win after going six innings, allowing just two runs on three hits and a walk, while striking out a Double-A career-high eight batters. Cuevas faced the Baysox earlier this month in Harrisburg, where he also went six frames of two-run baseball, despite allowing a season-high eight hits in the process. Still just 21 years old, Cuevas was a 23rd round pick of the Nationals back in 2019 out of Brennan High School in San Antonio, Texas. He has progressed steadily through the Washington farm through his first four professional seasons, ranking towards the top of the system with 114.1 innings (5th) and 24 starts (1st) while maintaining a 4.64 ERA (3rd) with High-A Wilmington last season. Tonight will be the 14th appearance for Cuevas against an Orioles' affiliate.

CITY ISLAND SETBACK

Bowie's bats enjoyed plenty of success last-time out against Harrisburg, but struggled when it came to crucial execution. The Baysox outthit the Senators in five of the six games played in Harrisburg earlier this month, by a 47-39 total. Despite this, Bowie scored two runs or fewer in five of the six games, hitting just .140 (7-for-50) with runners in scoring position. On the season, the Baysox are hitting .225 with runners in scoring position - the third-lowest mark in the Eastern League. Bowie is 13-11 in games where it has outthit its opponent this season.

SLIPPING UP

The 46 errors committed by the Baysox this season are the most at the Double-A level. This comes after a season where Bowie had a lauded infield defense, and committed only 100 errors, an average number in the Eastern League. At this point in the season, Bowie is on pace for 148 total errors.

TERRY TATERS

TT Bowens has helped rejuvenate the Baysox lineup the past two weeks. Since making his Double-A debut on 5/16, Bowens leads Bowie with a .325 average and three home runs. Bowens' four doubles and seven extra-base hits in that span are tied with Coby Mayo for the team lead as well. The Baysox lineup is averaging 4.75 runs per game in the past two series, after averaging 3.90 runs per game prior.

STARTING STRONG

Starting pitching has been exceptional for the Baysox throughout the 2023 season thus far. Bowie's ERA from starting pitchers this season is 3.23 - the best in the Eastern League and the second-best in all of Double-A. Three of the eight lowest ERAs as starters in Double-A (min. 25 IP) come from Baysox pitchers (Justin Armbruester, 2nd - 1.40; Garrett Stallings, 3rd - 1.44; Chayce McDermott, 8th - 2.73). However, Bowie's 4.98 ERA from relievers is the second-worst mark in the Eastern League.

CAREER NOTES

- Pitched to a 0.96 ERA in the month of June, allowing just three runs across 28 innings, while striking out 32 compared to just 10 walks. Also held opponents to .188 average in the month of June.
- Went four or more scoreless innings seven times on the season.
- Started two postseason contests for the IronBirds, allowing a single run over nine innings, including going four scoreless frames in the South Atlantic League Championship Series.
- Pitched two seasons at UC Irvine, where he posted a 4.03 career ERA in 19 appearances (18 starts) across 96 innings.
- Transferred to UC Irvine in 2020 after spending two seasons at Ohlone College, pitching 26 games (22 starts) with an ERA of 2.19, striking out 133 batters and walking just 33 in 119 innings.
- Pitched sparingly at California High School in San Ramon and entered college with a mid-80s fastball before truly developing his game at Ohlone.
- Oldest of six siblings.

NOTES BY START

- 4/8 Double-A debut. Pitched in tandem to Cade Povich's start. Third pitch thrown went for a double, and an error that should have ended the inning allowed the runner to score. Across a 1-2-3 inning in the next frame, was struck by a line drive on the forearm before assisting on the out at first. Left the game.
- 4/29 Second game of a doubleheader, only baserunner allowed was a double with two outs in the first. 22 pitches in the first, just 12 in the second.
- 5/6 Walked two batters in the first, but a caught stealing kept inning scoreless. Allowed a solo home run to lead off the second.
- 5/12 Relieved Garrett Stallings with Bowie up 2-0. Allowed double to first batter, and two-run home run to fourth. Walked first two batters in next inning and allowed go-ahead single.
- 5/18 Thanks to a double play, faced the minimum in the first two innings, and struck out the side in the second. Allowed the first four batters to reach in the third inning, allowing five total hits and two walks in the frame before being pulled.
- 5/24 Pitched in relief of Garrett Stallings. Walked the first batter he saw, then retired next six to open a scoreless outing.

2023 will be Kyle Moore's second season as the manager of the Baysox, and his 14th within the Orioles' organization. After leading Bowie to a division-best 41-28 through the back half of last season, Moore continues to display consistency at the helm of recent successful teams throughout the Orioles system. Moore led Class-A Delmarva to a minor league-best 90 wins as manager in 2019. The Shorebirds were named MiLB.com's Team of the Year and Moore won South Atlantic Manager of the Year honors. Moore's career managerial record sits at 254-216 (.540) entering the 2023 season. Prior to his managerial career, Moore also spent three seasons as a player/coach in the Orioles system (2013 Frederick Keys, 2014 Bowie Baysox, 2015 Delmarva Shorebirds). He then took a position as the Shorebirds hitting coach in 2016, before joining the Keys in the same role in 2017. Moore played collegiately at Alabama, before signing with Baltimore as an undrafted free agent in 2010. He currently resides in Sarasota alongside his wife Whitney, and his two daughters, Madielyn and Cameron.	Sherman Johnson makes his coaching debut, as he joins the Baysox staff as the hitting coach in 2023. Johnson had a brief stint in the major leagues with the Los Angeles Angels back in 2018 and spent parts of nine minor league seasons across the Angels, Reds and Minnesota Twins organizations. Johnson's playing career most recently landed him in independent ball this past season with the Kane County Cougars. Johnson also played two seasons collegiately at Florida State.	Forrest Herrmann joins the Bowie Baysox coaching staff in his second season with the Orioles organization. He served as the pitching coach of the Aberdeen IronBirds during the 2022 season, helping Aberdeen clinch a first-half division title and make it all the way to game three of the South Atlantic League Championship Series. Herrmann guided one of the best staffs in the SAL last season, which led the league in strikeouts. Prior to joining the Orioles organization, Herrmann spent two seasons as a pitching coach within the Cincinnati Reds organization. Herrmann also served as a pitching strategist in 2019 for the Seattle Mariners organization at their facility in Peoria. Herrmann also worked with current Orioles' left-hander John Means at P3 Premier Pitching Performance center in Missouri. He pitched for three seasons at the University of Evansville prior to his coaching career.	Tim DeJohn returns to the Baysox in 2023 for a second season as Fundamentals coach. However, DeJohn also received a promotion this season and will also serve as the Minor League Infield Coordinator at all levels. DeJohn has been a part of the Orioles' staff since November 2019. Prior to joining the organization, DeJohn had an extensive background in the college ranks. He served as an assistant coach at the University of Memphis between 2017 and 2019 and was an assistant at the University of Hartford the two seasons prior. DeJohn played at Western Connecticut State from 2003-2008.	Ryan Goll, much like pitching coach Forrest Herrmann, is making a jump from High-A in 2023. Goll serves as the Baysox development coach for his first season in Bowie, after filling the same role for Aberdeen last season. Goll has also been promoted to Offseason Camp Coordinator entering 2023. Goll first served as a Player Development Intern for the Orioles organization in 2020, before joining the minor league staff full-time in 2021. Goll attended the University of Minnesota, where he began as a bullpen catcher and Head Student Manager from 2015-2018, before moving on to be a Student Undergraduate Assistant Coach in September of 2018.
