IT'S A WINNING STREAK: After winning three straight in Salem and getting back to single-digit games under .500, the FredNats will look to keep the good times rolling tonight behind RHP Bryan Caceres. The FredNat offense has scored 20 runs in the last three wins, the pitching staff has continued its steady improvement throughout this month of May. The three-game winning streak is the longest of the year for the FredNats. Caceres is making his second start of the year, and will look to improve upon his last start in which he didn't make it out of the 4th inning and walked five.

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: Salem scored first against Bryan Sanchez, but the starter for the FredNats benefitted from two double plays and a triple play turned behind him in an 8-5 FredNat win. Murphy Stehly extended his hitting streak to 14 games with four hits, including the go-ahead RBI in the 6th inning and two huge insurance runs in the 9th, and Mason Denaburg earned his second win of the season in relief. Luke Young picked up his first career save as well.

TRIFECTA: For the first time in franchise history last night, the FredNats turned a triple play. Murphy Stehly started it 5-4-3 around the horn, and it took a great turn from Sammy Infante at second base to make it happen. This was the third triple play in MiLB this year, and the FredNats join the Dayton Dragons (Cincinnati High-A) and Midland Rockhounds (Oakland Double-A) as the three clubs that have turned triple plays this year.

STEHLY POWER: Despite only playing 2-3 games per week, FredNat infielder Murphy Stehly has the longest hitting streak of the season in the entire Carolina League at 14 games, and Stehly has only played in 18 games this year. Stehly, a 10th round draft pick of the Washington Nationals last summer out of Texas, played one game with the FredNats last year after the draft before being injured in that game. Last night he had four hits, three RBI including the go-ahead RBI, and started the triple play for the FredNats.

PAUL WITT CAN HIT: 25-year-old Paul Witt is the hottest hitter in the FredNat lineup right now. In the first four games of this series, Witt is 6-for-15 with three doubles, a home run, five RBI and two walks. He's had the go-ahead RBI in two games of the series so far, and in the month of May, Witt is slashing .361/.410/.556 for an OPS of .966. The VCU alum is playing his professional baseball nearby where he played his college ball in Richmond, VA.

BULLPEN SUCCESS: After giving up a 3-0 lead in the 9th inning on Tuesday, the last three nights, the FredNat bullpen has locked it down. In the three wins in Salem, the bullpen has pitched 14 2/3 innings of two-run ball with and just six hits allowed. Thursday night, Franklin Marquez and Brad Lord allowed just two base runners in the final five innings of the 5-3 win for the FredNats. Last night, Luke Young finished the game with three innings of two-run ball to earn his first career save. One run against Young should not have scored due to a defensive miscue.

LORD AND SAVIOR: 2022 18th-round draft pick Brad Lord has been a versatile arm for the FredNats this season. The Tallahassee, Florida native and distant cousin of FredNat Pitching Coach Justin Lord earned his first career save Thursday night with three perfect innings to finish out the game, and has also started a game this year.

THE SKIP IS BACK: The FredNats' leader from 2022 returns to the Managerial role for 2023. Jake Lowery is back for another year in the 'Burg after winning the Washington organizational Manager of the Year award last year after leading the FredNats to a 75-55 record. Lowery, 32, was selected by Cleveland in the fourth round of the 2011 Draft out of James Madison University, where he was given the Johnny Bench Award as the nation's top collegiate catcher. The Midlothian, Virginia native played in the Nationals organization from 2016 to 2019, including parts of two seasons with the Potomac Nationals. Lowery reached the Triple-A level in 2018 and transitioned to a managerial role in 2021 after nine seasons in the minor leagues. Lowery is the 28th manager in franchise history dating back to 1978.

THE STAFF: Joining Lowery on the staff is returning hitting coach Delwyn Young, pitching coach Justin Lord, returning developmental coach Carmelo Jaime, athletic trainer Jacob Meyer, strength and conditioning coach Nathan Sier, and Performance Analyst Josh Freligh. Young, 41, played parts of five major league seasons with the Dodgers (2006-08) and Pirates (2009-10), and participated in spring training with the Nationals in 2013. Under his guidance, The FredNats' offense scored the most runs in the Carolina League in 2022. He previously served as a hitting coach with Kingsport and Brooklyn in the Mets system, and spent the 2021 season managing the State College Spikes of the MLB Draft League.

Lord, 43, begins his fourth year in the Washington organization after serving as the Pitching Coach for the Double-A Harrisburg Senators last season. Lord was scheduled to be the FredNats' Pitching Coach in the team's inaugural season in Fredericksburg in 2020, but that season was ultimately canceled due to Covid. Jaime, 37, was Detroit's 24th round selection in the 2008 Draft out of Miami Dade College. The Santo Domingo, Dominican Republic native reached Double-A in his three-year minor league career, and he returns with Lowery and Young as holdovers from last year's FredNat coaching staff. Meyer begins his sixth season in the Washington organization and first in Fredericksburg after spending the first five years of his Nationals career at the Spring Training facility in West Palm Beach, Florida. Sier begins his first year in the Washington organization after previous stops with Macomb Community College in Metro Detroit (Mich.), and 2SP Sports. Freligh steps into the newly-created Performance Analyst role after previous stops with the L.A. Dodgers and Boston Red Sox.

TONIGHT'S START: Bryan Caceres is making his second start of 2023, although he is no stranger to beginning a game. For his career, Caceres had made 31 starts and is 15-19 with a 5.59 ERA. He's logged nearly 250 innings in his career, all while sporting a 1.50 WHIP.

Caceres led the FredNats in starts and innings pitched last season, and has transitioned to more of a long relief role in the bullpen this season.

LAST TIME OUT: Caceres worked 1.1 innings of relief in his most recent appearance against the Columbia Fireflies. In his last start on 5/14 against Carolina, he three earned runs in 3.2 innings.
