series vs. the Indianapolis Indians (Pittsburgh Pirates) at Coolray Field, the only series between the two clubs this season. Tonight is Wet Nose Wednesday, presented by New Country 101.5 (dogs free with paid owner on The Bank) and a Xolos de Gwinnett Night (MiLB's Copa de la Diversión for Hispanic heritage)

VS. INDIANAPOLIS: Gwinnett is 32-21 (.604) all-time vs. Indianapolis at Coolray Field, and enters play riding a seven-game home winning streak over the Indians dating back to 4/23/19 (outscoring IND 44-18). The Stripers have won six straight overall against Indianapolis since 6/1/19 (outscoring IND 37-16). In 11 season series vs. Indianapolis since 2009, Gwinnett is 3-4-4 (2-0 since 2018).

MULLDOZING: Kyle Muller struck out 11 batters over 7.0 IP (4 H, 2 R, 1 ER, 0 BB) for the win last night, his second double-digit strikeout game of the year (tied career high with 12 SO over 6.0 IP on 5/14 at DUR). He has recorded three straight quality starts since 6/2, going 2-0 with a 0.90 ERA (2 ER in 20.0 IP), 0.90 WHIP, .194 BAA, and 12.60 SO/9.0 IP ratio (28 SO) in that span.

- IL Leaderboard: Muller leads the league in strikeouts (84) and is among the top 10 in ERA (3rd, 2.89), innings (3rd, 62.1), WHIP (5th, 1.19), and BAA (T-6th, .230).
- GWN Career: Since making his Triple-A debut in 2021, he is 9-7 with a 3.17 ERA (50 ER in 142.0 IP), .226 BAA, and 177 strikeouts (11.22 SO/9.0 IP ratio) in 28 starts.

STIFLING STARTERS: Stripers' starters (Tucker Davidson, Bryce Elder, Nolan Kingham, Kyle Muller, and Huascar Ynoa) have combined to post a 2.49 ERA (21 ER in 76.0 IP), 10.18 SO/9.0 IP ratio (86 SO in 76.0 IP), and seven quality starts over the last 13 games (team is 6-7). The group has allowed 58 hits and just 19 walks in that span.

KINGS OF THE "K": Gwinnett pitchers lead Triple-A in strikeouts with 631 in 61 games (10.34 SO per game). That's six more than Sacramento of the PCL (2nd with 625) SO in 61G). Gwinnett last led Triple-A in strikeouts for a full season in 2011 (team-record 1,223 SO). Kyle Muller (1st, 84), Tucker Davidson (10th, 53), and Huascar Ynoa (T-15th, 50) all rank in the IL top 15 in strikeouts.

DIFF'RENT STREAKS: Preston Tucker enters play riding a 12-game on-base streak. He's batting .300 (12-for-40, 3 2B, 2 HR, 4 R, 5 RBI, 10 BB, .965 OPS) during the streak since 5/27, his second of 10-plus games this year (had 13game on-base streak from 4/24-5/12). Braden Shewmake has a five-game hitting streak since 6/7, batting .333 (6-for-18, 2 2B, 2 R, 2 RBI, 1 SB, .794 OPS) in that span.

WATERS STARTS IT WITH A BANG: Drew Waters tripled on the first pitch thrown by RHP Bryan Hoeing on 6/11 at Jacksonville, his third extra-base hit on the first pitch of a game this season. He also hit first-pitch leadoff homers on 5/3 vs. Charlotte (off LHP Wes Benjamin) and 5/11 at Durham (off RHP Tommy Romero).

- 2022 with GWN: In 28 games overall, Waters is batting .250 (27-for-108, 5 2B, 1 3B, 3 HR, 16 R, 9 RBI, 1 SB), including .457 against LHP (4 2B, 1 HR, 1.143 OPS) and .151 against RHP (1 2B, 1 3B, 2 HR, .466 OPS).
- **GWN Career:** Since making his Triple-A debut in 2019, Waters is batting .247 (153-for-619, 32 2B, 2 3B, 16 HR, 103 R, 57 RBI, 32 SB, .706 OPS) in 157 games.

TONIGHT: The Stripers play game two of a six-game **DEMERITTE RETURNS:** Travis **Demeritte** played for the first time since 6/1 last night (0-for-3, 2 BB, 1 R, 1 SB), just his second game since being optioned by Atlanta on 5/28. He hit .213 (19-for-89, 2 2B, 3 HR, 9 R, 6 RBI) in 26 games during his first career stint with the Braves from 4/22-5/27.

> • GWN Career: Demeritte has reached base safely in 163 of 191 games (85.3%) with the Stripers since 2019, batting .283 (186-for-658, 49 2B, 4 3B, 43 HR, 129 R, 137 RBI, 14 SB, .941 OPS). He is one of three players in Gwinnett history with two 20-homer seasons, joining Stefan Gartrell and Ernesto Meiia.

DESHIELDS KEEPS REACHING: Delino DeShields Jr. has reached base safely in 35 of 42 games (83.3%) with the Stripers this season, batting .252 (30-for-119, 5 2B, 16 R, 10 RBI). He currently ranks among IL leaders in stolen bases (T-9th, 13) and walks (T-10th, 31).

FORD IN THE FOLD: Mike Ford made his Gwinnett debut last night (0-for-2, 3 BB, 1 R), just four days after being claimed by the Atlanta Braves off waivers from the Seattle Mariners. The Stripers are Ford's fifth team this season, as he's also played for Triple-A Tacoma (SEA), Triple-A Sacramento (SF), and both Seattle and San Francisco in the Majors. Ford is a career .197 hitter (12 2B. 17 HR. 46 RBI, .707 OPS) in 118 MLB games with the NY Yankees (2019-21), Mariners (2022), and Giants (2022).

TUIASOSOPO REACHES 100-WIN MARK: Matt Tuiasosopo earned his 100th win as a Triple-A manager on 6/9 at Jacksonville (won 5-1). He is the fourth manager in Gwinnett history to reach 100 wins, joining Dave Brundage (293 from 2009-12), Brian Snitker (161 from 2014-16), and Damon Berryhill (221 from 2017-19).

GOSSELIN GETS THE CALL: Yesterday, the Atlanta Braves selected the contract of INF **Phil Gosselin** from Gwinnett. Gosselin hit safely in 23 of 29 games from 5/1-6/12, batting .312 (34-for-109, 10 2B, 1 3B, 4 HR, 14 R, 16 RBI, .885 OPS) in that stretch. Through 6/13, he ranked 14th in the IL with a .297 average (54-for-182, 13 2B, 2 3B, 5 HR, 25 R, 24 RBI, .831 OPS) in 49 games.

GWN Career: In 284 games over four seasons (2013-14, 2018, 2022), he's batting .295 (309-for-1046, 64 2B, 10 3B, 17 HR, 138 R, 106 RBI, 11 SB, .769 OPS).

MANAGER MATT TUIASOSOPO

Matt Tuiasosopo is in his second season as the manager of the Stripers in 2022 ... He was named the seventh manager in Gwinnett history on 3/30/21, making him the first former Gwinnett player to manage the club (played OF/1B from 2016-17) ... In 2021, he guided the Stripers to a 71-58 record (3rd in Triple-A East Southeast Division) ... On 5/4/21 at Charlotte, he became the youngest manager in Gwinnett history (34 years, 11 months, 25 days) ... On 6/9/22 at Jacksonville, he became the fourth manager in Gwinnett history to reach 100 career wins ... Began his managerial career with Class-A Rome in 2019, earning Atlanta's Bobby Cox Award for MiLB Manager of the Year ... Coached at the Braves' Alternate Training Site in 2020.

- <u>Triple-A Splits:</u> In 11 starts with Gwinnett, is 0-4 with a 6.37 ERA and .298 BAA ... In 14 games (7 starts) at Coolray Field, is 0-4 with a 7.09 ERA and .293 BAA.
- <u>Last Start/Win:</u> Hasn't won in a start since 8/20/21 with Double-A Mississippi at Montgomery (7.0 IP, 6 H, 1 ER, 0 BB, 5 SO in 3-1 victory).

2022 SEASON: Was a member of Gwinnett's Opening Night roster for the first time in his career ... Did not allow a run over his first five games (9.1 IP), all relief outings ... **4/30 vs. NOR:** Made his first start of the year, tossing a season-high 4.0 scoreless innings (1 H, 1 BB, 2 SO) in a combined six-hit shutout (won 5-0) ... **5/10 at DUR:** Earned his first career Triple-A win in relief (2.0 IP, 0 H, 3 SO in 8-4 victory) ... **6/9 at JAX:** In his fifth spot start, tied his season high with 4.0 IP (4 H, 1 R, 0 ER) and struck out seven (won 5-1), his most strikeouts in a game since 8/16/19 with Double-A Mississippi vs. Birmingham (8 SO in 7.0 IP).

2021 SEASON: Opened and closed the year with Double-A Mississippi, going 6-1 with a 2.08 ERA and .225 BAA in 12 games (10 starts) ... Went 5-1 with a 2.29 ERA in his final six starts before his promotion to Gwinnett on 6/29 ... Named the Double-A South Pitcher of the Month for June (3-0, 0.83 ERA, .193 BAA in 5 starts) ...
