LAST GAME

The Bowie Baysox suffered back-to-back walk-off losses in a doubleheader with the Reading Fightin Phils on Sunday night, their second and third-consecutive walk-off losses, as they finish their road trip with only one win. Bowie fought back to tie things up three different times in game one, losing 5-4, and blew a lead in the second game, losing 4-3. Bowie slugged four different solo home runs during the twin bill, including three different game-tying home runs. Zach Watson and Andrew Daschbach went back-to-back early in game one, while Shayne Fontana slugged his third of the year later in the game. The second game saw another shot Joey Ortiz. Reading used their own power to win game one, as Logan O'Hoppe hit a walk-off solo shot, and Jhalyn Ortiz drove in the winning run in the second game with an RBI single to score O'Hoppe.

TODAY'S OPPONENT

Hartford and Bowie have settled to some very similar numbers over the first six weeks of the season. Entering the series, both teams have scored exactly 155 runs, while Bowie does have a slightly higher ERA, compared to Hartford's 4.40. Hartford has relied plenty on their speed, as they lead the league with 62 stolen bases, despite only having two players with double-digit steals so far this year. Hartford has had to coast on their early offense this season, as their starting pitchers have the third-highest ERA in the league, while their bullpen arms have the second-lowest ERA in the league.

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

Right-hander Noah Davis, a top Rockies prospect and member of the Colorado 40-man roster, has been off to a rocky (get it?) start to the season. While he did go 3-1 with a 3.60 ERA in six starts with Hartford at the tail end of 2021, his six starts in 2022 have lead to an 0-3 record with a 7.77 ERA. While he has allowed multiple home runs in two separate starts, the issue for Davis has been in the walks. Over his last three starts, Davis has walked 12 batters, while striking out only 11. Traded to Colorado from Cincinnati, Davis features a mid-90s fastball, a high-80s slider, as well as a curveball and a changeup.

PATIENCE, YOUNG GRASSHOPPER

Bowie has been frustrating opposing pitchers this season with their patience and discipline at the plate. Their 156 walks lead the Eastern League, despite playing two fewer games than most teams in the circuit. Bowie has also drawn 205 full counts this season, and 87 walks on full counts, both numbers also lead the league.

SLIM MARGINS

Bowie had an early handle on one-run games this season, as they won three of their first four games decided by one run, but have gone 1-6 in one-run games since. Bowie has lost each of their last three games by exactly one run. It is the first time that Bowie has lost three consecutive games by one run each since 5/13-5/16 in 2016 against the Erie SeaWolves. Coincidentally, all three losses, both in 2016 and last week, were all walk-off losses for Bowie.

INTO THE GROUND

Bowie's patience at the plate has been a constant pain for opposing pitchers. Three of Bowie's main infielders have seen more pitches than almost every other player in the Eastern League. Gunnar Henderson has seen the second most pitches in the league, at 566, about 4.1 pitches per plate appearance. Jordan Westburg has seen the third-most pitches in the league, and Andrew Daschbach has seen over 470 pitches in 100 plate appearances.

SETTLING OUT WEST

Infielder Jordan Westburg may have found a new home in the Bowie lineup after a recent change. In a 16-game stretch from 4/20-5/10, Westburg was only able to manage a 6-for-59 mark at the plate (.102) with two doubles, one home run, three RBI, three runs scored, eight walks, and 23 strikeouts, all while batting among the first four spots in the lineup. After moving down into the fifth spot in the lineup on 5/11, Westburg hit 6-for-15 in four games with four doubles and a home run.

STARTER SHORTAGES

Behind a handful of factors, Bowie has been having to rely on many of their bullpen arms for spot starts recently. While Conner Loeprich and Griffin McLarty each have starting experience in their careers, both have shifted into full-time relief roles before being called upon in the last two weeks to start. Over the last two series, Bowie has only accumulated 89 innings from starting pitchers, the fewest in the league, as well as a 5.46 ERA, the highest in the league.

Career Notes

- Saw his ERA more than double across the jump from Low-A to High-A. 2.14 across 33.2 innings with Delmarva, and 4.94 across 31 innings with Aberdeen.
- In the Orioles system, his 79 strikeouts were the third-most among pitchers who made at least half of their appearances in relief.
- Auburn native played four years for his local university, logging a 4.01 ERA, but a 0.67 WHIP.

What They're Saying:

Watson on his approach to at bats: "I took what my college coach, coach Thompson at Auburn, he was big on not walking guys. Challenging the hitters, and going right after them. I try not to waste any time, and just go after them with my best stuff, and my best locations. Attacking hitters is my philosophy."

Watson ongoing through the 2020 draft as an NDFA: "There were a couple of teams that had made contact, but Baltimore was the one that been the most thorough in talking with me so it was a no-brainer."

Garrett Stallings, Bowie Starter and Watson's Throwing Partner: "He's put a ton of work on this offseason. Moving better, a lot more aware of his body. Honestly, I think he's just out there not thinking too much. When a pitcher is in a groove, the gears start turning. He's the most electric guy on the team right now, and he's trying extremely hard to get better, and that's a dangerous combination."

Notes by Outing

- 4/13 @ BNG Double-A debut, fired four perfect innings of long relief against Binghamton to earn a one-run win. He struck out seven batters, including the first four batters he faced.
- 4/20 v AKR Matched his previous relief outing with four more consecutive perfect innings, completing a one-hit shutout of Akron while earning a long save. Struck out three batters, induced six ground outs, and three fly outs. Across first 24 batters faced, only two reached a three-ball count.
- 4/27 @ RIC Saw his perfect streak come to an end on the fifth batter of the game on a single by Brandon Martorano. Allowed two runners to reach second base, but none to reach third base.
- 5/3 v HBG Lost his 13 inning scoreless streak after only two batters. Allowed back-to-back doubles to open the first inning, as Jake Alu drove in a run. Taylor Gushue followed with a two-run home run for three runs in the opening frame. Faced the minimum for 12-consecutive batters, but hit another snag in the fifth inning when he allowed a two-run home run to Alu. Bowie tied the game at five in the fifth, as Watson departed midway through the top of the sixth.
- 5/11 @ REA Allowed a two-out solo home run to Aldrem Corredor in the first inning, just into the corner in left field. Allowed two baserunners in the second inning through a walk and an error, but worked a double play. Faced exactly four batters in all five innings pitched on the night.

Coaching Staff

Manager: Kyle Moore

The 2022 season will be the 13th season for Moore in the Orioles organization. He played 29 games over two seasons (2010-11) before becoming a coach. He spent three seasons as a player/coach (2013 Frederick Keys, 2014 Bowie Baysox, 2015 Delmarva Shorebirds) before being named as the Shorebirds hitting coach in 2016 and the Keys hitting coach in 2017. Hitting Coach: Branden Becker

Becker was drafted by the Orioles in the 17th round of the Major League Baseball First-Year Player Draft in 2015 and played parts of four seasons in the organization before retiring in May, 2019. He rejoined the Orioles as the Fundamentals Coach for the IronBirds for the 2020 season before it was canceled. He served as the Hitting Coach for the Complex League Orioles in 2021.

Pitching Coach: Josh Conway

Conway was selected in the fourth round of the 2012 Major League Baseball First-Year Player Draft by the Chicago Cubs out of Coastal Carolina. He played three seasons with the Cubs organization, making it to Double-A in 2016. The Smithburg, Md native returned to the Chanticleers to complete his undergraduate degree and served as a student assistant and assistant pitching coach before joining the Orioles.
