Lansing is coming off a six-game series split against Fort Wayne, the Lugnuts' ninth series split of the year.

Sunday: Fort Wayne TinCaps 12, Lansing Black Rhinos 1. William Simoneit broke up a perfect game with a walk, broke up a no-hitter (with two outs in the 7th) with a single, broke up a shutout (in the 9th) with an RBI double, and pitched the final two innings in relief, as Fort Wayne beat Lansing in a laugh.

On Deck: The Lugnuts play the Captains through Sunday, returning home to host Dayton on August 20-25.

What's New in 2021: Entering this season, the Black Rhinos' stadium name changed from Cooley Law School Stadium to Jackson® Field™, Lansing moved up to the High-A Central and the ballclub accepted an invitation to affiliate with the A's, the Nuts' fourth MLB partner, following the Royals (1996-98), Cubs (1999-2004) and Blue Jays (2005-2020).

LUG•NOTES: HEADLINES AND POINTS OF INTEREST

No Place Like Close to Home: Before today, Lansing had not had to leave the state since June 27 thanks to three homestands and road trips to Midland (Great Lakes) and Comstock Park (West Michigan).

Three Nuts Go to Washington: Before Friday's game vs. Fort Wayne, catcher **Drew Millas** and pitchers **Richard Guasch** and **Seth Shuman** were traded by the Oakland Athletics to the Washington Nationals in exchange for catcher **Yan Gomes** and utilityman **Josh Harrison**. All three reported to High-A Wilmington. Interestingly, Gomes, the first Brazilian to reach MLB, played for the Lugnuts in 2010.

More Trade Talk: In addition to **Yan Gomes**, a number of other former Lansing players were also dealt approaching the deadline, namely:

- the Chicago Cubs traded **Jake Marisnick** to the Padres for Fort Wayne TinCaps starting pitcher Anderson Espinoza,
- the Cubs also sent **Ryan Tepera** to the White Sox for Bailey Horn,
- the St. Louis Cardinals traded **Lane Thomas** to the Washington Nationals for Jon Lester,
- the Seattle Mariners sent **Kendall Graveman** to the Astros in a four-player deal with Rafael Montero for Abraham Toro and Joe Smith,
- and the Detroit Tigers traded **Daniel Norris** to the Brewers for Reese Olson, who immediately joined the West Michigan Whitecaps.

Alumni Report: Vladimir Guerrero, Jr., who played for the 2017 Lansing squad at 18 years old, is third in the Majors in batting average (.328), second in home runs (34), first in RBIs (85), second in on-base percentage (.423), second in slugging (.659), first in total bases (245), first in OPS (1.082) and first in runs scored (82).

Transactions: The Lugnuts added three players to the roster before today's game, namely catcher **Cooper Uhl** and super-utilityman **Elvis Peralta, Jr.** from Triple-A Las Vegas and 6'8 starting pitcher **Jorge Juan** from Low-A Stockton.

Historical Lugnuts Roster Index: Debuting with two innings of relief on Saturday, **Norge Ruiz** became the 849th Lansing player all-time and the 45th player used this year. (When **Cooper Uhl** and **Jorge Juan** debut, they'll become 850/851 and 46/47.) The franchise record for most players used in a single year is 54, set in 2017. Currently, 18.7% of the franchise's players have reached the Major Leagues (159 of 849), with five players debuting in the Majors this season (**Ty Tice**, **Joshua Palacios**, **Taylor Saucedo**, **Conner Greene** and **Kirby Sneed**).

History vs. Lake County

The Lugnuts are 5-7 in 2021 and 88-90 vs. the Captains all-time, with a record of 53-47 vs. the Caps at home, compared to 35-44 in Eastlake. In 2019, the Nuts won the series, 10-9.

TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2009: The Nnuts scored four runs in the 1st and three runs in the 3rd for a 7-0 lead at Fort Wayne, only to see the TinCaps rally for one run in the 4th, five runs in the 5th, and the game-tying run in the 6th, leading to extra innings. In the last of the 12th inning, Matt Daly's wild pitch brought in Cole Figueroa, and Fort Wayne walked off with an 8-7 victory.

2011: Casey Lawrence pitched a nine-inning complete game, and the host Lugnuts beat South Bend, 6-1. Lawrence allowed four hits, one run, no walks and three strikeouts. The game took two hours and 13 minutes. Groundout:flyout ratio for Casey: a ridiculous 20 groundouts and one flyout.

Root, Root, Root for the Home Team: July 4th's Lugnuts/Dragons series finale drew a season-high attendance of 10,109. That's higher than the average attendance in MLB for the Baltimore Orioles, Pittsburgh Pirates, Tampa Bay Rays, Miami Marlins and Oakland Athletics. Only nine of the 119 other Minor League teams have drawn a larger crowd to a game this season: Albuquerque, Nashville, Salt Lake, Charlotte, Fresno, Indianapolis, Round Rock, Durham and Las Vegas.

Pitching is an Art... and So is Sculpting: Blake McFarland, who pitched for the 2012 Lansing Lugnuts, is now a professional sculptor who competed on NBC's reality show "Making It," hosted by Nick Offerman and Amy Poehler, but was eliminated in the fifth episode.

Major League Lugnuts: Five former Nuts have made their Major League debuts this season, bringing the total to 159 all-time - pitcher **Ty Tice** '18, outfielder **Josh Palacios** '16-'17, pitcher **Taylor Saucedo** '16-'17, pitcher **Conner Greene** '15 and pitcher **Kirby Sneed** '16-'17. Tice and Palacios made their first MLB appearance in the same game for the Toronto Blue Jays on April 9th. It was the seventh time in team history that two Lugnuts made their MLB debut in the same game, with the first occurring on September 14, 1998: **Carlos Febles** and **Carlos Beltrán** for the Kansas City Royals. Sneed most recently debuted, appearing in relief for the Blue Jays on July 28.

Star of Stars: The 2021 MLB All-Star Game MVP Award was won by 2017 Lugnut **Vladimir Guerrero, Jr.**, who went 1-for-3 with two RBIs, including a 468-foot home run, in the American League's 5-2 victory. Fellow 2017 Lugnut **Bo Bichette** came off the bench for the A.L. as reserve shortstop.

Record-Setting, Single Game, Stolen Bases: On June 15, **Max Schuemann** broke **Samad Taylor's** franchise single-game record of four steals in a game (set July 1, 2018) with five stolen bases against the Great Lakes Loons.

Record-Setting, Single Game, Home Runs Allowed: On June 20, **Stevie Emanuels** broke the franchise single game record, tied many times before, of three homers served up in a game, giving up four HRs to the Loons - two apiece by Deacon Liput and Andy Pages.

Record-Setting, Single Game, HBPs: On July 14, Lansing Lugnuts pitchers hit seven Lake County Captains, breaking the franchise single game record, and the second-highest single game HBP total for a team plunked by one pitching staff behind the 1993 Gulf Coast League Braves, who were hit eight times on June 18, 1993.

Representing His Country: 1B/3B **Jordan Diaz** played for Colombia in Olympic Baseball Qualifying play, blasting a game-tying home run in the 9th against Venezuela, but Colombia lost all three games in opening pool play and was eliminated. Team USA won the tournament, punching a ticket to Japan.

Front Office Connections: Lugnuts pitching coach **Don Schulze** was drafted 11th overall by the Chicago Cubs in 1980, 12 picks before Oakland Executive Vice President of Baseball Operations **Billy Beane** was drafted by the New York Mets. Lugnuts first baseman **Patrick McColl** set a new Harvard baseball single season record with 70 hits in 2019, breaking the previous record held by Athletics General Manager David Forst.

Clubhouse of Higher Learning: The Ivy League is well represented on the Lansing roster. First baseman **Patrick McColl** played for Harvard University, reliever **Michael Danielak** was drafted from Dartmouth College and catcher **William Simoneit** spent four years at Cornell University before grad-transferring to Wake Forest. Speaking of outstanding academic institutions, starter **Jack Cushing** spent four years at Georgetown University.

International Appeal: Seven nations are represented on the Lugnuts' roster: USA, Colombia, Cuba, Dominican Republic, Japan, South Africa (**Anthony Phillips**) and Venezuela (**Javier Godard**).

Finally: Pitchers **Jeff Criswell**, **Stevie Emanuels** and **Shohei Tomioka**, catchers **Jared McDonald**, **Drew Millas** and **William Simoneit**, first baseman **Patrick McColl**, and outfielder **Michael Goldberg** have all made their pro debut this season with the Lugnuts.

So Many Starters: The Lugnuts have used 14 different starting pitchers this season, namely **Brady Basso**, **Reid Birlingmair**, **Jeff Criswell**, **Jack Cushing**, **David Leal**, **Stevie Emanuels**, **Richard Guasch**, **Rafael Kelly**, **Bryce Nightengale**, **Colin Peluse**, **Leudeny Pineda**, **Seth Shuman**, **Shohei Tomioka** and **Brock Whittlesey**.

Last Appearance: July 29 vs. Fort Wayne, gave up eight hits and two walks in 5 2/3 innings, with runners constantly on base, yet allowed only three fourth-inning runs while striking out seven... Lugnuts rallied from 3-1 deficit with one in the 7th and four in the 8th against Austin Smith for 6-3 win.

2021 in Lansing:

- Debuted in the High-A Central against the Dayton Dragons, July 2, with a dominating performance: 6 IP, 3 H, 1 R, 1 BB, 6 K... allowed only one hit through five scoreless innings before giving up a run in final frame... Lugnuts cruised to 10-3 victory over Dayton.
- Started Game 2 of doubleheader, July 9 at Great Lakes: tossed 7-inning CG, 3 H, 1 R, 2 BB, 9 K on 84 pitches (57 strikes) in Lugnuts' 2-1 win... came four outs from throwing a no-hitter, broken up by Leonel Valera's two-out single in the 6th.
- July 15 vs. Lake County, pitched in relief, piggybacking Shohei Tomioka (4 IP, 2 H, 0 R) and firing the final five innings scorelessly to complete a five-hit 4-0 shutout of the Captains... result was even more impressive considering Captains scored 48 runs in the other four games of the series.
- July 22 at West Michigan: dominated the Whitecaps through five scoreless innings before tiring and allowing two runs in 6th and final inning... fanned eight batters in Nuts' 5-2 victory.

2021 in the Low-A West:

- Began the season as the No. 3 starter in Stockton's rotation and blasted out of the gates with four hitless innings, walking three and striking out two, against the Modesto Nuts, May 6.
- Finished May with a 0.92 ERA in four starts: 2 ER in 19 2/3 IP, 7 BB, 23 K and a .147 opponent average.
- Struck out 10 batters in six innings at Rancho Cucamonga, May 27, allowing two hits, one walk and one run via solo HR.
- In June, posted a 4.71 ERA in four starts, with 11 ER in 21 IP, 3 BB, 20 K, .321 avg., though of the four starts, two were poor (4 HR in 5 IP vs. San Jose, June 10; 7 R/4 ER in 4 1/3 IP at Fresno, June 17) and two were outstanding (5.2 IP, 2 R, 8 K vs. Lake Elsinore, June 3; and 6 IP, 1 UER, 0 BB, 4 K at Inland Empire, June 24).
- Shut down right-handers: .221/.292/.379... left-handers hit .281/.288/.421... of 10 walks issued, however, nine were to right-handed batters.
- Opposing base-stealers were 5-for-7 in success rate.

Going Pro: Drafted in the 22nd round, 2019, signing with the A's for \$1,000... signing scout: Tripp Faulk, who also signed the Lugnuts' Bryce Nightengale and Elvis Peralta, Jr., and was the scout for 2021 Oakland Athletics draft picks Zack Gelof (2nd round) and Aaron Holiday (13th round).

2019 Pro Debut: Opened in AZL with two appearances for A's Gold before making 11 appearances, 6 starts, with Short-Season Vermont... in best appearance, 8/1/19, pitching five shutout two-hit innings at State College, striking out two... opposition went 4-for-5 in stealing bases against him.

Traveling Childhood: Born in Enid, Oklahoma - the ninth-largest city in the state - Cushing moved to Colorado for "several years" before his family relocated to Flower Mound, 28 miles north-west of Dallas, when he was seven... he grew up rooting for the Texas Rangers... Flower Mound is named for, yes, a flowering mound - a 50-foot tall hill nicknamed "The Mound," maintained by The Mound Foundation, which features dozens of flowers naturally blooming each spring... Flower Mound is located 28 miles northwest of Dallas, on Grapevine Lake... 2019 Lugnuts starter Sean Wymer also hailed from Flower Mound... in his spare time, he enjoys hunting, fishing and hiking.

Glory Days: Attended Marcus High School... named team captain as a senior, going 6-2 with a 0.73 ERA to earn the honor of District 6-6A Pitcher of the Year... was named to the Texas Sports Writer's Association Class 6-A All-State Team and Dallas Morning News All-Area Team... set Marcus H.S. career records in no-hitters and shutouts, ranking second all-time in wins and innings and third in complete games.. played two years on the Marcus H.S. varsity football team.

Legend in the Family: Sister Lexi ended her softball career at Middle Tennessee State University (2017-2020) as the Blue Raiders' all-time record holder in home runs (50), RBIs (145), total bases (371), putouts (1500) and sacrifice flies (T-1, 7).

Hoya Saxa: Attended Georgetown University, where he set the program's career strikeout record (236) with 11 K's in his final college appearance, 5/17/19 vs. Butler at Shirley Povich Field... set Georgetown's single-game strikeout record with 16 K's vs. Mount St. Mary's, 3/5/19... notched 87 strikeouts total in 79 1/3 innings as a senior in 15 games, 12 starts, leading the Hoyas with a 3.06 ERA... Named All-Big East Second Team, Big East Honor Roll, and Big East All-Academic Team... baseball greats from Georgetown include legendary scout Clyde Sukeforth, Doc White, speedster Art Devlin, and Del Bissonette... the only Hoyas to reach the Majors in the last 50 years: Sean Maloney (1997-98) and Tim Adelman (2016-17).

Lansing Connection: Played for 2018 Lugnuts hitting coach (and current Dunedin Blue Jays hitting coach) Matt Young on the Dallas Mustangs... teammates with Zac Cook, currently playing for the Dunedin Blue Jays.
