LAST GAME

Trailing twice down to their final at-bats, the Bowie Baysox rallied on both occasions, eventually walking off the Altoona Curve, 7-6, in 13 innings on Sunday afternoon. Bowie took an early 3-1 lead with three runs in the bottom of the first, including an RBI triple from Jackson Holliday and a two-run home run from Billy Cook. The Baysox held that edge until two outs in the top of the ninth, when Chavez Young mashed a three-run home run to give the Curve a 4-3 edge. Two pitches into the bottom half of the ninth, Silas Ardoin clobbered his first Double-A home run - a solo shot to tie the game and force extra innings. The 4-4 tie lasted into the 13th, where Joe Perez hit a go-ahead, two-run home run for Altoona off right-hander Ignacio Feliz to make it 6-4 Curve. Ardoin doubled with one out in the bottom half to score Cook, who started the inning out at second base, leading to a walk-off, two-run blast from Greg Cullen to dead center field, clinching the third consecutive series win for Bowie.

TODAY'S OPPONENT

The Erie SeaWolves enter this week with an overall record of 63-50 on the season. The Double-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers, the SeaWolves are 26-19 in the second half, already first half champions in the Southwest division. Erie has excelled in 2023, sitting second in the Eastern League in team average (.246) and home runs (141) at the plate, while holding the second-highest fielding percentage (.980), and the best ERA (3.81) amongst a starting staff. The SeaWolves' roster includes seven of the top 30 prospects in the Tigers' system, per MLB Pipeline, including IF Jace Jung (No. 4 DET/No. 71 OVR), RHP Ty Madden (No. 6 DET), RHP Wilmer Flores (No. 7 DET), LHP Brant Hurter (No. 12 DET), OF Justice Bigbie (No. 21 DET) IF Danny Serretti (No. 25 DET), and RHP Tyler Mattison (No. 28 DET).

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

Right-hander Ty Madden is set to take the ball for Erie in the series opener. The No. 6 prospect in the Tigers' system, per MLB Pipeline, Madden's 3.77 ERA on the season is fourth-best in the Eastern League (among qualifiers). While he has allowed the most home runs (13) and walks (41) on the Erie staff, he's also accumulating the second-most innings (93) and strikeouts (109) on staff. Madden has had a couple of tough starts by his standards in the month of August, matching a career high with six earned runs allowed through five innings against Harrisburg on 8/4, before allowing four earned runs on seven hits through five frames in Akron his last time out, this past Wednesday. However, sandwiched in between those two outings is a performance of seven, shutout innings in Altoona on 8/10. In total, Madden's ERA this month is 5.29. In two starts against the Baysox, the right-hander has allowed five earned runs through 5.2 innings, only recording two outs in his most recent start against Bowie on 6/8, allowing two runs and firing 29 pitches in the process. A competitive balance - A round selection of the Tigers in 2021 out of the University of Texas, where he was battery mates with Baysox catcher Silas Ardoin, Madden features a fastball, curveball, slider, and changeup.

ROAD WARRIORS

After losing each of their first two six-game series on the road this season, the Baysox have won four of their last six series away from home. Overall this season, Bowie is 21-16 away from home since its 4-10 start to begin the 2023 campaign. Those 21 road wins since 5/23 are second-most in the Eastern League. The road success from the Baysox has been powered by the pitching staff, who own a 4.02 ERA away from home this season - third-best of any team at the Double-A level.

HAPPY HOLLIDAY

Top prospect Jackson Holliday has had a stellar start at the Double-A level. Holliday has reached safely in 22 of 25 games at the new level. Sunday afternoon, he mashed his ninth triple overall on the season - the second-highest total in Minor League Baseball. Holliday has posted the second-highest batting average (.350) and highest on-base percentage (.431) in the Eastern League since his Double-A debut on 7/14. Holliday's overall on-base percentage of .457 across the three levels he's played in 2023 leads all of Minor League Baseball. He is the ninth player to play for the Baysox prior to his 20th birthday and the first 19-year-old to make his debut with Bowie since Manny Machado and Dylan Bundy in 2012.

SWING IT LIKE SILAS!

C Silas Ardoin has made a name for himself at the plate in Double-A so far with Bowie. After hitting just .215 through 68 games with High-A Aberdeen, Ardoin is hitting .364 after 12 games at the new level. Ardoin led the Baysox with a .444 average (8-for-18) at the dish last week against Altoona, highlighted by a three-hit day on Tuesday, go-ahead single on Friday, and a game-tying home run in the ninth inning on Sunday. Ardoin already brings plenty of plate discipline and defensive versatility to the Baysox, joining Bowie with a walk rate of nearly 20% and a caught stealing rate of nearly 30% from behind the dish in his time with Aberdeen.

ONE RUN REBOUND

The Baysox have still turned a corner in one-run games this season. After claiming one-run victories on both Saturday and Sunday, The Baysox are 14-2 in their last 16 one-run games. Bowie is 24-14 overall in games decided by one run in 2023 - the third-most one-run victories in Minor League Baseball, while playing in the fifth-most one-run games. Last season, the Baysox were just 21-29 in such games, giving them the most one-run losses in Minor League Baseball in 2022, along with the second-lowest winning percentage in the Eastern League in such games. 11 of the last 16 Baysox wins this season have been by a single run.

CAREER NOTES

- Sixth-most strikeouts and innings across the Orioles' system in 2022, along with the third-most wins.
- Held opponents to a .183 average with runners in scoring position.
- Named South Atlantic League pitcher of the Week on May 15, after twirling six shutout innings with eight strikeouts against Hudson Valley. Part of a month where he pitched to a 1.64 ERA and held opponents to a .116 average.
- Spent all three seasons in Aberdeen, but due to the reclassification of minor league baseball, advanced to High-A from Single-A short season in between 2019 and 2021.
- Spent three seasons starting games for VCU. Was first-team all-conference as a senior, posting a 2.50 ERA through 20 starts and 86.1 innings. His 118 strikeouts in 2019 are fourth-most in program history.

NOTES BY START

- Dealt with multiple runners on base in all three innings worked, including runners at third base in the second and third innings.
- Retired five straight batters, but allowed three-straight extra-base-hits with two outs in the second inning. Allowed three-straight singles in the third inning.
- Allowed a leadoff home run, but then retired every batter for the remainder, but Bowie lost 1-0. First Complete Game One-Hitter for Bowie since 2009.
- Allowed first base hit in the fourth inning. Game shortened due to rain. First Complete Game Two-Hitter for Bowie since 2015
- Allowed a two-out walk in the first inning, then retired the next 11 batters. One-out single in the fifth was one of only two hits in the game.
- Pitched in relief of Austin Voth. Retired first six batters before allowing a double and two fly outs for a run. Three of four hits allowed were doubles.
- Started with two scoreless innings, but allowed four hits and three runs in the third inning. Walked two batters and hit one to allow three more runs in the fourth.
- Allowed three runs in a five batter span in the second inning. Retired the next seven batters before exiting.
- Fourth batter of the game hit a two-run home run. Other four base hits were first-pitch singles
- Allowed a single and double to across first three batters for only run. Left with a full count and one out in the sixth inning due to cramping. Only worked two groundouts.
