Tonight's Game: The Nashville Sounds take on the Omaha Storm Chasers in game three of the six-game series. Right-hander Janson Junk starts for the Sounds against Omaha southpaw Austin Cox.

Janson Junk: 27-year-old Janson Junk takes the mound for Nashville. He is coming off a strong outing in Jacksonville where he tossed 5.2 scoreless innings. His win that night was the first by a Nashville starter this season. The right-hander is just one of three pitchers in the IL this season to post a sub-1.00 ERA over 10 or more innings (also Yacksel Rios, GWN & Zach Muckenhirn, SYR). He has not allowed a run for Nashville since the fourth inning of his April 2 start vs. Louisville. Junk was originally selected in the 22nd round of the 2017 First-Year Player Draft by the Yankees out of Seattle University.

Austin Cox: 26-year-old Austin Cox gets the nod for the Storm Chasers tonight. The left-hander is 0-0 with a 3.14 ERA (14.1 IP/5 ER) through four games (3 starts). Cox last pitched on April 21 vs. Gwinnett, allowing one run over 5.0 innings and not factoring into the decision. The Macon, Ga. native spent the entirety of the 2022 season with Omaha, going 7-7 with a 4.21 ERA in 29 games (24 starts) for the Storm Chasers. He also earned a save. Cox was originally selected by Kansas City in the fifth round of the 2018 First-Year Player Draft out of Mercer University.

Homerin' Hiura: Just 24 hours after knocking his eighth homer of the year, Keston Hiura mashed his ninth last night, tying Scranton/Wilkes-Barre's Jake Bauers for the most in the International League. The 26-year-old has homered in consecutive games on three separate occasions this year. Only Memphis slugger Luken Baker has replicated the feat in the league.

Taylor On the Mend: Milwaukee outfielder Tyrone Taylor is off to a strong start to his rehab assignment. He built upon his stellar debut on Tuesday by doubling and scoring in last night's win. In his brief Sounds career (13 games), Taylor is hitting .455 (20-for-44) with 5 doubles, a triple, 3 homers and 12 RBI.

Singleton's Streaks: Jon Singleton extended his on-base streak to 17 games with an RBI single last night. It's now tied for the fourth-longest of its kind in the IL this season. The lefty has an .834 OPS over the span. While his walk streak came to an end at nine games, it remains the second longest in the IL so far in 2023. He set a Sounds single season record and led the league with 117 walks in 2022.

Starting to Heat Up: After failing to earn a win through the team's first 18 games, Nashville starting pitchers have earned three in their last four games. The Sounds' rotation has posted a 1.02 ERA, 0.89 WHIP and .172 opponent average over the last week, all the best marks in Triple-A over the span.

Strong Arm Barn: The Nashville bullpen continues to rank among the finest in Triple-A, posting the level's second-best ERA (3.16) and WHIP (1.16). They've managed to limit damage through keeping the ball on the ground, picking up 1.39 ground outs per air out, the second-highest rate at the level.

It's Over When It's Over: Eddy Alvarez's scorching nine-game on-base streak came to an end last night with a 0-for-5 performance. Alvarez batted .433 (13-for-30) and posted a 1.283 OPS from April 12 through April 25. He still leads the Brewers organization with a .333 average this season.

Bull on Parade: Abraham Toro pushed his on-base streak to 16 games and his hitting streak to 11 games on Tuesday night with a single. It is one of seven active on-base streaks of 16 or more games in the IL. His hitting streak is tied for the second longest active streak in the IL. Toro is batting .364 (16-for-44) during the hitting streak with five doubles and 10 RBI.

The Future Brew Crew: Nashville opens the 2023 season with five players on the roster who are listed on MLB Pipeline's Top-30 Milwaukee prospects. Outfielder Sal Frelick is the No. 2 prospect, left-handed pitcher Robert Gasser is the No. 9 prospect, left-handed pitcher Ethan Small is the No. 13 prospect, right-handed pitcher Janson Junk is the No. 15 prospect and right-handed pitcher Cam Robinson is the No. 24 prospect.

How Sweet It Is: Sounds manager Rick Sweet begins his fourth season overall and third consecutive season at the helm of the Nashville club. The reigning International League Manager of the Year, Sweet led the Sounds to a 91-58 record in 2022, 70-58 record in 2021 and a 77-67 record in 2014. He has served as the manager for Milwaukee's Triple-A club since the 2014 season and has compiled a 612-528 record during an eight-season span.
