## FROM THE CROWS NEST

ONG FINISH: Despite dropping three of the series first four games in Lakeland, the Marauders finsihed with two wins on Saturday (9-3) and day (2-1). On Sunday, pitching led the way - Clevari Tejada got the start, tossing two shutout innings. He was followed by Sean Sullivan, us Clode, Jose Garces and Noah Takacs who combined to allow one run on three hits through the game's final seven innings. acs, who recorded the last six outs, earned his first Single-A save. Yordany De Los Santos drove in both of Bradenton's runs. The win secured ries split, snapping a stretch of three series losses to begin the 2025 season.

**IIGHT'S STARTER:** Major-League rehabber, **Dauri Moreta** will make his first outing of the 2025 season tonight at LECOM Park. Before lergoing Tommy John Surgery in March of 2024, the 26 year-old right hander made 55 relief outings with the big-league Pirates in 2023. He ted a 3.72 ERA over 58 innings while fanning 76 hitters and walking 24. Tonight's outing will mark his first ever in a Marauders uniform as vas initially signed by the Cinciantti Reds (2015) and spent seven seasons in their system before being traded to Pittsburgh ahead of 2022 *v*in Newman trade). His last in-game outing was March 3rd, 2024 in a Spring Training game versus the Orioles (422 days ago). He features a ball, slider and change up. His heater sits at 95.2 miles per hour and slider stands outs given it's unorthodox screwball shape.

TING IT DONE ON THE BUMP: Over their last seven starts, the Marauders rotation has dominated. Jonawel Valdez (2), Clevari Tejada (2), los Castillo, Matt Ager, and Peyton Stumbo have combined for a 2.28 ERA over 23.2 innings of work. Over that stretch, they've allowed just home run, 11 walks, and limited opponents to a .221 batting average. TEENAGE TITAN: MLB. com's No. 42 prospect and 2024 first-round pick Konnor Griffin finshed the week strong. Since he turned 19 on Thursday, he is 7-for-14, with two home runs, six RBI and five extra-base-hits (3 GP). Moreover, he has registered elite-level exit velocities early on in his first pro season. Of his first 20 hits this year, seven have left the bat at over 100 mph including a 114.2 mph single versus Palm Beach on 4/8. The top mark is the highest recorded by a Single-A player this season and would place 38th in all of MLB. The only players to hit a ball harder at the big-league level this season include: Riley Greene, Pete Alonso, **Oneil Cruz**, Aaron Judge, Ketel Marte, Ryan Mountcastle, Vladamir Guerrero Jr., and Kyle Schwarber among others. Moreover, is second in the FSL league in stolen bases with 11.

MAKING HISTORY: Pirates No. 30 ranked prospect David Matoma was promoted to Single-A Bradenton on Saturday, and made his team debut to ssing 1.1 innings while allowing one earned run with one punchout. The 19-year-old right hander was born in Kasana, Uganda. If he makes it to the big leagues, he would become the first player from Uganda and second from Africa (Gift Ngoepe). On Saturday, he featured a fastball that sat between 96-98 miles per hour and touched 99 multiple times. Last year, he reached 101 mph in an FCL game. In 24 prior outings before 2025, Matoma allowed just two earned runs over 38.2 innings. Over that stretch, he fanned 42 and walked 17.

SCOUTING THE TARPONS: The Tampa Tarpons enter play on Tuesday with the same record as Bradenton at 8-13 after dropping 5 of 6 to the Dunedin Blue Jays. They enter the week having stole 48 bases in 58 attempts to lead the FSL. However, they have struggled in other offensive categories, posting a .624 OPS (9th) with just nine homers (9th) and 45 extra-base hits.On the mound, they enter play with a 4.84 ERA and have allowed the league's second most walks (118). Their 5.27 ERA from starting pitchers is the third highest in the FSL. Their scare features six of the New York Yankees Top 30 Prospects (MLB Pipeline): INF Roderick Arias (No.6), LHP Henry Lalane (No. 10), C/IB Edgleen Perez (No. 12), RHP Gage Ziehl (No. 17), LHP Griffin Herring (No. 26), and RHP Greysen Carter (No. 29)

**CHANGING THE TIDE:** These two teams were quite familiar with each other in 2024, meeting 15 times. The Marauders finished the sesaon series at 3-12 overall and just 1-5 against Tampa at LECOM Park, inclduing five in a row to end the year. This week, they seek their first series win versus the Tarpons since June of 2021 (6/15-6/20) when they took four of six. In that stretch, they are 22-38 against them.

ANOTHER FIRST: After starting starting 11 games at shortstop and two as DH to begin the year, top prospect Konnor Griffin made his season debut in centerfield on Wednesday night at Lakeland. The start marked his first \*technical\* pro-start in the outfield, but the 18-year-old did appear in eight big-league Spring Training games for Pittsburgh, all in center. Griffin always played outfield during his amateur career, and started playing shortstop in 9th grade. He is poised to cover plenty of ground in the outfield, as his quickest sprint speed this season registered at 30.8 feet per second, the fifth fastest in all of Single-A.
