☛ **SUNDAY FUNDAY:** On Sunday, the RidgeYaks dropped 16 runs off 14 hits and a 8-for-20 clip hitting with runners in scoring position in the series finale against the Wilson Warbirds. The 16 runs marked the most runs scored by a Salem team since September 2, 2022 when Salem scored 17 runs in a win at Augusta. The only game with more runs in the last five seasons was April 27, 2025 when Salem dropped 19 runs in a 19-1 victory at Hickory. Sunday also marked the third time this season (April 3 vs Delmarva and April 7 vs Wilson) that Salem has scored double digits in a game.

☛ **FUTRELL PITCHER OF THE WEEK:** On Sunday, southpaw **Devin Futrell** made his first start of the season, and the former Vanderbilt Commodore went five innings scoreless and hitless. Futrell walked the leadoff man before retiring the next 15 Warbird hitters in order. Salem won six Carolina League Pitcher of the Week honors which was the most by any Carolina League team and Futrell is the inaugural winner of the award in 2026.

☛ **OPATA HEATING UP:** After going 0-for-7 to start his professional career on opening weekend, outfielder **Andrews Opata** is starting to figure it out at the plate. Opata recorded a pair of triples on Wednesday for his first and second career hits before following that up with an encore on Thursday when he went 2-for-3 with a pair of stolen bases. Opata in this series vs Wilson went 8-for-14 (.571) with four stolen bases, five runs scored and four extra-base hits.

☛ **TY HODGE IS HOT:** Despite an 0-for-4 pro debut at the dish for infielder **Ty Hodge**, he's been on a stretch the last six games. Over his last six games since April 3, the former UTSA Roadrunner is hitting .421 (8-for-19), with five RBI, five walks and a stolen base.

☛ **BROWN'S DOMINANCE:** After hurling five scoreless frames on Opening Night, southpaw **Dylan Brown** followed with encore on Thursday night. The former ODU Monarch hurled 3.2 innings scoreless against Wilson while striking out eight of his 16 batters faced. In two starts this season, Brown has pitched to 14 punchouts which is good for third in the Carolina League (trailing Jervis Alfaro and Miguel Flores of Hill City), and tied for third in all of Single-A.

☛ **18 PUNCHOUTS:** On Thursday, the Salem RidgeYaks pitching staff sat down 18 Wilson Warbird hitters en route to a 2-1 victory. Those 18 strikeouts were the most K's by the staff since April 11, 2024 at Delmarva. Salem's pitching staff has struck out 102 batters on the season which is fourth best in the Carolina League.

☛ **BULLPEN SHUTDOWN:** Through ten games this season, the Salem RidgeYaks arm farm is dealing to a 3.52 ERA out of the bullpen. That ranks second in the Carolina League trailing just the Hickory Crawdads (2.98). That mark is also fifth best in all of Single-A. In 53.2 innings of work from the bullpen, Salem relievers are 5-2, with two saves, 73 strikeouts (sixth in Single-A) and just 21 earned runs allowed.

☛ **RIDGEYAK SPEEDSTERS:** Salem also rank fifth in the Carolina League and seventh in Single-A with stolen bases this season. The Yaks have swiped 23 bases in the ten games this season. The Single-A leading top three is swept by Carolina League team with Fayetteville stealing 40 bases, Fredericksburg at 37, and Hill City rounding it out at 31. For context, after ten games last season, Salem had just six stolen bases.

☛ **RUNS PARTY:** Through the first ten games of the 2026 season, Salem has struck for 67 runs scored at the dish. Behind three double-digit scoring performances already this season, the RidgeYaks are second in the Carolina League in total runs scored and rank tied for fifth in Single-A.

☛ **ONE RUN BALL:** Salem also owns a 3-1 record this season in one-run games. Salem, Hickory and Clearwater are the only teams in all of Single-A to have played four one-run games this season.

BY THE NUMBERS

On Sunday, Salem scored 16 runs in a 16-3 victory over the Wilson Warbirds. The 16 runs are Salem's most in a home game since a 16-8 win over Fayetteville on July 13, 2021

The Salem bullpen has pitched to a 3.52 ERA which is second in the Carolina League just behind the Hickory Crawdads (2.98) and fifth best in all of Single-A

👉 **WELCOME BACK STANLEY TUCKER:** Stanley Tucker played in his first minor league baseball game since August 13, 2024, Salem at Fredericksburg. And after a 598-day hiatus rehabbing from injuries, Tucker did not disappoint. Crushing a three-run home run in his first at-bat back on Friday, April 3, as well as tying his career highs with two hits, and four RBI.

👉 **CONTINUING MOMENTUM FROM 2025:** If you include the final three series of the 2025 season against Fayetteville, Kannapolis and Carolina, Salem has won 18 of their last 25 games and have won their last three home series and three of the last four series overall and are averaging 5.50 runs a game since August 20, 2025. Salem has also won three straight series dating back to the end of last season.

👉 **LIKE FATHER, LIKE SON:** Salem southpaw Devin Futrell is in his second season of professional baseball after being drafted from Vanderbilt University during the 2024 MLB draft. Salem, Virginia is not unfamiliar territory for the Futrell family. Devin's father, Mark Futrell, was drafted by the New York Yankees in 1988 and played six years in the minor leagues. His dad pitched in 10 games going 1-1 with 17 strikeouts in 1991 with the Salem Buccaneers, at the time the Pittsburgh Pirates High-A team. Devin and Mark are the first and only father-son combo in Salem baseball history.

👉 **SALEM WINS OPENING WEEKEND:** The Salem RidgeYaks won their inaugural series against the Delmarva Shorebirds two games to one. This marked the second year in a row that Salem won the opening weekend series (Swept Delmarva last season). This made history marking the first time in the modern stats era (Since 2005), Salem has won the Opening Series in consecutive seasons.

👉 **RIDGEYAKS IN FORT MYERS:** 11 members of the RidgeYaks Opening Day roster saw time in Fort Myers participating in Spring Training with the Boston Red Sox. OF Eddy Azocar (5 GP), OF Anderson Fermin (4 GP), OF Skylar King (4 GP), OF Andrew Opata (4 GP), IF D'Angelo Ortiz (2 G), IF Avinson Pinto (2 GP), OF Stanley Tucker (2 GP), IF Ilan Fernandez (1 GP), IF Starlyn Nunez (1 GP), IF Frederik Jimenez (1 GP), and RHP Griffin Kilander (1 GP).

👉 **RIDGEYAKS IN ARIZONA:** Both OF Stanley Tucker and RHP Brandon Neely had the chance to represent the Red Sox in the Arizona Fall League with the Salt River Rafter. Tucker finished second on the AFL club with 15 RBIs and led the team with 13 stolen bases; one of only two players in the league to reach both marks. As a result was named a 2025 Arizona Fall League Rising Star. Neely meanwhile made five appearances (one start), posting a 10.80 ERA while recording 11 strikeouts in AFL play.

WHAT IS A RIDGEYAK

The name "RidgeYaks" is a creative and symbolic reflection of the Southwest Virginia community and carries a double meaning:

Ridge: A tribute to the scenic Blue Ridge Mountains that tower beyond the outfield wall at Salem Memorial Ballpark, a nod to the beautiful, rugged landscape that defines the region.

Yak: The name carries two layers of local-flavor meaning. First, "yak" plays off the slang for kayak, a subtle salute to the region's love for kayaking and other outdoor recreation on the area's waterways.

A Yak is also a real animal. The Yak is a long-haired, heavily built bovine native to high-altitude mountains. The Yak comes to symbolize strength, resilience, stability, and a hardworking spirit, qualities that resonate with both the team and the broader Salem community.

The new mascot, named Mac the Yak, takes inspiration from McAfee Knob, one of the region's most iconic natural landmarks, linking the team's identity not only to athletic grit, but to local heritage, outdoor adventure, and mountain pride.

- Was the seventh SEC pitcher that the Red Sox drafted through the first nine rounds, including his LSU teammate and third-round pick Anthony Eyanson
- Finished the 2025 season pitching for the State College Spikes in the MLB Draft League, tossing 6.1 innings with 12 strikeouts and a 1.42 ERA
- Attended Nicholls State University for two years, working primarily as a starter, before transferring to LSU for the 2025 season
- Had his best performance as a freshman and was named National Freshman Pitcher of the Year by both Collegiate Baseball and the NCBWA
- Came to LSU as the No. 17 transfer portal prospect per Baseball America. He hails from Gonzales, LA, and played prep baseball at St. Amant High School
- Earned a College World Series relief win vs. Arkansas on June 18, striking out the final two Razorback hitters in the top of the ninth
- Ranked third in the NCAA in hits per nine (4.97) and 15th in strikeouts per nine (13.50), posting a 5-1 record with a 4.58 ERA in 70.2 innings as a sophomore at Nicholls State in 2023
- Was selected as part of Boston's 2026 Spring Breakout Roster
- As a senior with LSU last year, posted a 2-0 record with a 4.80 ERA in 17 relief appearances last season apart of the 2025 National Champion run for the Tigers
- Made his last collegiate start on May 22, 2024, vs Texas A&M Corpus Christi when he was with Nicholls State. Hurlled six innings of just one run baseball with six strikeouts to his name
