## TODAY'S HEADLINES

# LAST TIME OUT: The Saints had an early 2-1 lead but struck out a season-high 16 times en route to a 6-4 loss in Indianapolis on Thursday. After an hour and 26 minute delay, Indy scored the first run on a Nick Yorke RBI single in the first inning. Diego A .Castillo responded with a solo home run to tie the game in the second. A Wynton Bernard sacrifice fly later in the inning gave the Saints the lead. However, Indianapolis scored three runs in the third inning to reclaim the lead and hang onto

strikeout from the fifth through the eigth inning. It marks the third time this season the Saints have struck out 16 times. The Saints would get the tying run to the plate, but dropped the game 6-4, marking their sixth straight loss.

ON THE SKID: The Saints have dropped their last six games, tying their longest losing streak of the season and their fourth-longest streak in franchise history. They

it. The Saints had four hits after the third inning, recording 10 consecutive outs via

previously lost six in a row when they were swept by Louisville from July 9-14. There have been only two skids of seven-or-more games, the most recent being the franchise-record 11 consecutive losses from May 8-20, 2022. During this sixgame skid, the Saints have been out-scored 39-29 and been out-hit 63-47.

Stall six losses have been decided by three-or-fewer runs, including the last

\$\overline{\Sigma}\$ All six losses have been decided by three-or-fewer runs, including the last four, which have been decided by two-or fewer. The tying run has been at the plate or on base in five of the six losses, with the only other being the 6-5 walk-off loss on Wednesday.

FINDING THE GAPS: The long ball has not been much of a factor for the Saints in the month of August, hitting a Triple-A-low eight homers this month, tied with El Paso and Round Rock for the fewest in the circuit. However, they have still gotten extra-base hits, hitting 33 doubles in August, tied for the most in Triple-A with Reno and Toledo. The Saints' four triples in August are also tied for the third-most in Triple-A. The club's .389 slugging percentage this month is good for 12th in the International League.

GOING FOR A PERFECT 10: Caleb Boushley will look to become the Saints first 10-game winner since joining the International League in 2021. He is currently tied for the season-season record with nine wins, along with Randy Dobnak's nine wins this year and Chandler Shepherd, who did so in 2021. Boushley previously won double-digit games in 2022, going 12-2 with Nashville. No IL pitcher has had multiple 10+ win seasons since 2021. Only 16 IL pitchers have posted multiple 10+ win seasons in the Statcast Era (2015).

NO VICTORY FIELD: Indianapolis has proved to be a challenging road trip for the Saints this year, going 1-8 in Circle City. Their .111 win percentage is the lowest against any team in a single season since joining the International League in 2021. Over the course of a season series (minimum six games), the Saints have been held to two-or-fewer wins on three previous occasions: vs Toledo, 2021 (2-9), vs Buffalo, 2022 (2-4) and vs Syracuse, 2024 (2-4).

**BANNON ON THE BRINK:** Rylan Bannon is looking to break a streak of 30 hitless at-bats, dating back to his final at-bat on August 1. It is the longest streak for the Saints this season, as is his nine-game hitless streak. He has now tied the franchise records, both held by Daniel Descalso, who went on an 0-for-30, ninegame hitless skid from May 18-28, 2021.

**ELECTRIC EELES:** Since joining the Saints on July 4, he has constantly found ways to get on base, sporting a .419 on-base percentage in Triple-A. He's reached base in 27 of the 31 games he's played in, drawing 17 walks and been hit by a pitch four times. He is fourth among full-season minor league players in on-base percentage at .442 across three levels. Of the three players ahead of him, only one has played in Triple-A.

SUMMERTIME SEVERINO: In Yunior Severino's 58 games since May 21, he has hit .327 (71-for-217), with 12 home runs, drawing 40 walks, owning a .970 OPS. In that time, Severino leads the league in OPS, ranks second in batting average and on-base percentage (.430), third in RBI (47), fourth in slugging percentage at .545 and eighth with 71 hits. His 40 walks since May 21 are the ninth-most in the league.

**TWINS UPDATE:** The Twins got another quality start from Bailey Ober as they beat Texas 3-2. Carlos Santana hit a sacrifice fly in the ninth inning that gave Minnesota a 3-2 lead. The Twins bullpen allowed just one baserunner over the final 3.0 innings in the win.

APPEARANCE PRIOR: 8/4 @ IOW...made 19th start of the season and second of the lowa series...allowed three runs on four hits, one home run, walking one and striking out a season-tying low one over 5.0 innings...did not allow a hit until the fourth inning, a solo home run to Owen Caissie...was the first of four consecutive hits allowed, followed be two doubles and a single, bringing in all three runs allowed...only batter to reach after came on an error to open the fifth...did not factor into the decision in a 10-9 Saints loss in 10 innings.

WORLD SERIES RUNNER-UP: Caleb spent his college years not far from home at the University of Wisconsin-La Crosse. As a freshman, he got to experience something that not many players get the opportunity to experience: a trip to the College World Series. His DIII squad reached the championship after beating Salisbury, 7-3, Emory, 3-2 in 12, losing the first game of the semifinals to Trinity(TX), 16-7, but bouncing back to win the second game, 10-7. Unfortunately, they met their match in the championship dropping the best-of-three to Cortland, getting swept 11-3 and 6-2.
