TODAY'S GAME: The Quakes finish this six-game series in Lake Elsinore, with game six of the six-game series against the Lake Elsinore Storm (Padres) here at The Diamond. Today's game is just the third game of the second half.

VS THE STORM: Today's game is the 18th of 30 head-to-head meetings between the two teams and the 12th of 18 here at The Diamond. The Quakes are 6-5 here in Lake Elsinore and 8-7 overall against the Storm in 2022.

LAST GAME: The Storm tallied five times in the sixth inning to break open what had been a back-and-forth game, as Lake Elsinore went on to beat Rancho Cucamonga on Saturday night, winning 15-8 at The Diamond, giving the Storm three wins in the first five games of the series. Quakes' pitching not only gave up 11 hits, but walked nine and hit a batter to help Lake Elsinore's cause. Reliever Orlando Ortiz (1-2) suffered the loss, allowing four runs on two hits with four walks in just two innings. Lake Elsinore reliever Yerry Landinez (3-2) notched the win, allowing just one run on two hits over 2.2 innings, while Alexuan Vega fired three scoreless frames to earn his first save. Lake Elsinore's Justin Farmer homered and drove in four runs to lead the Storm. Damon Keith had three hits and three RBIs, while Griffin Lockwood-Powell homered and drove in two.

OFFENSE IS HUMMIN': The Quakes haven't pitched particularly well in this series, as Lake Elsinore has scored 14, 9, 13, 10 and 15 runs, respectively (61 runs overall) in the first five games. But to counter that, the Rancho offense has scored 7, 24, 8, 11 and 8 respectively (58 runs overall). Damon Keith has a team-high 11 hits (11-for-24) in the series and has also driven in a team-best 12 RBIs. Luis Rodriguez is right behind him, with seven hits and eight RBIs. Both Austin Gauthier and Julio Carrion have two home runs apiece in the series and have combined to drive in 11 runs.

RUN, DON'T WALK: The Quakes gave up another nine walks in last night's loss to the Storm, giving them 392 walks (5.76 per game), second only to the Visalia Rawhide (433). In 2021, the Quakes walked 415 batters in the abbreviated 120-game schedule, a ratio of 3.46 walks per game, or 2.3 walks per game less than this year.

RECENT ROSTER MOVES: The Quakes placed outfielder Jake Vogel on the Injured List on Thursday afternoon. Taking his spot on the active roster is catcher and first baseman Griffin Lockwood-Powell, who joins the Quakes from the Arizona Complex League. Lockwood-Powell was an undrafted FA, signed by the Dodgers in 2021 out of Central Michigan University.

STRONG START FOR THE NEW GUY: The Quakes have gotten a boost from Griffin Lockwood-Powell, who's homered in each of his first two games as a Quake. Lockwood-Powell homered in his first at-bat of his Rancho career in Friday's win, then went deep again in the fifth inning of yesterday's loss. He's knocked in two runs in each of his first two games, giving him four RBIs already. Lockwood-Powell had one homer and two RBIs in five games of Arizona Complex League action over the last two weeks, also slugging a homer in his first game with the ACL Dodgers. In college, he hit a total of 19 homers over four seasons, but only three in 2021, after a career-high 11 in 2019.

JERMING ROSARIO: Right-hander Jerming Rosario makes his 14th appearance and 12th start for Rancho, his fourth appearance and third start against the Storm. Rosario appeared earlier this series, as he got the start on Tuesday, where he allowed four runs on two hits with three walks, while retiring just two batters in a no-decision. Against the Storm in total, Rosario is 1-0 with a 3.48 ERA, allowing four runs on just two hits over 10.1 innings. Rosario was signed by the Dodgers out of the Dominican Republic in 2018.

JESUS GONZALEZ: Left-hander Jesus Gonzalez makes his 12th appearance and 11th start of the year, his third against the Quakes. In two prior outings versus Rancho, he's 0-2 with a 7.71 ERA, allowing nine runs (eight earned) on 15 hits over 9.1 innings. In his last outing overall, he allowed two runs on six hits over five innings in a win at Modesto on June 19. Gonzalez was signed by the Padres out of Venezuela in 2017.
