RANCHO CUCAMONGA QUAKES (29-14)

RHP Christian Zazueta (4-1, 2.52 ERA) vs. RHP Jose Dicochea (3-3, 5.74 ERA)

TODAY'S GAME: The Quakes continue their longest road trip of the year, as they take on the Stockton Ports (ATH) in game five of a six-game set and game five of a 12-game, 13-day road trip. The Quakes will return to LoanMart Field on Tuesday, June 3rd to face the San Jose Giants. Tickets are available at rcquakes.com.

VS THE PORTS: Today's game is the 17th of 18 games (all in the first half) against the Ports and the 11th of 12 at Banner Island Ballpark. The Quakes have dropped seven of ten in Stockton in 2025, but after winning five of six at home, are now 8-8 against Stockton in 2025. In 2024, Rancho went 8-2 against the Ports, 5-1 in Stockton.

LAST GAME: Stockton capitalized on 11 Rancho walks and defeated the Quakes for the third time in four games, winning 5-2 on Friday night at Banner Island Ballpark. Davis Diaz had two hits and two RBIs for the Ports, while Stockton reliever Tucker Novotny (2-0) earned his second win of the series by striking out five over 2.1 innings of scoreless relief. Samuel Munoz (5) homered and drove in both runs, finishing with two of Rancho's four hits. Quakes' reliever Logan Tabeling (2-1) struggled with his command in the loss, walking five batters, while giving up four runs (three earned) on just one hit. Rancho has now dropped four of their last six games overall and three of four in this set.

DON'T WALK: Rancho pitching has struggled in this series, allowing 30 runs on 30 hits over four games. That's not the most alarming stat though, as Quakes' pitchers have given up 42 walks over 33 innings pitched through the four games. The Quakes now have an ERA of 3.68, second behind San Jose's 3.29. 233 walks is now third most in the league.

ROSTER MOVES: The Quakes have made several roster moves this week in Stockton. Three days after sending RHP Jhonny Jimenez back to the ACL, they transferred him back to Rancho on Thursday. INF Raynerd Ortega was added to the roster from the ACL and Marco Corcho was activated from the Injured List on Wednesday. Gio Cueto was placed on the Injured List on Tuesday.

UNFAMILIAR TERRITORY: The Quakes ended their two-game skid on Thursday night, avoiding tying their longest losing streak of the year. Consecutive losses to open this Stockton series was the first time Rancho had lost two straight since they dropped back-to-back games against San Jose on April 17-18. The Quakes have only had three losing streaks this season, two two-game streaks and their longest of the year, a three-game losing streak here in Stockton back in April. Rancho's best record in a single half was in the second half of the 2018 season, when they went 52-18 and finished a whopping 15 games ahead of second-place Lancaster. That 2018 season also marked their last Cal League Championship, their third in franchise history.

CHRISTIAN ZAZUETA: Right-hander Christian Zazueta makes his ninth start of the year and his fourth against Stockton. In three games against the Ports, he's 0-1 with a 4.63 ERA, allowing six earned runs on 13 hits over 11.2 innings. In his last start, Zazueta allowed three hits over six scoreless innings in a win over Inland Empire on May 18th. Last year in Rancho, Zazueta went 1-5 with a 6.36 ERA over 14 games (11 starts) and 52.1 innings. Zazueta signed with the Yankees in 2022 out of Mexico and then was traded to the Dodgers in February of 2024 in the trade that saw former Quake Caleb Ferguson go to the Yankees.

JOSE DICOCHEA: Right-hander Jose Dicochea makes his tenth appearance and fourth start for the Ports, his fifth appearance and second start against Rancho. In four games against Rancho, he's 1-0, but with a 10.45 ERA, allowing 13 runs (12 earned) on 14 hits over 10.1 innings. In his last outing, he fired four perfect innings of relief in a win over San Jose on May 18th. Dicochea has spent parts of five seasons with the Ports, starting in 2021. Dicochea was drafted by the A's in the eighth round of the 2019 draft out of Sahuarita High School in Arizona.
