RIDERS TAKE SERIES FINALE IN CORPUS BEHIND HOMER AVALANCHE:

The Frisco RoughRiders crushed the Corpus Christi Hooks 11-3 on Sunday afternoon from Whataburger Field, winning the series 4-2. For the fifth time in the six games, Corpus Christi (9-9, 40-47) started off the game with a run in the first inning, this time off of rehabbing Frisco (10-8, 49-37) starter **Cody Bradford**. The runs scored on a double steal, and was the only run Bradford surrendered in his lone inning of work. The Riders immediately struck back in the second when **Arturo Disla** clubbed a two-run home run and **Rafe Perich** added on with a two-run shot of his own in the third to make it 4-1 against Cole Hertzler (1-1). After a Hooks run in the bottom of the third, **Corey Joyce** laced an RBI single in the fourth before Perich and **Dylan Dreiling** hit back-to-back bombs in the fifth, boosting the lead to 7-2. After another Hooks tally in the fifth, Joyce homered in the sixth and Dreiling added a two-run triple, pushing the score to 10-3. In the eighth, **Keith Jones II** powered his 10th home run of the season to finalize the score at 11-3. **Janser Lara** (3-1) captured the win for the Riders with two innings out of the bullpen, allowing one run and striking out four.

THIS CURRY IS SPICY:

RoughRiders starter **Aidan Curry** tied a career best with 12 strikeouts in his start on Tuesday against Corpus Christi over 6.0 innings in a no-decision and has now whiffed 23 in his last 2 starts (11.2 IP). His 12 strikeouts are the most whiffs by a Texas League starter this season and was the most by a RoughRiders starter since **Victor Payano** cut down 13 Missions on May 3rd, 2016 (the franchise record is 14 by **Robbie Erlin** on June 26th, 2011). Frisco also struck out 18 as a team on Tuesday, tying their season-high and franchise record for a nine-inning game. The RoughRiders have 3rd-most strikeouts in Minor League Baseball with 140 (11.7 per game) in their last 12 games.

IT TAKES TWO:

Frisco hit a season-best 6 home runs in the Corpus Christi series finale Sunday. Along with **Rafe Perich** hitting 2 homers on the day, 3 RoughRiders (**Arturo Disla**, **Corey Joyce** and **Keith Jones II**) have all homered in back-to-back games entering into the series opener against Tulsa.

RAFE AT HOME:

Riders infielder **Rafe Perich** has an incredibly clutch for the RoughRiders, homering 10 times in his first 36 games with the RoughRiders. All of but 4 of his 10 home runs have either tied the game or gave the RoughRiders the lead, including his go-ahead, 2-run home run in the 8th on Tuesday in Corpus. The Riders are 9-0 when he homers. His 21 home runs this year are the most in the Rangers organization. With 5 3-hit games in July already, he is batting .419 (18-for-43)/.500/.860/1.136 in the month. For the first time in his career, he had 3 hits or more in 3 games in a row. Since May 31st, he is 3rd in the Texas League in average (.341), 5th in OBP (.435), 1st in SLG (.697), 2nd in OPS (1.132), 3rd in hits (45), 1st in doubles (15), 1st in extra-base hits (26), 1st in total bases (92) and 1st in runs (38). He is the reigning Texas League Player of the Week, hitting 4 homers in Corpus Christi.

RIDERS ARE POSTSEASON BOUND:

The Riders clinched a playoff spot with a win on June 18th, capturing the Texas League South Division 1st Half. The Riders have now made the playoffs 11 times, their first berth since 2024, with two championships in 2004 and 2022. The Riders have now won the first half 9 times, their first since 2024. Frisco finished the first half 39-29 (.567).

BIG POWER STRETCH:

In their last 18 games, Frisco is 1st in the Texas League with 36 long balls and 3rd in all of Minor League Baseball. Their 119 home runs through 86 games are the most in franchise history, as are their 6.2 runs per game (the 4th-highest mark in Double-A since 2005) with Tulsa, this week's opponent, owning the best mark since 2005.

OH, YOU THINK THE DARKNESS IS YOUR ALLY:

The Riders have been the best run-scoring offense in the 7th inning or later in Double-A (187 runs). In the 8th inning last week in Corpus Christi, the RoughRiders scored 15 runs in 6 games.

GIMME THAT OFFENSE EARLY AND OFTEN:

Frisco's 58 runs in the 1st inning this year are 2nd in the Texas League. They have scored in the 1st inning in 29 games and have scored multiple runs in the 1st inning in 14 games this season. The Riders are 10-10 when trailing after one inning this year, including winning 4 games last week in Corpus Christi in which they allowed runs in the 1st inning. When scoring 7 or fewer runs, the Riders are 22-35 (including a combined 9-11 record when scoring 6 or 7 runs) and 27-2 when scoring 8 or more. Frisco is also 20-19 in 1 or 2-run games.

YOU WANT THE HITS, WE GOT UM:

Through 86 games the RoughRiders are 1st in Double-A with 783 hits. They are 1st in the league in batting average (.268) and 2nd in runs (532, 6.2 runs per game). The RoughRiders have not led the Texas League in batting average since 2014. Frisco has scored 7 or more runs in 43 percent of their games (37-of-86). The Riders are 4th in the Texas League in homers (119), 1st in doubles (159), 1st in SLG (.454) and 2nd in OPS (.815).

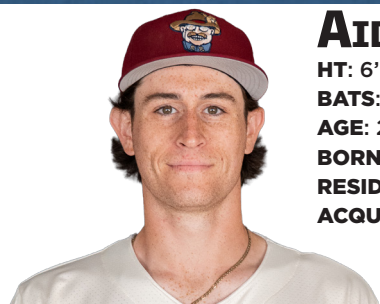

-One of five Rangers pitchers to be signed after the five-round 2020 Draft, including former RoughRiders Josh Stephen and Nick Krauth.

-Originally committed to Bucknell University.

-Was part of the 2017 Ossining Little League team that won the New York state championship and advanced to the Little League World Series.

2026 SEASON

-Before promotion, went 2-1 with 3.48 ERA in 7 starts with High-A Hub City. Struck out 42 in 31.0 IP to 18 walks.

-With Hub City, led South Atlantic League in fly ball rate (51.4%) and 11th in ERA (3.48).

-Tied a career high with 12 strikeouts at Corpus Christi on 7/7. Riders tied nine-inning franchise record with 18 on the night. Over a 2-start span, Curry with 23 strikeouts, the most in a 2-start span in his career.

2025 SEASON

-Started the season with High-A Hub City, owning 4.72 ERA from 4/9-6/11 before spending short stint with ACL Rangers from 6/21-7/23. Returned to Hub City from 7/30-end of season, owning 3.00 ERA over 24.0 IP).

-From 2023-25, Curry was 5th among all High-A and Low-A pitchers with 284.

CHAD COMER

Years with Rangers: 10

Years with RoughRiders: 2 (1st as manager)

Comer returns to Double-A Frisco in 2026 after managing at the High-A level over the last three seasons. The native of Mansfield, Texas will enter his 10th season with the Rangers and his second in Frisco.

In 2022, Comer helped pilot the Riders to their second Texas League Championship in franchise history, serving as a development coach. Over the last three seasons, Comer managed High-A Hickory (2023-2024) and High-A Hub City (2025), going 197-191 (.508).

Prior to Frisco, Comer was the hitting coach for the High-A Hickory Crawdads in 2021, after serving as a coach at various levels of the Rangers system from 2016-2019.

The former University of Texas at Arlington catcher played two seasons in the Atlanta Braves organization, reaching High-A Lynchburg in 2012. He was drafted by Atlanta in the 29th round of the 2011 draft after four seasons at UTA.

THOMAS ST. CLAIR

St. Clair joins the Riders as the pitching coach after leading a Hub City staff that finished third in the SAL with a 3.50 ERA in 2025. St. Clair also will serve as the assistant pitching coordinator in the Rangers farm system in 2026.

Initially, St. Clair came to the Rangers as a coach in the Dominican Summer League in 2022 before serving as a pitching coach for the ACL Rangers from 2022-23. Before professional baseball, he spent two and a half years as pitching coach and recruiting coordinator at North Carolina Wesleyan College.

The right-hander pitched three professional seasons in the St. Louis Cardinals system from 2017-19 after he was picked in the 24th round of the 2017 June draft, making 88 outings for the organization's Rookie and Single-A affiliates.

The Winston-Salem, North Carolina native played four years (2014-17) at Division II Lenior-Rhyne University in Hickory, N.C.

JASON HART

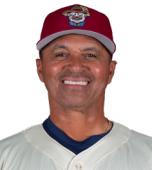
Hart returns as the hitting coach in Frisco for the first time since he served as the RoughRiders hitting coach from 2012-2019. Before that, most recently, he was the Major League hitting assistant for the Miami Marlins under current Rangers manager Skip Schumaker.

In 2015, Hart was named the Mike Coolbaugh Texas League Coach of the Year for his work with the Riders hitters. Prior to joining Frisco, Hart spent two seasons as the hitting coach with Low-A Hickory. His tenure with the Rangers began after he assisted the Single-A Clinton staff with coaching responsibilities for a portion of the 2008 season and continued when he accepted the role of hitting coach for the Arizona Rangers before the 2009 campaign.

Hart played professionally for parts of eight seasons from 1998-2006, with stints in the Oakland, Texas and Minnesota organizations. He made his Major League debut with the Rangers in 2002, when he batted .267 (4-for-15) with three doubles over a span of 10 games. He missed the 2004 campaign following the removal of a benign brain tumor, but returned to the field in 2005 and hit 21 home runs in 128 games with Frisco.

Originally drafted by Oakland in the fifth round of the 1998 draft, Hart was acquired by Texas in a January 2002 trade with the Athletics. He attended Southwest Missouri State University, where he paced the conference in homers in 1997 and was named a Missouri Valley Conference All-Star in 1998.

Hernandez joins the RoughRiders for his first season with the Rangers organization.

During 2020, Hernandez managed the Texas Collegiate League Frisco RoughRiders after the MiLB season had been canceled. In 2025, he served as a bench coach for Triple-A Jacksonville and spent 19 seasons with the Marlins as a coach and coordinator. As part of that stint, he served eight seasons as a manager, most recently in 2022 with High-A Beloit.

Hernandez started his coaching career at the University of Mobile in 1993 as a hitting coach and stayed there through 2001. From 2005-2006, Hernandez served as the hitting coach for the Independent Pensacola Pelicans.

Before joining the professional ranks, Sullenger led the baseball program as head coach at Biola University in La Mirada, California, from 2013-2018.

Additionally, he worked one season in stadium operations for the Tampa Bay Rays. Sullenger attended Spotswood (Va.) High School and went on to play baseball at Florida Southern College (one season) and Liberty University (three seasons).

He holds a bachelor's degree from Liberty and earned a master's degree in Kinesiology with a focus in Athletic Administration/Coaching from James Madison in 2003.

Brown was also a student athletic trainer at Slinger (Wisc.) High School (2022) and Carroll University in Waukesha, Wisc. (2021).

The Louisville, Ky. native holds an associate's degree in Biology (McHenry County College), a Bachelor's degree in Exercise Science (Upper Iowa University), and a Master's in Athletic Training (Carroll University).
