BERRY LEADS OFFENSIVE ERUPTION IN 11-4 WIN

A huge night from Jacob Berry helped Jacksonville knock off Durham 11-4. The Jumbo Shrimp scored four runs in the top of the first inning - their second straight night with a four-spot in a frame. After Durham cut things to 4-3 in the second, Jacksonville plated three runs in the fourth, two of them coming on Jesús Bastidas' first home run of the season. Berry added an RBI single in the sixth, and after a Bulls run in the seventh, Berry scored on Kemp Alderman's RBI single in the eighth. Berry then doubled in two in the ninth to set the final score at 11-4.

DEFENSE AGAINST THE DARK ARTS

Jacksonville has yielded the third-fewest runs (114) in Triple-A while posting the level's third-best ERA (3.73). While the club leads all Triple-A staffs in strikeouts (321), the Jumbo Shrimp have also done a phenomenal job at turning batted balls put into play into outs; Jacksonville leads Triple-A by turning 73.9 percent of balls put into play into outs. Only five clubs have recorded a rate of at least 72 percent this season.

STARTER FLUID

Jacksonville starting pitchers have yielded two runs or fewer in 18 of the last 22 games. During this stretch, Jumbo Shrimp lid-lifters have ceded only 36 runs, 34 earned, on 68 hits (5.8 H/9) in 106.1 innings for a 2.88 ERA, totaling 47 walks (4.0 BB/9) against 113 strikeouts (9.6 K/9). On the season, Jacksonville starters collectively lead Triple-A in batting average against (.188) and WHIP (1.14) while ranking second in strikeouts (145), third in innings (133.0), fourth in ERA (3.38), fewest runs allowed (52), fewest hits allowed (86) and GO/AO (1.23). Of the club's 29 games this season, Jumbo Shrimp starters have surrendered more than three runs just three times.

HOUSE OF HORRORS

Since rejoining Triple-A in 2021, the team Jacksonville has struggled the most against is by far the Durham Bulls. The Jumbo Shrimp are just 45-68 (.398) against the Bulls. In Durham, Jacksonville is 22-34 (.393), getting outscored by a 320-259 margin. The Jumbo Shrimp have won only three of the nine series the clubs have played at the DBAP since 2021.

ON THE OFFENSIVE

Heading into play on April 22, Jacksonville had scored at least five runs in a contest just three times in 22 affairs, ranking last in Triple-A in runs scored (68, 3.1 per game) and each slash line category (.186/.296/.282/.578). The Jumbo Shrimp have now plated at least five runs six times in the seven games since, awakening a previously-dormant offense. During this stretch, the club ranked fourth in Triple-A in runs scored (49, 7.0 per game). They place seventh in both average (.280) and OBP (.372), 11th in OPS (.800) and 12th in SLG (.428) over this seven-game span. Jacksonville was hitting just .166 with runners in scoring position over the season's first 22 games; they are 25-for-82 (.305) in those situation over the last seven contests.

FRIENDS CLOSE, ENEMIES CLOSER

Fifteen of Jacksonville's last 18 games, and 22 of their 29 (75.9 percent) on the season, have been decided by three runs or fewer. The Jumbo Shrimp are now 10-12 (.455) thus far in 2026 in these narrowly-decided matchups. In 2025, the Jumbo Shrimp went 58-34 (.630) in games decided by three runs or fewer, meaning 65.2 percent of their 89 victories came by those slim margins. The 2025 Jumbo Shrimp tied Indianapolis for the most one-run victories (29) in MiLB. Those 29 one-run wins were the most for a Jacksonville club since 2014 Suns won 35 such games.

THE WHITE WIZARD

Thomas White, who takes the ball for Jacksonville on Thursday at Durham, makes his third Triple-A start of the 2026 season. The 21-year-old left-hander has compiled 14 strikeouts in just 8.0 innings over his first two starts with the Jumbo Shrimp this season. In just his first four career Triple-A starts going back to last season, White has generated 45 whiffs out of 125 swings - a rate of 36.0 percent. To put that in perspective, only two MLB pitchers (Jacob Misiorowski & Dylan Cease) have posted a higher whiff rate this season.

SHRIMP BITES

Jacksonville's seven steals on Wednesday matched the third-highest in a single game in recorded club history (since 2005)... Jacob Berry is hitting .367/.474/.500/.974 over his last 18 games.

ABOUT THOMAS

-A native of Rowley, Mass., White burst onto the national scene in middle school. When he was in eighth grade and only 14 years old, his fastball was clocked at 91 miles per hour, leading *Prep Baseball Report* to rank him as the top player nationally in the 2023 class when he was a high school freshman.

-White had committed to Vanderbilt for college, but was selected in the supplemental first round (35th overall) by the Miami Marlins in 2023. He signed with Miami for an over-slot \$4.1 million.

-In *MLB Pipeline's* 2026 prospect rankings, White is ranked as the No. 1 Marlins prospect and No. 17 prospect in all of baseball. He is ranked as the fourth-best pitching prospect behind Nolan McLean of the New York Mets, Bubba Chandler of the Pittsburgh Pirates and Trey Yesavage of the Toronto Blue Jays.

-White won Gatorade Player of the Year in the state of Massachusetts twice while at Phillips Academy Andover (Andover, Mass.) in high school. He went 6-1 with a 0.21 ERA as a junior. As a senior, he was 5-2 with a 1.66 ERA and 95 strikeouts with just 10 hits allowed over 42 innings pitched.
