# BROOKLYN CYCLONES (20-25) at JERSEY SHORE BLUECLAWS (24-21)

RHP Jeffrey Colón (0-2, 7.28) vs. LHP Matt Osterberg (1-2, 4.45) ShoreTown Ballpark | Thursday, June 1, 2022 | 7:05 PM Lakewood, N.J. | Game #46 | Road Game #25



Lakewood, N.J. Lame Last Time OUT: Brooklyn was swept by Jersey Shore in Wednesday's doubleheader... The Cyclones dropped the opening game, 9-3, as well as the nightcap, 5-0...Brooklyn jumped out to a 2-0 lead in the 1st in the lid-lifter on a SS William Lugo home run...Blue-Claws jumped in front for good with a 6-run 3rd inning, capped by a two-run blast from SS Casey Martin...3B Mateo Gil added a solo clout for the Cyclones in the 4th...Martin, 3B Nick Ward, CF Marcus Lee Sang, 1B Rixon Wingrove, 2B Freylin Minyety, and RF Jared Carr all tallied multi-hit games in the initial contest for Jersey Shore...Lee Sang, Wingrove, and Martin all recorded multi-RBI games, as well...Wingrove added a two-run home run in the 6th inning of Game 2 and contributed 3 RBI in the affair...C Andrick Nava and LF Wilfredo Flores joined Wingrove with multi-hit nights in the finale...2B Mateo Gil picked up 2 of Brooklyn's 3 hits in the nightcap...RHP Rodolfo Sánchez, LHP Tristan Garnett, RHP Tommy McCollum, and RHP Orion Kerkering combined on the shutout for the 'Claws.

UP TO PAR-ADA: C Kevin Parada extended his hitting streak to 5 games with a knock in both ends of Wednesday's doubleheader...The 21-year-old is 7-for-his-last-18 (.389) with a run scored, 2 doubles, 2 RBI, and a pair of walks...He is tied with Greenville's INF Blaze Jordan for 3rd in the SAL in doubles (13)...Only Winston-Salem OF Wilfred Veras (20) and Hudson Valley OF Spencer Jones (15) have collected more...In May, Parada was tied for 3rd in the circuit in two-baggers (9) and tied for 4th in the league in extra-base hits (12).

RAMÍ ROCKETS: OF Alex Ramírez has reached base safely in 12-straight games since May 18...In that time, the 20-year-old is slashing .256/.373/.419 with a .791 OPS...Ramírez has 6 runs scored, 4 doubles, a home run, 6 RBI, and 8 walks in those contests...Since joining Brooklyn's roster on July 4 of last year, Ramírez leads the South Atlantic League in hits (103), doubles (25), and total bases (154)...He only trails teammate OF Stanley Consuegra (36) in extra-base hits (34) and Jersey Shore 1B Rixon Wingrove (60) in RBI (57).

MATEO MASH: INF Mateo Gil has reached base safely in 10 of his last 11 games dating back to May 17 at Hudson Valley...While the 22-year-old is slashing only .235/.366/.559, he has registered an impressive .925 OPS in that time...Gil is 8-for-34 at the plate (.235) with 6 runs scored, 2 doubles, 3 home runs, and 9 RBI adding 6 walks and a hit-bypitch...Since that date, Gil is tied for the South Atlantic League lead in home runs (3)... The former 3rd-round pick also leads Brooklyn in RBI (9) and OPS (.925) during that stretch (min. 15 PA).

**THEY'RE NO. 1:** The Cyclones' pitching staff has been marvelous over the course of the team's last 14 games...Since May 17, Brooklyn has permitted just 29 earned runs (36 total) on 69 hits through the last 118.2 innings...That is good for a 2.20 ERA...That mark is the best in the SAL and the High-A level...It is also the 2nd-best ERA in all of Minor League Baseball in that stretch...Kansas City's Single-A Columbia leads MiLB (2.00)... Cyclones' pitching has walked 51 (10.5 BB%) and struck out 144 in that span (29.6 K%)... The 'Clones have outscored opponents, 61-36, over the 14-game stretch...Brooklyn is 9-5 during that span...On the year, the Cyclones lead the South Atlantic League in ERA (3.95).

**BULL-PEN ON PARADE**: The Cyclones' relief staff has been exquisite at quelling fires in 2023...Entering Thursday, Brooklyn has the best bullpen ERA (3.25) in the entire South Atlantic League and among all High-A teams...Rome (3.55) is 2nd in the circuit and the Dodgers' High-A Great Lakes is 2nd (3.32) at the classification...The Cyclones' relief ERA is also the best in the New York Mets' farm system and 5th best in all of MiLB...The 3.25 ERA is 6th best in all of Minor League Baseball.

JEFE JEFFREY: RHP Jeffrey Colón matched his then-team-season-high with 6.2 innings of 2-run ball in a no-decision on Friday night...The 23-year-old also matched a career-best with 9 strikeouts...That equaled his total from last August 28 at Jersey Shore... In his last 2 home starts, Colón has hurled 13.1 innings, allowing just 3 runs on 9 hits... The Las Matas de Farfán, D.R. native has a 2.03 ERA and permitted only 3 walks and punched out 16 in that span.

AT HIS BECK-ON CALL: RHP Jace Beck has been a strikeout machine in the 2023 season...The 22-year-old tied a career-best with 7 strikeouts over 2.1 innings, earning the win at Jersey Shore on Tuesday...Beck had previously punched out 7 on August 19, 2021, with the Florida Complex Mets at the FCL Astros...Through his first 11 relief appearances this summer, the Tuttle, Okla. native has registered an eye-popping strikeout rate of 45.1% and 20.09 strikeouts-per-nine-innings...Among South Atlantic League pitchers with at least 10.0 innings pitched, Beck leads the circuit in K/9 (20.09) and is 3rd in strikeout rate (45.1%)...His 20.09 K/9 mark is 2nd-best in MiLB among arms with at least 10.0 IP...Cleveland's RHP Tyler Thornton (20.54) leads at High-A Lake County.

THRILL OF THE 'CHASE': After a bumpy month of April, INF Chase Estep picked up the pace at the plate in the season's second month...The former Kentucky Wildcat had a 9-game hitting streak stretching back to May 14 at Wilmington snapped on Sunday... In his last 19 games dating back to May 5, the 23-year-old slashes .297/.357/.500 with a .857 OPS...Estep has accumulated 10 runs scored, 6 doubles, 2 triples, a home run, and 10 RBI in 70 plate appearances...The Corbin, Ky, native has also registered a 129 wRC+... Estep has garnered at least one knock in 15 of those 19 games...In his first 12 outings, he was just 2-for-43 (.047) at the dish with a wRC+ of -21...Estep has also raised his batting average by 149 points in that time (.047 to .196).

vs. JERSEY SHORE: Brooklyn travels south to Jersey Shore for a 8-game set against the Phillies' High-A affiliate...The BlueClaws posses 2 of Philadelphia's top 30 prospects per *Baseball America*: RHPs **Orion Kerkering** (25) and RHP **Tommy McCollum** (29) are featured...INF **Hao Yu Lee** (6) is currently on the 7-day injured list...The Cyclones went dropped 2-of-3 to Jersey Shore in their last meeting at ShoreTown Ballpark from April 25-30... The final 3 games of that series were postponed due to weather...On the year, the Cyclones are 3-3 against the BlueClaws in 6 matchups.

THE DONUT SHOPPE: Brooklyn's pitching staff has made a habit of tossing donuts on the scoreboard...The Cyclones completed their 4th shutout of the 2023 season with an 8-0 win at Jersey Shore on Tuesday night...All 4 blankings for Brooklyn's pitching staff have occured in May...The Cyclones beat Aberdeen, 3-0, at home on May 7 and shutout Hudson Valley, 6-0, on the road in Game 1 of a doubleheader on May 21...Brooklyn's previous shutout was a 4-0 triumph vs. Winston-Salem last Wednesday afternoon...Tuesday marked the 'Clones first shutout over the BlueClaws since a 7-0 win at ShoreTown Ballpark on August 23, 2022...LHP Keyshawn Askew (6.0 IP) and RHP Jeffrey Colón (3.0) united on a 3-hitter that dav.

**BLADE RUNNER:** RHP **Blade Tidwell** is in the midst of his best stretch of baseball in 2023...The 21-year-old did not factor into the decision on Tuesday, but hurled 3.2 innings of shutout ball...Over his last 3 starts dating back to May 17 at Hudson Valley, Tidwell is 2-0 with a 1.32 ERA (2 ER in 13.2 IP) with just 6 hits allowed...The Loretto, Tenn. native has walked 12 and struck out 19...Tidwell's strikeout rate is 32.8% during the stretch and opponents hold a meager .130 batting average (6-46) against him...In that span, the 2022 2nd-round pick is tied for 4th in the SAL in strikeouts (19).

IN THE 'PALM' OF HIS HAND: IF/OF Jaylen Palmer has scattered himself across the Cyclones' all-time leaderboards...Entering Thursday, the 22-year-old is Brooklyn's franchise record holder in games played (179), at-bats (589), plate appearances (705), runs scored (93), walks (96), and stolen bases (44)...Palmer passed INF Ronny Mauricio '21 (63) for 2nd place in Cyclones history in RBI (65) last Tuesday, added an RBI on Saturday, and is 4 behind INF José Peroza (69) for the all-time mark...The Canarsie, Brooklyn native is 2nd all-time in total bases (189), tied for 5th in home runs (15), and 6th in hits (111).

OMAR ON THE RUN: In addition to his 18 stolen bases in 2023, OF Omar De Los Santos remains among the best base stealers in Minor League Baseball since the beginning of 2022...The 23-year-old has accumulated 88 stolen bases in that span, which is tied for 4th most in Mil.B...Only Red Sox prospect INF David Hamilton (96), Aberdeen OF Luis Valdez (94), and Marlins farmhand INF Nasim Núñez (93)...De Los Santos has also snagged 51 more bases than any other Mets prospect in that time...Fellow Cyclone IF/OF Jaylen Palmer is 2nd with 37...Omar is already 14 swipes shy of matching INF Walter Rasquin's franchise record for single-season stolen bases (32) which was set back in 2017.

BIG STU: At 6-foot-9, RHP **Tyler Stuart** has been as consistent and imposing as any starting pitcher in the South Atlantic League in 2023...The 23-year-old had his scoreless inning streak snapped at 15.1 innings on Sunday, but permitted just 2 earned runs over 25.1 frames (0.71 ERA) in 5 starts during May...Stuart leads the SAL — and all qualified High-A pitchers — in ERA (1.13) by nearly a full run over Wilmington's LHP **Dustin Saenz** (2.03)... Stuart is also 7th in the circuit in WHIP (1.15), 8th in batting average against (.213), and 10th in strikeouts (48)...The Kankakee, III. native is also 1st in LOB% (89.4%), 2nd in FIP (2.87), 3rd in xFIP (3.50), and 4th in strikeout rate (30.8%) plus strikeouts per 9 innings (11.08).

RIDING THE 'D' TRAIN: RHP Dylan Tebrake has been nearly untouchable since being reinstated from Brooklyn's injured list...Since being activated on May 14, the 23-year-old has faced only one batter over the minimum...In 4 appearances, Tebrake has not allowed a run and walked only 2 over 6.0 innings, registering 8 strikeouts.

**GREAT SCOTT!:** RHP **Christian Scott** punched out a career-high 8 batters, earning the victory on Saturday vs. Winston-Salem...The Coconut Creek, Fla. native posted 5 innings of 1-hit, shutout ball...Over his last 2 starts dating back to Game 2 of last Sunday's double-header at Hudson Valley, Scott has not yielded a run on 2 hits over 9 innings...The former Florida Gator has not walked a hitter and punched out 10...In 4 starts since returning to Brooklyn on May 5, Scott is 1-0 with a 3.07 ERA (5 ER in 14.2 IP), 1 walk, 15 K's, and a WHIP of 0.82.

AMAZIN' STARTS HERE: Brooklyn boast the top 2 Mets per MLB Pipeline in C Kevin Parada and CF Alex Ramírez...They also hold 3 of the Top 10 prospects, according to MLB Pipeline and Baseball America and 5 of the Top 30...They include Parada (No. 1 MLB Pipeline/No. 4 Baseball America), Ramírez (2/5), and RHP Blade Tidwell (5/9)...INF William Lugo (24/26) and RHP Christian Scott (28/26) also appears on both lists...OF Stanley Consuegra ranks as the organization's No. 19 farmhand per MLB Pipeline.

PROSPECT RADAR: Entering the 2023 season, Baseball America deemed Colón one of the Mets' "14 Prospects to Watch Beyond The Top 30"

JEFE JEFFREY: Colón matched his then-team-season-high with 6.2 innings of 2-run ball in a no-decision on Friday night...The 23-year-old also matched a career-best with 9 strikeouts...That equaled his total from last August 28 at Jersey Shore...In his last 2 home starts, Colón has hurled 13.1 innings, allowing just 3 runs on 9 hits...The Las Matas de Farfán, D.R. native has a 2.03 ERA and permitted only 3 walks and punched out 16 in that span.

2022: Assigned to Single-A St. Lucie from extended spring training on June 1...Registered a 3-0 record with a 3.23 ERA (17 ER in 47.1 IP), 2 saves, and 57 strikeouts in 13 appearances (4 starts) with the Mets...Transferred to High-A Brooklyn on August 8...Composed a 1-0 mark with a 1.07 ERA (3 ER in 25.1 IP), 2 saves, and 27 strikeouts in 6 appearances (3 starts) for the Cyclones.

FINISHING STRONG: After joining the Cyclones on August 8, Colón was one of the most dominant pitchers in the South Atlantic League through the remainder of the season... Among pitchers with at least 25.0 innings pitched, the righthander was 2nd in the circuit in ERA (1.07)...He also yielded the fewest hits (13), tied for the fewest runs allowed (3), and ranked 3rd in WHIP (0.79) and batting average against (.153).

FLORIDA'S FINEST: During his stint with St. Lucie, Colón was among the elite producing arms in the Florida State League...From June 1 until the time of his promotion to Brooklyn, the Las Matas de Farfán, D.R. native was 2nd in the circuit in ERA (3.23) and tied for 3rd in strikeouts (57)... He was also 3rd in WHIP (1.10), 4th in innings pitched (47.1), and 5th in batting average against (.227).
